Please remember all Masses are back in the church, there are no longer any Masses on the field, it's just become too hot outside. The current Mass schedule is Saturday at 5:00pm, Sunday at 7:45am (livestream), 9:30am, 11:15am, 12:45pm in Spanish and 5:00pm.

I would also like to express my sincere gratitude to all those involved in making this year's Masses so beautiful. From our field Masses to Masses in the Hall, the plaza and finally back into the Church. This includes all our Drive Thru events as well. Together we have kept people engaged and our faith strong. The Ministry of Altar Servers is being brought back. If your child is interested in becoming an Altar Server please call the church office. Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is available in the Church M-F following the morning Mass from 8:30 to 9:30 AM, before the evening Mass from 5 to 6 PM and Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:45 PM. Confession is available in the plaza on Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:30pm.

If you view our live stream Mass at <http://stangelabrechurch.org/mass/> or listen to Mass in the parking lot on the FM dial at 106.9 you may receive Communion at the covered lunch table area on Sundays from 10:30 to 10:45am to coincide with the new Mass schedule. Please note: per the Diocese, since the number of Covid vaccinations has risen and the number of cases has dramatically declined, the dispensation from the obligation to attend Holy Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation is eliminated unless you have a serious health concern. Such as: those who are currently ill or caring for an ill person, those who have a fever or exhibit flu-like symptoms and those who have good reason to think they might be asymptomatic of a contagious illness (for example, those who have been in recent contact with someone who tested positive for a contagious illness such as Covid or influenza).

Just a reminder, the front pews will maintain safe distancing for those who have safety concerns. For those who are fully vaccinated, masks and social distancing are no longer required at Mass. If you are not fully vaccinated, wearing a mask and safe distancing is recommended.



## SUNDAY REFLECTION

In this Sunday's readings we can see one thing we have in common with all the people mentioned in the old and new testaments which is being elected by God. Many times, in our lives we had the desire to be chosen, possibly to be a part of a sports team, in stage production, asked to dance or go out on a date or even asked to be married. The list is infinite but there is an important part of being recognized and belonging.

In today's first reading Amos, a prophet, was being humiliated and was content with being a shepherd rather than being a prophet. He voiced his reluctance as being elected by God as well as many others who looked for excuses to find a way out. This began with Moses, who stuttered, and asked the Lord to choose his brother Aaron for the task of leading the people of Israel to freedom.

One might wonder why God chooses who he does, as Paul in the second reading notes, "in Him we are chosen." Paul makes it evident that he persecuted the Church. Even with this fact the Lord called him on the road to Damascus, as he was chasing some of the early Christians, when he heard the voice, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" After his conversion, some still had to be convinced he was one of them.

Nothing could be clearer than when Jesus hand picked the Apostles, they were going about their everyday lives when the Lord said, "Come follow me." In the Gospel, Jesus finally sends them out to preach, heal and cast out demons. In this experience they also need to trust in the Father's providence. A great test for them after leaving the security of Jesus' presence.

The task, for all mentioned, is to further the Kingdom of God! In our own election we might concentrate on our weaknesses or fears, and ask why has God chosen me for this? We might question His choice of others, as with Paul, and say, what have they got? Or judge them for what we see and not what God sees. No matter where we find ourselves on this pilgrimage of faith, we are all called to look at the Lord, not ourselves, and know that He gives us what we need to fulfill the mission He entrusts each of us, as we all participate in this history of salvation and know, as Paul says, "In Him we are chosen."


## FUNERAL PLANNING
