PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

It is my privilege and great joy to announce Fr. Randy Guillen will be the new Administrator for St. Angela Merici Parish. Fr. Randy comes to us from St. Joachim Church in Costa Mesa where he served as a Parochial Vicar. I'm truly excited about his coming here and believe wholeheartedly he'll be perfect for St. Angela's. Now of course, after being around me for 4 years you know no priest is perfect, we all have strengths and areas for growth, but I know he'll bring strengths I didn't possess and will take our Parish to the next level. I look forward to sharing more with you in the next couple months. Please stay tuned and welcome Fr. Randy when he arrives in July and my sabbatical begins. Fortunately for St. Angela's, Fr. Francis will remain here for at least another year to help show Fr. Randy the ropes and make his transition as smooth as possible. Until then please start praying for Fr. Randy as he makes the transition into his new parish home. As always, your prayers for me are much appreciated as well.

It's great to see the number of Covid vaccinations going up and the number of Covid cases coming down. Given the low infection rate and the increased number of people being vaccinated, we are slowly and cautiously opening up for more activities. Our church office is now open every day from 8 to 11 am and every evening from 4 to 7 pm except Sundays. Schools and church services are allowed to reduce the 6-foot safe distance between people from different households to 3 feet and there is no longer a capacity limit for people inside the church provided we wear masks and keep the minimum 3-feet safe distance rule.

I've been taking informal poles about reducing the distance from 6 to 3-feet and there's about 15% of our parishioners who, for health reasons, want to maintain the 6-foot safe distancing rule. For this reason, and because our attendance allows us to maintain the 6' rule, I believe it's best to postpone reducing the safe distance from 6 to 3'. It's great to know we have the option to sit closer to each other and still be safe. Eventually we will be removing the pew barriers and allowing people to sit in all pews. Another exciting announcement is all of our ministry related groups are now allowed to meet inside, provided food is not served. This includes the Knights of Columbus, PALS, Social Justice, charismatic prayer groups, Fire, Ignite, Rosary, etc.

Our annual Pastoral Services Appeal, PSA, is well under way. PSA provides an opportunity for us to join together as one Diocese of Orange church family in our support of many diverse ministries like; Catholic Education, Clergy Formation and Support, Outreach ministries to the poor and needy, and Parish and Diocesan Development. These ministries and services benefit our own parish as well as parishes and people all over Orange County. With funds from PSA, we will be able to address some significant needs here at St. Angela Merici Church. This year we have chosen to focus on refurbishing/ replacing our church pews. With all the major improvements to our lighting system we can now see how our pews and kneelers have fallen into disrepair. In the months ahead we will hear how we can respond to this call to carry on the work of Christ in our community. Please prayerfully consider how you will be able to support this important appeal.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

JESUS' FOOTPRINT ON THE MOUNT OF OLIVES CONNECTS US WITH HIS HEAVENLY HOME AND THE OPPORTUNITY TO PROCLAIM HIS GOSPEL

It is the morning of Tuesday, October 6, 2015, and I am staring into the sky on top of Mount Olivet (Mount of Olives) in Bethany, Israel, next to the Chapel of the Ascension. I am imagining I am one of the Apostles looking at Jesus as he ascends into heaven. This happened after I exited a 12 by 12 meter octagonal structure, known as a martyrium (memorial), where a glass-encased rock can be found containing the footprint of Jesus prior to His ascension into heaven.

No, I did not literally see Jesus for those who might be asking. My reason for doing this was to experience, as best I could, how the Apostles must have felt after spending three years with the Son of God. My initial reaction was both eerie and sad He is physically gone. But, as I looked down, I realized everything else is still the same, and I need to follow through with the commission He gave to them and to all who are baptized: **Evangelize, Heal, Experience the Power of the Holy Spirit, and the Presence of Jesus.**

Evangelization is the duty of every Christian to communicate the life vision contained in the Christian Testament and in the Gospel. In the Diocese of Orange, evangelization is the first of five key themes in the five-year Strategic Plan through 2023 which quotes Jesus words before His ascension to spread the Gospel message. It focuses on a vision to promote a personal relationship with Jesus and celebration of the sacraments to increase Mass participation, expand the number of Catholics in Faith formation, and increase youth and young adults active in the Church. Call the parish office to become involved.

Healing for a Christian primarily addresses reconciliation of the sinner and his or her soul. In doing so, we sometimes neglect the whole person who needs healing in spirit, mind, feelings, and body. Salvation affects all we are. This is especially important in a world striving to make sense of what is essential to not just maintain and thrive in life.

Power is an ingredient we don't often hear about in the teachings of Jesus unless it refers to God using His power to punish those who disobeyed His will. With Jesus in heaven, it is the power of the Holy Spirit who provides us with tools of strength in times of weakness, hopes to offset fear or despair, and meaning to handle many life situations.

Presence takes a two-prong approach. First, the presence of Jesus as He works with and through His Paraclete, the Holy Spirit, sent here after His ascension. Second, is our presence, with the help of the Holy Spirit, to give all He has created a new life in the Church. It comes to us through multiple sacramental rites, keeping the faith, and spreading the Good News.

The feast of Ascension is not to commemorate a departure, but the celebration of the living and lasting presence of Jesus in the Church. It was time for Him to rejoin His Father, send us the Holy Spirit, and prepare for the day of His return. We need to carry on with His perfect plan.

Let us take this time between now and Pentecost, to prioritize what specifically we need to do to evangelize, heal, power up, and be present as Jesus calls us to "Go into the whole world and proclaim the Gospel to every creature." We might surprise ourselves with what we discover. If we decide to take it a step further and do something about it, we might be blessed in many different and wonderful ways because we said "yes" to Jesus' command and an opportunity to serve Him and all His creation.
