SUNDAY REFLECTION

Sometimes, when hearing the Gospel of the Widow's Mite, I have wondered if the church uses readings like this to request more money from me. So here we go again. Both the First Reading and the Gospel Reading are about widows who give more than they can afford. Is that what I'm supposed to do? What else am I being

asked to do?

During Mass over the past months, we have heard we are called to something more. We have been hearing Jesus tell us several things: first, we must have the faith of a child, and we must take care of what a child in Jesus' eyes represents: the vulnerable, poor, bereaved, unemployed, victims of domestic violence, physically and mentally challenged. All those who live on the margins.

Second, we are called to serve and not be served. Back to the original question, are we called to give more? Maybe we do need to evaluate how much we give. More importantly however, the Gospel today calls us to look and ponder. Just as Jesus sat "across from the Treasury," watching what people did and how they gave, Jesus calls us to be aware of what's going on around us. Who are the people who need something and what are they in need of? Does someone need to be listened to, or do we know someone who is alone because someone has died or left them? Does an elderly person on our block need someone to go to the store for them?

We are the hands, the ears, and the eyes of God. May we be intentional about how we live out our call to be like Jesus. May we see differently with God's eyes and may we be there for someone who needs to feel God's love and tenderness, even in small ways. May we open our heart to our Lord Jesus, and to all those symbolized by the widow. May we intentionally be Jesus to others.

A veces, al escuchar el Evangelio de la Ácaro de la Viuda, me he preguntado si la iglesia usa lecturas como esta para pedirme más dinero. Aquí vamos de nuevo. Tanto la primera lectura como la lectura del Evangelio tratan sobre viudas que dan más de lo que pueden pagar. ¿Es eso lo que se supone que debo hacer? ¿Qué más se me pide que haga?

Durante la Misa de los últimos meses, hemos escuchado que somos llamados a algo más. Hemos estado escuchando a Jesús decimos varias cosas: primero, debemos tener la fe de un niño, y debemos cuidar lo que representa un niño a los ojos de Jesús: los vulnerables, los pobres, los afligidos, los desempleados, las víctimas de la violencia doméstica, discapacitados físicos y mentales. Todos los que viven en los márgenes.

En segundo lugar, estamos llamados a servir y no a ser servidos. Volviendo a la pregunta original, ¿estamos llamados a dar más? Quizás necesitemos evaluar cuánto damos. Sin embargo, lo que es más importante, el Evangelio de hoy nos llama a mirar y reflexionar. Así como Jesús se sentó "frente al Tesoro", observando lo que la gente hacía y cómo daban, Jesús nos llama a ser conscientes de lo que sucede a nuestro alrededor. ¿Quiénes son las personas que necesitan algo y qué necesitan? ¿Alguien necesita ser escuchado, o conocemos a alguien que está solo porque alguien ha muerto o lo ha dejado? ¿Necesita una persona mayor de nuestra cuadra que alguien vaya a la tienda a buscarla?

Somos las manos, los oídos y los ojos de Dios. Que seamos intencionales acerca de cómo vivimos nuestro llamado a ser como Jesús. Que podamos ver de manera diferente con los ojos de Dios y que estemos allí para alguien que necesita sentir el amor y la ternura de Dios, incluso en pequeñas formas. Que abramos nuestro corazón a nuestro Señor Jesús y a todos los simbolizados por la viuda. Que seamos intencionalmente Jesús para los demás.

TABLE OF REMEMBRANCE




You know what...you convinced me. I've been attending this church for years and finally I have decided to join the choir!!




