

# PARISH UPDATE

Happy Lent everyone!

It's great to see the number of Covid vaccinations going up and the number of Covid cases coming down. For this reason, we'll slowly, cautiously and safely open for more activities. Our church office will be open for an additional hour in the morning, from 8am to 11am, and after Easter we're hoping to expand office hours to include evenings from 4pm to 7pm. I must say, I'm so very proud and must commend all of you on how well you've followed all the Covid safety protocols. I even had a parishioner from a nearby church say they've decided to make St Angela's their new church home because of our commitment to Covid safety.

As you start to make plans for Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday, please notice we have added an additional Palm Sunday, 12 noon Mass to our schedule. Also, on Easter Sunday, we'll have our first Easter Sunrise Mass on the field at 6:30am; an additional 12 noon Mass in the church has been added as well.

Our St. Angela Merici Parish School will host a virtual auction, A Very Merry Un-Gala Virtual Auction, on Saturday, March 27. Please consider supporting our children and help them "be the change" in our world.

As you may know I have asked our Bishop for a sabbatical starting this July. I'm hoping the sabbatical will provide me an opportunity to address several personal health concerns as well as family related issues. 18 years ago, I was diagnosed with Trigeminal Neuralgia. I've had brain surgery, a Gamma Knife treatment and a multitude of medications which have provided some relief. Unfortunately, over the past 3 years my trigeminal neuralgia has become progressively worse. I'm hopeful that there's a new medicine or procedure which will help provide relief.

Sunday: 7:45am Live stream Mass in the Church. 9:00am Mass on the field. 10:30am Spanish Mass on the field. 5:00pm Mass in the Church. (there is a limit of 200 people in attendance for Masses in the church). Please remember if bad weather prevents us from celebrating Sunday Mass on the field, then we'll move into the church with a slight time delay to make sure the church has been sanitized. You can also view our 7:45 am livestream Mass on line at <https://stangelabreachurch.org/> or drive into the church parking lot at 9:00 am or 10:30 am (Spanish) and listen to Mass on FM dial 106.9. At Communion time, approximately 10:00 am and 11:30 am (Spanish) come up and receive Communion at the covered lunch table area. At all times, please wear your mask, keep social distancing, and before receiving Communion, please sanitize your hands. **Week day Masses** are at 8 am and 6 pm and Sat. 8am. **Adoration** will be in the Church M-F from 8:30-9:30am, 5:00-6:00pm and Sat. 3:30-4:45pm. **Confessions** are on Saturdays in the plaza from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

During Lent, in the midst of fasting, almsgiving, and penance, it is good to pause and look at the gifts God has given us. For Rachel and me, we have been given the gift of precious friends who have affected not only our lives but also the lives of our two adult children, Teresa and Joe, and their children's lives.

Bishop Joe Brennan has been my best friend since we began the college seminary together. There are several others, Ted, taught me to see the positive and the good in people. Msgr. Jim who taught me a lot about liturgy and preaching, at least I hope he taught me a lot. Leah is one of Rachel's closest friends, who many years ago became someone who is a constant source of love and care for our family. Leah is a few years older than me and is an example of the complete and unconditional love of Jesus Christ in our lives as a family. Leah has shown us what it means to love others who are ill and on the margins. She has taught us so many things, I can't begin list them all.

I want you to know a few things about Leah. First, Leah is slowly preparing to die. Her body is slowly giving out. In a person who is so full of love, who has a heart of gold, it is her heart that is giving out. I know whenever my kids interact with her, they are going to walk away feeling absolutely loved. Not because of who they are but because of what Leah sees in them. She sees the best.

Our readings today speak of God's desire to offer us his friendship, not because of who we are, people who walk around in fancy robes and live in nice houses but because it is what God does. In every single word Jesus utters, he manifests God's desire for us to be in relationship with the Father. As we hear in the readings, God loves us first. God chooses us. If that was the end of the story, we'd be in great shape. We are loved! However, there is a price and the price is our deeds. Are we a people of the light, the light that has come into the world? Are we messengers of God's love to others we meet? We can't decide to be messengers, we can't decide to live in the light; no, it is God who lives in us. God leads us through his Son, Jesus, to love.

Now the question is not just do we consent to live in the light, but do we live our lives in the light, with intention. Do we acknowledge it is God who moves us forward, who empowers us and impels us to love and care and affect others in ways we ourselves will never fully understand? For it is our God who is rich in mercy and slow to anger who loves us. But this mercy and love, this God we call Father, is demanding. Because as we heard in the Gospel, God sent his only Son, Jesus, the light of the world, to lead us to salvation.

We are called to live this truth and by this truth, we discover who we need to love and care about, who we need to communicate this God who is rich in love and mercy. It is God who points us to the people he wants us to love. Our friend Leah mirrors God's love; may we mirror God's love in all we do.

## ST. ANGELA MERICI OPERATION RICE BOWL BEGINS.

Cardboard rice bowl distribution begins today. It is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. CRS Rice Bowl is the Lenten program of Catholic Relief Services (CRS). Through CRS Rice Bowl, faith communities in dioceses throughout the United States put their faith into action. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. Twenty-five percent of donations to CRS Rice Bowl stay in the local diocese, poverty alleviation efforts. This simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms - and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". A tradition for millions of Catholics who employ the Lenten pillars of praying, fasting and almsgiving to change the lives of others while enriching their own. 

Eligible expenses are **UNPAID rent or utility bills** due to COVID-19 impact only, not future rent or utility costs. You must also meet income requirement as stated below.

Household annual income must be at or below **80% Area Median Income (AMI)**:

Landlords can encourage tenants to apply.

Rental households in the cities of Anaheim, Santa Ana and Irvine are ineligible for this County program, as those cities provide their own rental assistance programs.
