

## SUNDAY REFLECTION

A few days ago, we found the Virgin Mary, mother of Jesus, in a situation where she is carrying out disinterested service. Her cousin Elizabeth, a woman who is advanced in age but nevertheless will be mother of John the Baptist. John the Baptist with the mission to prepare the people to receive Jesus, as announced by the prophets and expected for so long by so many. In the powerful emotional occasion between these two women, there are words that stand out, from Elizabeth to her cousin Mary: "Blessed are you amongst Women, but who am I that the mother of my Lord should come to me?"

What is Elizabeth saying here? She is referring to the anointed one of God, the One announced by the prophets, who will come on the appointed day to save and redeem his people, and from them will come Mary his mother. We receive from Mary, the mother of Jesus, a great lesson of charity for her cousin, we also learn to admire the joy John shows in the womb of his mother in the presence of Jesus, who Mary carries in her womb.

To contemplate these two women shall serve as an invitation for us as people devoted to Mary, to help us to become her imitators, happy, joyful, and selfless servants. To be ready with kindness and gentleness towards those who suffer great difficulties, and who need compassion, understanding and kindness.

As Christmas, ever closer, help us feel we are daughters and sons of God, and may we live as true children, feeling a closer bond of brotherhood. My brothers and sisters as we're getting close to celebrating the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ, with all those who surround us all day, principally the helpless and lonely, let us ask ourselves what gift can we give our Lord Jesus to help us to be better Christians and disciples of our Lord Jesus Christ. From the bottom of my heart, I wish you all to have a merry Christmas and a happy new year. Blessings for you all and your families.




