

FIRST SUNDAY OF ADVENT

NOVEMBER 28, 2021



SUNDAY REFLECTION

Advent is a time of anticipation and preparation for the coming of our savior Jesus Christ. While anticipation is a psychological and emotional state, preparation is not. However, they are closely related to each other. The excitement of anticipation of the big day to come drives us to a frenetic preparation.

I remember as a kid growing up in Hong Kong, Lunar New Year was the mother of all festivals. Among all the preparations for the Lunar New Year, a few things I remember were these: one month before the big day, dad would drive one and a half hours to the countryside to get a dozen of chickens to bring home to gorge them with food before they were being sacrificed for the festival; among five of us children the floor had to be waxed and windows cleaned; new clothes and shoes were bought only to wear on the New Year Day; women relatives would show up and start making all kinds of cake only served during the New Year. One of the most memorable cakes was called 'saliva cake'. I believed the name came from the way the cake was made. At the end of the flour mixing, once the dough was formed, one had to blow into it to form the shape. I still don't know if that is the original name or not; everybody called this the 'saliva cake' with a straight face. Why all the fuss about the preparation of the New Year? Who and what were we celebrating? There were none. If you ask them, what is it that you celebrate in the Lunar New Year? Most of them would shrug their shoulders and say, the New Year.

As Christians, we do have a who and what to celebrate on Christmas Day. We celebrate the birth of our Lord, Jesus Christ, and the salvation he brought to us. Our preparation in Advent depends on the importance we put on Christ and our salvation. Does this news of salvation excite you to do an elaborate preparation? If the pagan could celebrate something out of nothing in such an elaborate preparation, how much more should we prepare ourselves for Christmas?

Eventually, our enthusiasm to prepare for Christmas depends on our faith. Do we truly believe what it said on the first reading, that God fulfilled the promise he made to Israel that a descendant of David would come to do what is just and right to the world? Do we truly believe when that day comes, whether our own death or the second coming, everyone who lives on the face of the earth will be assaulted as was being said in the gospel? If we believe, shall we beware our hearts do not become drowsy from carousing and drunkenness and the anxiety of daily life?

Recuerdo que cuando era niño y crecía en Hong Kong, el Año Nuevo Lunar era la madre de todos los festivales. Entre todos los preparativos para el Año Nuevo Lunar, algunas cosas que recuerdo fueron estas: un mes antes del gran día, papá conducía una hora y media hasta el campo para conseguir una docena de pollos para llevar a casa y atiborrarlos de comida. antes de que fueran sacrificados para la fiesta; entre cinco de nosotros, los niños, hubo que encerar el piso y limpiar las ventanas; se compraban ropa y zapatos nuevos sólo para usarlos el día de Año Nuevo; las parientes mujeres se presentaban y comenzaban a hacer todo tipo de pasteles que solo se servían durante el Año Nuevo. Uno de los pasteles más memorables se llamó "pastel de saliva". Creí que el nombre provenía de la forma en que se hizo el pastel. Al final de la mezcla de la harina, una vez formada la masa, había que soplar para darle forma. Todavía no sé si ese es el nombre original o no; todo el mundo llamaba a esto el "pastel de saliva" con una cara seria. ¿Por qué tanto alboroto por la preparación del Año Nuevo? ¿Quién y qué estábamos celebrando? No hubo ninguno. Si les preguntas, ¿qué es lo que celebras en el Año Nuevo Lunar? La mayoría de ellos se encogería de hombros y diría: Año Nuevo.

Como cristianos, tenemos un quién y qué celebrar el día de Navidad. Celebramos el nacimiento de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y la salvación que nos trajo. Nuestra preparación en Adviento depende de la importancia que le demos a Cristo y nuestra salvación. ¿Le anima esta noticia de salvación a hacer una preparación elaborada? Si el pagano pudo celebrar algo de la nada en una preparación tan elaborada, ¿cuánto más deberíamos prepararnos para la Navidad?

Finalmente, nuestro entusiasmo por prepararnos para la Navidad depende de nuestra fe. ¿Creemos realmente lo que dijo en la primera lectura, que Dios cumplió la promesa que le hizo a Israel de que un descendiente de David vendría a hacer lo que es justo y recto en el mundo? ¿Creemos de verdad que cuando llegue ese día, ya sea nuestra propia muerte o la segunda venida, todos los que viven sobre la faz de la tierra serán atacados como se dice en el evangelio? Si creemos, ¿debemos tener cuidado de que nuestros corazones no se adormezcan por las juergas, las borracheras y la ansiedad de la vida diaria?




