PARISH UPDATE

Wow, wasn't this past weekend amazing? It was so good to see so many ministries represented on the plaza....and so many people chatting and having fun. I was also very touched by all the expressions of gratitude and love for past 4 years of service. Just AMAZING! A big THANKS to everyone who made the "Church reopening weekend, ministry faire and good bye to Fr. Dave", such a success. Special THANKS to our Knights of Columbus, Sue and Rodger. Exceptional! As previously mentioned, from this time forward all Masses are back in the church, there will no longer be any Masses on the field; it's getting too hot outside. The current Mass schedule is: Saturday at 5:00pm, Sunday at 7:45am (livestream), 9:30am, 11:15am, 12:45pm in Spanish and 5:00pm.

I would also like to express my sincere gratitude to all those involved in making this year's Masses so beautiful. From our field Masses to Masses in the Hall, the plaza and finally back into the Church. This includes all of our Drive Thru events as well. Together we've kept people engaged and our faith strong. BIG TIME THANKS TO ALL OF YOU!

The Ministry of Altar Servers is being brought back. If your child is interested in becoming an Altar Server please call the church office. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available in the Church M-F following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM. Confession is available in the plaza on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

If you view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabrechurch.org/mass/> or listen to Mass in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area on Sundays from 10:30 to 10:45am to coincide with the new Mass schedule. Please note: per the Diocese, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is eliminated unless you have a serious health concern. Such as: those who are currently ill or caring for an ill person, those who have a fever or exhibit flu-like symptoms and those who have good reason to think they might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (for example, those who have been in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as Covid or influenza).

It is with great joy and my privilege to announce Fr. Randy Guillen will be the new Administrator for St. Angela Merici Parish. Fr. Randy comes to us from St. Joachim Church in Costa Mesa where he served as a Parochial Vicar. I'm truly excited about his coming here and believe wholeheartedly that he'll be perfect for St Angela's. Now of course, after being around me for 4 years you know that no priest is perfect, we all have strengths and areas for growth, and I know Fr. Randy will bring strengths that I didn't possess. When I first arrived at St. Angela's I thought this community needed more "charisma", now that 4 years has past, I think St. Angela's is ready for more "content" than "charisma". Fr. Randy is the best person to bring good solid content to take St Angela's to the next level. Please pray for Fr. Randy as he makes the transition into his new parish home. As always, your prayers for me are much appreciated as well.

I've been taking informal polls at Masses about reducing the safe distance from 6 to 3 feet and there's about 15% of our parishioners who, for health reasons, want to maintain the 6-foot safe distancing rule. For this reason, and because our attendance allows us to maintain the 6' rule, I believe it's prudent to remove the box barriers from the pews in the back 2/3 of the church. The front 1/3 of the pews will still meet the 6 foot distancing standard for those who have safety concerns. Of course, as more people start attending Mass we'll slowly reduce the safe distance from 6' to 3' to less than 3' for the entire church. For those who are fully vaccinated, masks and social distancing are no longer required at Mass. If you're not fully vaccinated, wearing a mask and safe distancing is recommended.

SUNDAY REFLECTION

LET US GIVE THANKS TO THE LORD FOR HIS GOODNESS

Almost all of us will experience fears, traumas, shocks, and near death moments. Whether we want to admit it or not, they are part of daily life. When this happens what we want most is to be rid of them as soon as possible and return to moments of tranquility. We readily want these harrowing moments to disappear and never return.

The story in the Gospel today presents us a Jesus who sleeps very peacefully in the boat where his disciples are on board. All was well until the moment when a strong gale strikes the fragile boat that carried them, nearly drowning them, and suddenly they are overpowered by a terrifying wind, and it is at that moment when they awaken their sleeping master to hurry and save them.

What happens with the disciples of Jesus is not far from what happens to us. It is enough to note that in almost any grave difficulty, whether unbearable surprise or suffering...almost unwittingly, there escapes from our lips' expressions like these: "my God, free us Lord, have mercy dear Lord." In the presence of almost any calamity or natural disaster we ask ourselves, where are you, Oh God?

Nevertheless, God does see us, we know with certainty, he watches over us and guards us. We cannot doubt this, but at moments of prosperity and well-being, it is almost as if we forget him and cease to invoke his name.

The Word of God in this reading for today takes us all to a moment in our lives when we are buffeted by raging winds that we really lack faith. We should have confidence. He will not overlook us and will be there, especially in this tempest that drives us by the winds of fear. Our Lord Jesus asks us: "you do not trust me, especially now?"

One might ask, what is faith? Above all, let us not forget faith is one of the three theological virtues. It refers to God, but again, what is faith? The answer is given by the Letter to the Hebrews where it says: Faith means to hold on to what is hoped for, it is the certainty concerning those things we cannot see "(Heb 11:1)

My dear brothers and sisters. Let us give thanks to the Lord for his goodness, and ask him to bless us and our families in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. May you all have a blessed week and may these blessings go to you, your families, neighbors, friends, and community. Amen.


FUNERAL PLANNING


