SUNDAY REFLECTION

In describing the relationship between God and his people Israel, the scriptures use the image of a bridegroom and his bride. God was the bridegroom and Israel the bride, especially in the book of the prophet Isaiah that we listen to this Sunday. The prophet was writing this passage at one of the lowest moments in the history of Israel. The people were being exiled to Babylon and Jerusalem lay in ruins. He compared Israel then like a widow bereft of children. But the prophet has a message of hope for the people: God, her husband, has not forgotten her. There will be a new wedding feast. This promise was fulfilled in the return from exile, but more so in the coming of Jesus, the Messiah.

John seems to pick up this idea from the prophet about the new wedding feast by introducing how Jesus began his public ministry at a wedding feast. At that wedding the wine ran out. This was a way of saying that the time has come for the promises to be fulfilled. A new law and a new spirit are at hand. All those who tasted the new wine agreed that it was better than the old.

The role of Mary in the wedding feast of Cana is depicted in John's gospel as the model of ministry. Mary noticed that the wine had run out, threatening to ruin the happy occasion of the bride and groom. She wanted to help but realized that she could not do it herself. So, she turned to her son and asked him to help. Some of us startle at how Jesus responded to Mary and called his mother woman. But as scholars have been telling us from the beginning, Mary played the role as the new Eve. Jesus refers to Mary as woman is to hint that what God has promised in Genesis is to be fulfilled: God will put enmity between Satan and the woman, and her offspring shall bruise your head. Mary was sensitive to the need of others, that is the ministry of us as Jesus' disciple like Mary. Furthermore, Mary did not just appear at the beginning of Jesus' ministry, she was also at the end by the cross on Calvary. She stood at the foot of the cross, watching Jesus die.

As the disciples of Jesus, at what stage do we appear in Jesus' ministry?

Al describir la relación entre Dios y su pueblo Israel, las Escrituras usan la imagen de un novio y su novia. Dios era el novio e Israel la novia especialmente en el libro del profeta Isaías que escuchamos este domingo. El profeta estaba escribiendo este pasaje en uno de los momentos más bajos de la historia de Israel. El pueblo estaba siendo exiliado a Babilonia y Jerusalén estaba en ruinas. Entonces comparó a Israel como una viuda privada de hijos. Pero el profeta tiene un mensaje de esperanza para el pueblo: Dios, su esposo, no se ha olvidado de ella. Habrá una nueva fiesta de bodas. Esta promesa se cumplió en el regreso del exilio, pero más especialmente en la venida de Jesús, el Mesías.

Juan parece tomar esta idea del profeta sobre la nueva fiesta de bodas al presentar que Jesús comenzó su ministerio público en una fiesta de bodas. En esa boda se acabó el vino. Esta era una forma de decir que ha llegado el momento de que se cumplan las promesas. Una nueva ley y un nuevo espíritu están a la mano. Todos los que probaron el vino nuevo coincidieron en que era mejor que el añejo.

El papel de María en las bodas de Caná se representa en el evangelio de Juan como modelo de ministerio. Mary notó que el vino se había acabado, amenazando con arruinar la feliz ocasión de los novios. Quería ayudar, pero se dio cuenta de que no podía hacerlo sola. Entonces, se volvió hacia su hijo y le pidió ayuda. Algunos de nosotros nos sorprendemos en cómo Jesús respondió a María y llamó a su madre mujer. Pero como los eruditos nos han estado diciendo, María desde el principio desempeñó el papel de la nueva Eva. Jesús se refiere a María como mujer para insinuar que se cumplirá lo que Dios ha prometido en Génesis: Dios pondrá enemistad entre Satanás y la mujer, y su descendencia te herirá en la cabeza. María fue sensible a la necesidad de los demás, ese es el ministerio de nosotros como discípulos de Jesús como María. Además, María no solo apareció al comienzo del ministerio de Jesús, también estuvo al final junto a la cruz en el Calvario. Se paró al pie de la cruz, viendo morir a Jesús.

Como discípulos de Jesús, ¿en qué etapa aparecemos en el ministerio de Jesús?






