
HAPPY EASTER SEASON! JESUS CHRIST IS RISEN! ALLELUIA!

SUNDAY REFLECTION

This Sunday has three titles. The first is the Second Sunday of Easter because last Sunday was Easter Sunday. The second, according to the calendar of our Catholic Church, we are within the “Octave” of Easter or within the eight days of the celebration of Easter starting on Holy Saturday at the Easter Vigil.

So today is, literally, Easter Sunday since each day within the Octave is celebrated as Easter Sunday. The third and final name came from Pope St. John Paul II. He named the Second Sunday of Easter, Divine Mercy Sunday, after the devotion of Divine Mercy.

I've never understood why the change to Divine Mercy Sunday. Many Catholics have adapted the devotion to Divine Mercy. But something hit me the other day in reflecting on the readings for this Sunday's celebration that made sense to me. When Mary Magdalen ran from the tomb after seeing the Risen Lord to tell the apostles, the apostles didn't believe her. When the apostles tell Thomas, the Risen Lord had appeared to them, Thomas didn't believe them until Jesus appeared to him, and showed him his wounds. The apostles and Thomas needed more because they were in fear of their lives. They needed more to believe.

The Risen Lord understood his followers more than they knew; Christ Jesus gave them more than they asked for and continued to do so. Jesus not only said “Peace be with you” once, but twice in this encounter. Jesus breathed on the apostles, which reminds us of the Genesis story of the Creation of the World when God breathed over the waters and gave life to his creation. Jesus then made his peace personal; “As the Father sent me, so I send you.”

Today, we find ourselves living in the midst of a worldwide pandemic. Death has been around us for this past year in very real ways, and many of us have been affected by death in our families and friends. Hatred and racism seem to be everywhere. Life is very fragile and scary. Our Risen Savior understands us down to the very core of our being. Scripture gives us the opportunity on this Divine Mercy Sunday to look again at the indescribable depth of the love, compassion, and mercy our God offers us. We get a glimpse of this mercy yet we can never fully understand it.

In our First Reading, from the Acts of the Apostles, the first line tells us we are in this together; “The community of believers was of one heart and mind.” We are not alone. We are called to pray for each other and love one another. Why? We are called to share this divine mercy and love of our God with those we meet, with those we encounter in our lives. It is not enough to know God has mercy on us, we must extend this mercy and love to those who need it most; people we meet on a daily basis, and those we know about by extension. Affirming someone who is working hard or trying their best, listening to someone we would normally not give the time of day, giving someone a hand who needs help.

This week I hope and pray we take five or ten minutes each day, perhaps at the beginning of our day, to pray and think about how we can bring our Risen Lord's gentle mercy into the lives of those we touch. The possibilities are endless. We are called to start. Jesus was preparing his followers for Pentecost when they would go out and preach the Good News of the Kingdom of God. Jesus prepares us for Pentecost every time we celebrate this Eucharistic Feast by giving us his Body and Blood so we might share his body, blood, soul, and divinity with all we meet. Today may we feel the Divine Mercy of our God and extend it to all we meet. Happy Easter everyone!



The season of Lent gives us a wonderful opportunity to reflect and make room in our hearts to welcome the stranger. Through our **prayer**, we encounter Jesus, who is present in the face of every member of our human family. When we **fast**, we encounter the obstacles that stop us from fully loving God and our neighbor. When we **give alms**, we share what we have with others. We have been using our rice bowls so far during Lent to share ourselves and save our treasure (alms) for those in need.

This Lent CRS Rice Bowl has taken us to three countries, Madagascar, El Salvador, and Timor-Leste. Hunger and malnutrition, which happens when we don't get the right amount of nutrients, are challenges that too many families face each day. One out of every 10 people worldwide don't have enough to eat. Sometimes this is caused by natural disasters like floods and droughts. Other times, families don't have enough money to buy the food they need, or the food they can get doesn't have all the vitamins and minerals they need to stay healthy. Our donations to CRS rice bowl help find solutions for these people.

As our Lenten sacrifices transition to our Easter Joy we will collect your rice bowl donations [**Until April 15**]. Use the collection boxes at Mass or drop your rice bowl donations by the parish office. You can add up the bowl contents and write a check for that amount to **Catholic Relief Services (CRS)** or if you prefer turn in the bowl cash. Don't forget to pray for those who benefit from your support.
