PARISH UPDATE

Dear friends,

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued guidance stating that "fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing," does this mean we still need to wear a mask while on church grounds? The short answer is "yes," we recommend all people wear masks while on church grounds. Why so? The problem is we have no way to know who has been fully vaccinated and who hasn't. The other issue is our Governor has required masks to be worn until mid June. We're almost there, please continue to be patient.

I've been taking informal polls at Masses about reducing the safe distance from 6 to 3 feet and there's about 15% of our parishioners who, for health reasons, want to maintain the 6-foot safe distancing rule. For this reason, and because our attendance allows us to maintain the 6' rule, I believe it's prudent to just remove the box barriers from the pews in the back 1/3 of the church. The front 2/3 of the pews will still meet the 6-foot distancing standard for those who have safety concerns. Of course, as more people start attending Mass, we'll slowly reduce the safe distance from 6' to 3' to less than 3' for the entire church.

Another exciting announcement is all of our ministry related groups are now allowed to meet inside. This includes the Knights of Columbus, PALS, Social Justice, charismatic prayer groups, Fire, Ignite, Rosary, etc. Please see Gina Mock to reserve your meeting space. We are planning a "reopening weekend, ministry faire, and good bye to Fr Dave" on June 13. Starting the June 13, we will return to our previous Mass schedule. This means there will no longer be outside field Masses and all Masses will be in the Church. Please note, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be eliminated.

It is with great joy and my privilege to announce that Fr. Randy Guillen will be the new Administrator for St. Angela Merici Parish. Fr. Randy comes to us from St. Joachim Church in Costa Mesa where he served as a Parochial Vicar. I'm truly excited about his coming here and believe wholeheartedly he'll be perfect for St. Angela's. Now of course, after being around me for 4 years you know no priest is perfect, we all have strengths and areas for growth, but I know he'll bring strengths I didn't possess and will take our Parish to the next level. I look forward to sharing more with you in the next couple months. Please stay tuned and welcome Fr. Randy when he arrives in July when my sabbatical begins. Fortunately for St Angela's, Fr. Francis will remain here for at least another year to help show Fr. Randy the ropes and make his transition as smooth as possible. Until then please start praying for Fr. Randy as he makes the transition into his new parish home. As always your prayers for me are much appreciated.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

PENTECOST

Last week we celebrated the Feast of the Ascension where the Resurrected Jesus returns to the Father. But before he leaves, he promises his disciples he will send the Advocate/Holy Spirit to help them build God's kingdom on earth. Today we celebrate the great Feast of Pentecost; the sending forth of the Holy Spirit; God's total self-giving and outpouring of grace to fill us and the world with God's very presence. This gift of God's Holy Spirit empowers us to achieve supernatural virtue and guides us in our discipleship to be more like Jesus. While Jesus had revealed much to his disciples in the time they had been together, he has much more to tell them and to tell us. It's important we're docile to the Holy Spirit, to hear God's continuing revelation to us and the world.

Before Jesus ascended, he had told his disciples to remain in Jerusalem until they had received the promise of the Spirit (Acts 1:4). Thus, we find Jesus' disciples, who were observant Jews, were all in one place together on Pentecost. This group includes not only the Apostles but also some women, Mary, the mother of Jesus, and his brothers (Acts 1:14). We see the Church in its earliest form, consisting of those who were with Jesus during his public ministry who can serve as eyewitnesses. With the aid of the Spirit their numbers begin to increase, God's Kingdom is coming and the church is growing. On Pentecost they were all filled with the Holy Spirit. They proceeded to speak in different languages, so a large crowd from many nations, gathered in Jerusalem for the feast, heard them speaking in their own tongues. As God divided the nations at Babel, so now the Holy Spirit unites them so they all might hear the Gospel the disciples are proclaiming. This leads to many in the crowd embracing the Good News of Jesus Christ and being baptized. The early Church began to grow, and with the power, guidance, and protection of the Holy Spirit her mission of revealing to the world the Gospel of Jesus Christ spread to all nations.

We here today are heirs to that Pentecostal moment, and to the life in the Spirit the early Christians proclaimed and passed on. This proclamation is found in some of its best form in the words of Saint Paul. The Holy Spirit, given to us in baptism, assists us in following God's commands. A life guided by the Holy Spirit bears good fruit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Of all the things we could "produce" in our lives, why would we seek to do anything other than what allows us to bring these good fruits into the world? The Holy Spirit changed the world, and we are not so small he cannot change us, there is no better Advocate than the Holy Spirit. As the Holy Spirit sanctifies the Church, may he sanctify each one of us, and guide us in our lives of discipleship.


