I also want to THANK each of you for your tremendous support and generosity of spirit over the past 4 years. St Angela's has definitely become a great Parish home to worship our Lord. Please remember all Masses are back in the church, there are no longer any Masses on the field, it's just become too hot outside. The current Mass schedule is Saturday at 5:00pm, Sunday at 7:45am (livestream), 9:30am, 11:15am, 12:45pm in Spanish and 5:00pm.

I would also like to express my sincere gratitude to all those involved in making this year's Masses so beautiful. From our field Masses to Masses in the Hall, the plaza and finally back into the Church. This includes all our Drive Thru events as well. Together we have kept people engaged and our faith strong. BIG TIME THANKS TO ALL OF YOU!

The Ministry of Altar Servers is being brought back. If your child is interested in becoming an Altar Server please call the church office. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available in the Church M-F following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM. Confession is available in the plaza on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

If you view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabreachurch.org/mass/> or listen to Mass in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area on Sundays from 10:30 to 10:45am to coincide with the new Mass schedule. Please note: per the Diocese, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is eliminated unless you have a serious health concern. Such as: those who are currently ill or caring for an ill person, those who have a fever or exhibit flu-like symptoms and those who have good reason to think they might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (for example, those who have been in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as Covid or influenza).

It is with great joy and my privilege to announce Fr. Randy Guillen will be the new Administrator for St. Angela Merici Parish. Fr. Randy comes to us from St. Joachim Church in Costa Mesa where he served as a Parochial Vicar. I'm truly excited about his coming here and believe wholeheartedly that he'll be perfect for St Angela's. Now of course, after being around me for 4 years you know that no priest is perfect, we all have strengths and areas for growth, and I know Fr. Randy will bring strengths that I didn't possess. ## SUNDAY REFLECTION

We heard in the Gospel today about the synagogue official named Jairus who asks Jesus to lay his hands on his daughter "who is at the point of death." Jairus belongs to a group of people who believe Jesus is a fraud, a fake and is doing nothing but causing trouble among the people of Israel and especially among the Romans. But the man's daughter of 12-years old is dying and Jairus betrays his standing in the community, takes on the ridicule of many, including his own family, and go to Jesus. Jairus asks Jesus to come and lay his hands on his daughter. Jairus has faith, but I would bet he and his wife were scared to death.

Over the past year and a half, many of us have experienced the death of someone we know, maybe even someone related to us has died from Covid. It's been a tough time for people all over the world. But most of us don't know the pain Jairus and his wife must have been feeling with the knowledge their own daughter was dying. As the Gospel progresses, people come to Jairus and his wife that indeed, their daughter has died. In the midst of this awful message, Jesus sees Jairus and his wife in utter, indescribable pain. This pain we know our Blessed Mother felt seeing her own son murdered, is beyond belief.

Jesus tells the couple what he has told his apostles over and over again in: "Don't be afraid;" then, "Have faith." Then without fanfare, trying to keep what he was about to do as quiet as possible, with as few people as possible knowing about it, takes the little girl by her hand and tells her, "Arise."

So, what about you and me? What does this Gospel story cause us to do? If I had a dollar for every time acted out of a lack of faith in my life, I'd have a whole lot of money! How often have I been afraid of one thing or one person or another? Arise! How often have I been worried about the possibility of losing my job? Arise, don't be afraid, have faith! How often have we been in a situation when we've hurt someone and are afraid that person won't forgive us? Arise, don't be afraid, have faith. How often have we been afraid of losing a loved one and it happens: Arise, don't be afraid, have faith.

Should we have faith in ourselves too? Yes, absolutely. In our First Reading from the Book of Wisdom, we are reminded God made man in his own image. In Baptism, Confirmation, and the Eucharist, we have been given the Holy Spirit. We have been given the Gifts of the Holy Spirit: knowledge, wisdom, and courage, just to name a few. These are part of our very being. We need to remember we have been given these gifts to use when everything seems to be going down the drain. We must Arise, we must have faith nourished by the Holy Spirit within us. In the worst of times, in the best of times, and everything in the middle, we are called by Jesus to have faith.

Jesus knows us to our very core, and the Holy Spirit is at our very core. Jesus knows full well that our faith is sometimes weak. Instead of walking away from us, Jesus whispers in our ear, just as he told Jairus and his wife, don't be afraid, have faith. Then, as he did with their little girl, Jesus calls us to be nourished with his Body and Blood.

Next time we are faced with stress and worry, may we hear the voice of Jesus. May we not be afraid, may we Arise and have Faith!


## FUNERAL PLANNING
