# PARISH UPDATE

We are planning a "Church reopening weekend, ministry faire, and good bye to Fr. Dave," June 12 and 13. From this day forward all Masses will be back in the church, there will no longer be any Masses on the field, it's just getting too warm out. The Mass schedule will be: Saturday at 5:00pm, Sunday at 7:45am (livestream), 9:30am, 11:15am, 12:45pm in Spanish and 5:00pm. As part of this special celebration, we will also have our ministries available on the Plaza. Come by and get information about many of our various Ministries. We will also be saying good-bye to Fr. Dave. He thanks God for his time spent at St Angela's these past four years. Stop by the Plaza after all the morning Masses to bid him farewell. Food and refreshments will be served. See you there.


**Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament** is available in the Church M-F following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM. **Confession** is available in the plaza on Saturday from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

If you view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabreachurch.org/mass/> or listen to Mass in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area from 10:00 to 10:15am. **However, starting June 13 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area only from 10:30 to 10:45am.**

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued guidance stating "fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing," so does this mean we should wear a mask while on church grounds? The short answer is "yes," we recommend all people wear masks while on church grounds. Why? The problem is we have no way to know who has been fully vaccinated and who hasn't. The other issue is our Governor has required masks to be worn until mid June. We're almost there, please continue to be patient. I've been taking informal polls at Masses about reducing the safe distance from 6 to 3 feet and there's about 15% of our parishioners who, for health reasons, want to maintain the 6-foot safe distancing rule. For this reason, and because our attendance allows us to maintain the 6' rule, I believe it's prudent to just remove the box barriers from the pews in the back 1/3 of the church. The front 2/3 of the pews will still meet the 6 foot distancing standard for those who have safety concerns. Of course, as more people start attending Mass we'll slowly reduce the safe distance from 6' to 3' to less than 3' for the entire church.

Please note: per the Diocese, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation will be eliminated.

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY: A MYSTERY WE DEFINE AS GOD's LOVE FOR US

For those who love mysteries, there is none greater than The Most Holy Trinity. Only God has the answer. Though He shares it in so many different ways through what the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit do for us, it befuddles us. We spend an inordinate amount of time looking to make sense of its components (three Persons in one God) than accepting what They accomplish together and individually.

We probably shouldn't be too surprised since the Church itself didn't provide a doctrine of a Trinitarian God until the Council of Constantinople in 381 AD, from which came the Nicene Creed. Not even the Bible mentions the word Trinity in the Hebrew Scriptures or New Testament. Theologians use nature, person and relations to best "define" what Trinity is and does. St. Patrick used a three-leaf clover to explain the Trinity and St. Augustine likened the Trinity to the Lover (God the Father), the Beloved (Jesus the Son) and the Love (The Holy Spirit) which binds Them together.

In essence, I believe we are so intent on solving this mystery because we want to know why God created us. The reasons we give are somewhat convoluted, especially when we try to give human reasons for God's decision. The answer accepted by most in the end is it was a choice. It seems to me to be the best answer and one that brings a good feeling to all of us; especially those who believe in God.

From the standpoint of our Gospel and readings, we learn what God's intent for us as a Triune God is to make sure His perfect plan for our life on earth and ultimate salvation is based on a foundation of love for Him and all that He has created.

In our first reading from the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses consistently wants the Israelites to understand that God is committed to their wellbeing. Though he never defines who God is as a Triune entity, he shares with them the unique relationship that have with God as His chosen people. He lists multiple experiences while in Egypt before their release and during the 40 years in the desert all that God has done for them, even though they have challenged God during the entire time. All God asks is their loyalty.

St. Paul in his letter to the Romans outlines for us in detail how the Spirit of God works on our behalf when we are faithful and follow His ways. We are adopted children of God who we call "Abba, Father" and heirs with Christ who though we will suffer with Jesus, we also will be glorified with Him. Though not named as the Trinity, it is the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit working with one another to ensure Their love shines brightly in our lives.

St. Matthew's Gospel provides the purpose of The Most Holy Trinity by mandating that the Apostles and we who are baptized in the name of the Trinity to go throughout the world baptizing all in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. In addition, we are to teach everyone to follow the ways of the Lord as he commanded. And finally, a reminder to all of us, that He is with us always, until the end of time.

Our Bible is filled with multiple stories of how The Most Holy Trinity has chosen Their love to be shared with us. It is by that love that we recognize a Triune God who though a mystery in Their nature, Their personage and in Their relationship with each other, we have been chosen to be loved and saved. Let us follow the ways of the Lord, no matter how difficult it may seem and the mystery is more of question of God's depth of love for us rather than how God is able to put it all together for our benefit.

The Knights of Columbus quarterly Mass will be celebrated on June 13th at the 9:30am Mass. Hope to see you there!




## FUNERAL PLANNING

## CHURCH CROSS




