

SUNDAY REFLECTION

There are numerous sayings, Proverbs, popular quote, or whatever we can call them, that remind us what life is all about. For example, we have the refrain that reminds us: "every beginning has an end," and there is the one we have all heard, "Remember that dust you are and to dust you must return." This last one reminds us of our death.

Those of us who live a life a faith and trust fully in God, know our lives begin one day, but won't end when we leave this earth. We know that life and death are a part of our creation, but we are made for an eternity because we are children of God. Though death saddens us it also consoles us because we know Christ Jesus, who died arose from the dead, awaits us, for he left us to go and prepare a place for us: "So that where I am you may be also with me."

In today's responsorial psalm, at the very end we say: "Show us, Lord, the path we are to follow in life, fill me with Joy in your presence and complete happiness next to you." In this psalm prayer we are asking God to form us so we may know how to live and additionally are praying for Joy, not only for a moment, "but unending happiness at your side."

The Joy, the happiness that is the greatest of all while we are in this life, while here on earth, is to be closest to the ones we love, but it is also true that no one except God can grant us his love. For He alone is love, and only he can give us what the heart really wants and ardently desires.

Grants us, we pray, O Lord our God, the constant gladness of being devoted to you. For it is full and lasting happiness to serve the author of all that is good. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, for ever and ever. Amen.

Hay numerosos refranes, proverbios, citas populares, o como podamos llamarlos, que nos recuerdan de qué se trata la vida. Por ejemplo, tenemos el estribillo que nos recuerda: "todo principio tiene un final", y está el que todos hemos escuchado: "Recuerda que polvo eres y al polvo debes volver". Este último nos recuerda nuestra muerte.

Aquellos de nosotros que vivimos una vida con fe y confiamos plenamente en Dios, sabemos que nuestras vidas comienzan un día, pero no terminarán cuando dejemos esta tierra. Sabemos que la vida y la muerte son parte de nuestra creación, pero estamos hechos para una eternidad porque somos hijos de Dios. Aunque la muerte nos entristece, también nos consuela porque sabemos que Cristo Jesús, que murió resucitado de entre los muertos, nos espera, porque nos dejó para ir a prepararnos un lugar: "Para que donde yo estoy, vosotros también estéis conmigo."

En el salmo responsorial de hoy, al final decimos: "Muéstranos, Señor, el camino que debemos seguir en la vida, lléname de alegría en tu presencia y completa felicidad a tu lado". En esta oración del salmo le pedimos a Dios que nos forme para que sepamos cómo vivir y, además, estamos orando por la alegría, no solo por un momento, "sino por la felicidad sin fin a tu lado".

La Alegría, la felicidad que es la mayor de todas mientras estamos en esta vida, mientras estamos aquí en la tierra, es estar más cerca de los que amamos, pero también es cierto que nadie excepto Dios puede otorgarnos su amor. Porque solo Él es amor, y solo Él puede darnos lo que el corazón realmente quiere y desea ardientemente.

Concédenos, te rogamos, oh Señor Dios nuestro, el gozo constante de estar dedicado a ti. Porque es felicidad plena y duradera servir al autor de todo lo bueno. Por nuestro Señor Jesús Chist, tu Hijo, que vive y reina contigo en la unidad del Espíritu Santo, por los siglos de los siglos. Amén.


