

THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

DECEMBER 12, 2021



SUNDAY REFLECTION

A famous rabbi, who held high office, said, 'If anyone had said to me before I entered high office, "Assume that office," my only wish would have been to hound him to death. But now that I have entered high office, if anyone were to tell me, "Give it up," I would pour a kettle of boiling water on his head.' High office is hard to rise to, but even harder to give up. There is an example of this in the Bible, "When Saul was told, "Rise to kingship," he ran away and hid. When the Israelites had been told Saul was to be their king, they went looking for him, but couldn't find him. But then they were told he was hiding among the baggage (1 Sam 10:22). Saul duly anointed king. When years later he was told, "give up the kingship," and David was to be his successor, he pursued David to kill him.

It is not easy to make way for another person. It's harder still to give up your place to him and let him take over. This is what John the Baptist did. He said about Jesus, "I am not worthy to loosen the thongs of his sandals. I baptize you with water but He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire."

This Sunday is Gaudete (Rejoice) Sunday. The readings today reflect on God's presence on earth. In the first reading from Zephaniah, the prophet addresses people in Jerusalem who were suffering, exclaiming to them to shout for joy because "the Lord is in your midst." In the second reading, Paul reminds the community to rejoice because God is near. The Gospel told us to bring joy into the world by living morally and emulating God. In Luke, John the Baptist preaches on how to live righteously, calling for sharing with one another. While baptizing people, John tells them to share their blessings with people who have less. To the tax collectors, he asked them not to collect more than is required. To the soldiers, he told them not to practice extortion, do not falsely accuse anyone, and be satisfied with their wages. We are joyful because the Lord is coming and like the people after listening to John's preaching were filled with expectation, and we were all asking in our hearts whether "joy to the world" is realistic or not. It could be realistic if we heed the voice of John the Baptist to share our power, financial resources and spiritual richness of our faith with one another.

Un rabino famoso, que ocupaba un alto cargo, dijo: "Si alguien me hubiera dicho antes de que yo entrara en el alto cargo," Asume ese cargo ", mi único deseo habría sido matarlo. Pero ahora que he llegado a un alto cargo, si alguien me dijera: "Ríndete", le vertiría una tetera con agua hirviendo en la cabeza '. Es difícil llegar al alto cargo, pero aún más difícil renunciar. Hay un ejemplo de esto en la Biblia: "Cuando se le dijo a Saúl: " Levántate a la realeza ", se escapó y se escondió. Cuando se les dijo a los israelitas que Saúl sería su rey, fueron a buscarlo, pero no pudieron encontrarlo. Pero luego les dijeron que estaba escondido entre el equipaje (1 Sam 10:22). Saúl debidamente ungido rey. Cuando años más tarde le dijeron que "renunciara a la realeza" y que David sería su sucesor, persiguió a David para matarlo.

No es fácil dejar paso a otra persona. Es aún más difícil cederle su lugar y dejar que él se haga cargo. Esto es lo que hizo Juan el Bautista. De Jesús dijo: "No soy digno de desatar las correas de sus sandalias. Yo los bautizo en agua, pero Él los bautizará con Espíritu Santo y fuego ".

Este domingo es el domingo de Gaudete (Regocijate). Las lecturas de hoy reflejan la presencia de Dios en la tierra. En la primera lectura de Sofonías, el profeta se dirige a las personas que sufrían en Jerusalén y les grita que griten de alegría porque "el Señor está en medio de ustedes". En la segunda lectura, Pablo recuerda a la comunidad que se regocije porque Dios está cerca. El Evangelio nos dijo que trajéramos gozo al mundo viviendo moralmente y emulando a Dios. En Lucas, Juan el Bautista predica sobre cómo vivir con rectitud, llamando a compartir unos con otros. Mientras bautiza a las personas, Juan les dice que comparten sus bendiciones con las personas que tienen menos. A los recaudadores de impuestos les pidió que no recaudaran más de lo requerido. A los soldados les dijo que no practicaran la extorsión, que no acusaran falsamente a nadie y que se conformaran con su salario. Estamos gozosos porque el Señor viene y, al igual que la gente después de escuchar la predicación de Juan, se llenó de expectación, y todos estábamos preguntando en nuestro corazón si el "gozo del mundo" es realista o no. Podría ser realista si escuchamos la voz de Juan el Bautista para compartir nuestro poder, recursos financieros y la riqueza espiritual de nuestra fe entre nosotros.


