

# PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

Great news! Given a recent court decision and a decline in the number of Covid-19 cases, the CA Bishops have allowed all Masses, baptisms, funerals, and weddings to be held in the Church, with a limit of 200 people. Please make sure to see the new Mass schedule for details. Faith Formation classes and meetings etc. must continue to remain outdoors or online.


I have been here for almost 4 years and since my arrival, my primary goal has always been to improve St Angela's. With your help, support, love, and prayers I believe we've accomplished our goal. Unfortunately, in the process to achieve our goal I've had to push many things to the side; now those things are pushing back. It is for this reason I asked our Bishop to grant me a sabbatical to care for my personal and familial needs. The Bishop has granted me a sabbatical effective July 1, 2021, at that time you will be given a new parochial administrator or pastor. Words cannot express the tremendous gratitude I have for you and all you mean to me. Please don't start the celebration yet as I'll still be here until July 1.

In the upcoming weeks, we will have the opportunity to participate in a new Diocese of Orange survey project, "Called for More." The Called for More Project is an initiative of the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI). CLI received a grant from the Lilly Endowment to pilot a new process for supporting priests and parishes in order to thrive in ministry. By gathering information about each priest and each parish, the pilot seeks to give parishioners more awareness about the needs and opportunities of their local community, priests more awareness and support around their ongoing ministerial development, and the diocese better information with which to consider and discern priestly assignments and parish support.

This survey will help more Catholics to grow in relationship with Jesus Christ, and become more highly engaged in their parish! The survey tool seeks to provide parishioners with an opportunity to reflect on their individual spiritual growth as well as provide the parish leadership with invaluable insight regarding your parish's strengths and opportunities. Our hope is for this experience to provide meaningful input as we set priorities and allocate resources so the parish is moving parishioners forward on their journey of faith as effectively as possible.

**If bad weather (rain, wind, etc.) prevents us from celebrating Sunday Mass on the field,** then we'll move into the church with a slight rain delay. You can also view our live stream Mass at 7:45 am or drive into the church parking lot at 9 am or 10:30 am (Spanish) and listen to Mass on the FM dial at 106.9. At Communion time, approximately 9:45 and 11:15 (Spanish) come up and receive Communion at the covered lunch table area. At all times, please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands.

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

I'm always amazed when I reflect on the fact God created us because he wants to be in a profoundly intimate relationship with us. God does not have to love us. He wants to; it's the desire of his heart. The reason we exist is for this relationship. We were made for love. This is the kind of Good News not possible without the Divine, for no other love for us is so pure, so unconditional, so freely given. In spite of God's total loving perfection, we are broken by sin. Ever since the fall of Adam and Eve sin has caused separation between God and humanity as well as separation between each one of us with each other. Even though we are made for relationship, many things separate us and limit the love for which we were created.

Our first reading reminds us that physical circumstances such as illness can separate us from one another. There are many other physical forms of separation, such as a job that takes a loved one far away, an emotional wound that demands physical distance as a response, and, of course, death itself. But spiritual separation also wounds us. Just as leprosy could be passed from one person to another, so sin infects and hurts those around us. We can see how gossip or lack of integrity influences others. Selfishness or greed hurts those who are most vulnerable. The damage of sin is infectious, just as physical illness is contagious. This is the brokenness into which Jesus enters with his mercy.

In our Gospel when Jesus reached out and touched the leper, he made himself ritually "unclean" under Jewish law. In doing so Jesus continues to show us the importance of the greatest Law...the law of love and compassion. This poor leper most likely hadn't been touched by another human since his first diagnosis. Now most of us are unable to cure illnesses but sometimes it's just a simple touch, an acknowledgment of one's pain, reaching out to others that is even more healing than a miraculous cure. During this pandemic I think we can all relate to the leper in this regard. We're removed and separated from normal relationships, reduced to air hugs, even to the point of avoiding fist and elbow bumps when we see friends. Now more than ever we need the healing touch of Jesus to sustain us.

If you wish, Jesus can make you clean. The leper's faith can lead us also to this confidence today. Jesus, the eternal Word of God, moved with pity, draws near to us and reaches out to us just like he did to the leper. Today Jesus reaches out to us, in a unique and powerful way; especially through his sacramental presence in the Mass. In the Eucharist, Jesus tells us that when we receive Holy Communion... "I am in you and you are in me". For two thousand years this has been the normative way for intimate, personal union with God. The loving touch of Jesus' very presence continues to heal every separation, whether physical, emotional, or spiritual. He does will to make us clean. What wounds can we bring to him today? What broken relationship, separation, or sin needs his healing presence? This is why Christ invites us here, this is why he draws near and reaches out to us. I do will it, he tells us, be made clean.


## PRESIDENT'S DAY

## ST. ANGELA MERICI OPERATION RICE BOWL BEGINS.

Cardboard rice bowl distribution begins today. It is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. CRS Rice Bowl is the Lenten program of Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Through CRS Rice Bowl, faith communities in dioceses throughout the United States put their faith into action. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. Twenty-five percent of donations to CRS Rice Bowl stay in the local diocese, poverty alleviation efforts. This simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms - and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". A tradition for millions of Catholics who employ the Lenten pillars of praying, fasting and almsgiving to change the lives of others while enriching their own. 


