# SUNDAY REFLECTION

It is not an exaggeration to say that in order to understand and comprehend any message that comes our way, it is important to listen carefully, with complete attention. Above all else, it is important to know how to listen. Today's reading of Deuteronomy ends with these words: "Hear, O Israel, the Lord, our God, is the Lord alone, you shall love your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength. Write in your heart the commandments which I have proclaimed to you today."

The commandments of the lord were well known by his people, and those who knew them and were capable of their interpretation, were the teachers of the Law. The narrative today presents us a scribe, specifically one who knew the Law and a teacher of the Law of God, who approaches Jesus to ask him a question; which clearly makes it possible he already knew the answer to the question he was: "What is the first of all the commandments?" Jesus responds and gives the answer which the scribe knew and expected, but comes as a surprise to the teacher. He hears Jesus say: "You are not far from the Kingdom of God." With this he was saying, in effect: "If you are already doing this, continue, but if you have not yet done this, it will be too late, so my brothers and sisters in Christ. Let us begin now, let us not put it off until tomorrow."

Obedience to the Law of the lord is a gain and to live it has its benefits even while here on earth we do not have to wait for the other life to receive the reward. Moreover, it is an encouraging and a powerful promise which is given to those who obey the Law of the lord. Remember to Obey them always, and your life will be extended so we may be happy and may multiply. I love you, Lord, for you are my strength. Bless my brothers and sisters and their families. In Jesus name we pray. Amen.

Jesús da la respuesta sabida y esperada por el maestro, pero lo que no se esperaba el maestro de la ley, le vino de peso, pues escucha de Jesús: "No estás lejos del reino de Dios." Con esto dándole a entender: Mira, si ya lo haces, pues síguelo haciendo, pero si todavía no lo haces," pues síguelo haciendo, pero si todavía no lo haces," para luego es tarde, empieza a hacerlo, pero ya, no lo dejes para mañana."

El cumplir la ley del señor es ganancia y practicarla siempre tiene su recompensa desde aquí en la tierra, no hay que esperar a la otra vida. Además, es alentadora la promesa que se hace a quienes cumplen la ley del señor: "Cúmpleslos siempre y así prolongarás tu vida... para que seas feliz y te multipliques." This past September 24, our own John Lee and 21 other classmates stood in front of the Altar of Christ Cathedral and were officially accepted by Bishop Kevin Vann as Candidates for, God willing, for ordination to the Diaconate. John and Maggie Lee have been involved in a process of diaconate formation: attending classes several nights a week in subjects such as Old and New Testament Studies, Moral Theology, and learning how to pray the Liturgy of the Hours. They have also participated in one Sunday a month of spiritual formation days, and an annual retreat for the past two and a half years.

Their spiritual formation has centered around whether God is calling them, and specifically John, to service as an ordained deacon for the Diocese of Orange, and again, God willing, for our parish. As candidates, they will continue in a more intense process of discernment of the Holy Spirit. Their classes and formation will continue, and if they are called by the bishop, will be ordained in October, 2023.

John and his wife Maggie have been parishioners of St. Angela since they were married here in 1988. John grew up in Malaysia; Maggie grew up in New Jersey. They met at a Beach Mass here in Southern California. They have been involved in various ministries over the years: Music, Marriage Encounter, Lector, Eucharistic Minister, Bread of Angels, Religious Ed, and RCIA. They are both retired (John was a Family Physician; Maggie was a Software Engineer). They have lived in Fullerton for most of their married life. John enjoys gardening, cooking, and eating; Maggie enjoys reading, baking, and eating; they both love to travel.


