I also want to THANK each of you for your tremendous support and generosity of spirit over the past 4 years. St Angela's has definitely become a great Parish home to worship our Lord. Please remember all Masses are back in the church, there are no longer any Masses on the field, it's just become too hot outside. The current Mass schedule is Saturday at 5:00pm, Sunday at 7:45am (livestream), 9:30am, 11:15am, 12:45pm in Spanish and 5:00pm.

I would also like to express my sincere gratitude to all those involved in making this year's Masses so beautiful. From our field Masses to Masses in the Hall, the plaza and finally back into the Church. This includes all our Drive Thru events as well. Together we have kept people engaged and our faith strong. BIG TIME THANKS TO ALL OF YOU!

The Ministry of Altar Servers is being brought back. If your child is interested in becoming an Altar Server please call the church office. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available in the Church M-F following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM. Confession is available in the plaza on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

If you view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabreachurch.org/mass/> or listen to Mass in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area on Sundays from 10:30 to 10:45am to coincide with the new Mass schedule. Please note: per the Diocese, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is eliminated unless you have a serious health concern. Such as: those who are currently ill or caring for an ill person, those who have a fever or exhibit flu-like symptoms and those who have good reason to think they might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (for example, those who have been in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as Covid or influenza).

It is with great joy and my privilege to announce Fr. Randy Guillen will be the new Administrator for St. Angela Merici Parish. Fr. Randy comes to us from St. Joachim Church in Costa Mesa where he served as a Parochial Vicar. I'm truly excited about his coming here and believe wholeheartedly that he'll be perfect for St Angela's. Now of course, after being around me for 4 years you know that no priest is perfect, we all have strengths and areas for growth, and I know Fr. Randy will bring strengths that I didn't possess. SUNDAY REFLECTION

Every time we come together to celebrate Mass, Jesus Christ our Lord is with us. Every time the Eucharist is celebrated, he is among us and within us. The question that has plagued us since Jesus walked this earth and proclaimed the Kingdom of God is this: will he, once again, find faith here in this little corner of his Father's vineyard, or will he be amazed at our lack of faith, yours and mine.

We gather on this 4th of July Holiday weekend. Many of us are probably wearing some sort of red, white, and blue as a sign of our celebrations. This year, after a year and a half of pandemic quarantine, we are able to gather with our families and friends. Thank God! However, we can see our nation is not united but is very much divided. Either I agree with you and will tell you why or I vehemently disagree and will likely yell at you telling you why you are wrong.

What does this say about us on this Sunday when in the gospel reading, Jesus himself is mocked, and angrily ignored. He can barely perform any miracles, "mighty deeds," as Mark writes. The very people who love him and know him, who are at once amazed by him and now shout how small Jesus is, how little he is worth. They were offended by him; by Jesus!

Then we come to our Second Reading. Paul increases in his weakness because it is only in his very weakness that Jesus dwells in him. It is only when Paul is weak, that he is strong because Jesus and his Holy Spirit are able to work in him.

What about us? When can Jesus most work through us? When we are on top of the world? When we feel we are better than everybody else? As Christians and Catholics, when are we most effective in our ministry of proclaiming the Kingdom, the command we were given at our Baptism? For me, it's when things are most out of control in my life and in my ministry. It's when I think I have nothing to give, when I'm most empty and feeling most alone. Not when I'm at the 'top of my game' (sorry for the sports metaphor!). It is when I'm weak that I can open my mind AND heart to the love and guidance of the Holy Spirit. When I can admit my own lack of faith and be filled with the grace of our loving God!

Do you know how I know and understand this? Because of you. It seems when I'm questioning my own usefulness, my own abilities, that one of you will affirm me in what I'm doing. You give me the pat on my back and encourage me on. You tell people like me that I'm good and loving. God speaks through you, and you make others feel loved. You and I can do so because our God calls us to do just that. It's as simple as telling the grocery clerk at Ralphs they're doing a great job; the receptionist at our doctor's office and even the kid who mows our lawn, especially if he or she is our own son or daughter!

Can we step out of our divisiveness today and be gracious to someone? Can we affirm someone we run into today? They might just need it and it's so simple. With faith, we know the Spirit is pushing us to love, to share God's grace and tenderness. Can we dig deep, even when it's tough to do so, and be kind today?

The big question is this: will Fr. Randy Guillen find faith here? Will Jesus see our faith in action today? This week?

Let's share our blessings on this 4th of July Holiday! Peace on you!


