

SUNDAY REFLECTION

In the gospel reading, we hear about the people in Jesus' hometown refusing to accept Him as a prophet. Because of their lack of faith, Jesus was unable to reveal He is God. In the first reading, we hear Jeremiah, a prophet of God was also rejected by his contemporaries.

Who is a prophet? A prophet is a person who speaks the word of God and is chosen by God. Through the grace of our Christian baptism, we are incorporated into God's divine life, and thus we were anointed as priest, prophet, and king. All baptized Christians are chosen to be prophets for God. There have been many reluctant prophets in the Holy Scriptures, including the Prophet Jeremiah in today's first reading who had complained to God that he was too young to be a prophet. Are we any different from the Prophet Jeremiah? In the first reading we hear, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born, I dedicated you, a prophet to the nations I appointed you." Do I speak publicly about my Christian faith? Prophets get into a lot of trouble when they speak the word of God. Look at Jesus, our supreme Prophet, who was persecuted and nailed to a cross because of His prophetic message of love.

The reading from St Paul offers an important balanced perspective to the lessons on persecution from the first reading and Gospel. In the face of persecution, it is easy to become bitter, self-righteous, and hateful toward the persecutors. The challenge for the Christian is to learn to suffer persecution while still practicing and showing love. The readings for this Sunday call us to face persecution with courage, knowing that persecution is the mark of a true prophet. Those who share Christ's prophetic role through Baptism cannot hope to avoid persecution in this life. At the same time, we cannot give in to hatred, bitterness, and self-righteousness. Unlike the people of Nazareth, we have to practice love and remember that the good news is for all people, not our personal possession. God will judge us at the end of time by the way we have loved since God is Love. Love is the standard by which we will be measured. As we pray and meditate on today's readings, let us pray to the Holy Spirit to continue to teach us how to speak of God's love daily.

En la lectura del evangelio, escuchamos acerca de la gente en la ciudad natal de Jesús que se niega a aceptarlo como profeta. Debido a su falta de fe, Jesús no pudo revelar que Él es Dios. En la primera lectura, escuchamos a Jeremías, un profeta de Dios también rechazado por sus contemporáneos. ¿Quién es un profeta? Un profeta es una persona que habla la palabra de Dios y es escogida por Dios. Por la gracia de nuestro bautismo cristiano, somos incorporados a la vida divina de Dios, y así fuimos ungidos como sacerdote, profeta y rey. Todos los cristianos bautizados son elegidos para ser profetas de Dios. Ha habido muchos profetas reacios en las Sagradas Escrituras, incluido el profeta Jeremías en la primera lectura de hoy, quien se había quejado ante Dios de que era demasiado joven para ser profeta. ¿Somos diferentes del profeta Jeremías? En la primera lectura escuchamos: "Antes de formarte en el vientre te conocí, antes de que nacieras te dediqué, profeta a las naciones te nombré". ¿Hablo públicamente de mi fe cristiana? Los profetas se meten en muchos problemas cuando hablan la palabra de Dios. Miren a Jesús, nuestro Profeta supremo, quien fue perseguido y clavado en una cruz por Su mensaje profético de amor. La lectura de San Pablo ofrece una importante perspectiva equilibrada de las lecciones sobre la persecución de la primera lectura y el Evangelio. Frente a la persecución, es fácil volverse amargado, farisaico y odioso hacia los perseguidores. El desafío para el cristiano es aprender a sufrir la persecución sin dejar de practicar y mostrar el amor. Las lecturas de este domingo nos llaman a enfrentar la persecución con valentía, sabiendo que la persecución es la marca de un verdadero profeta. Aquellos que comparten el papel profético de Cristo a través del bautismo no pueden esperar evitar la persecución en esta vida. Al mismo tiempo, no podemos ceder al odio, la amargura y la justicia propia. A diferencia de la gente de Nazaret, tenemos que practicar el amor y recordar que las buenas nuevas son para todas las personas, no para nuestra posesión personal. Dios nos juzgará al final de los tiempos por la forma en que hemos amado desde que Dios es Amor. El amor es el estándar por el cual seremos medidos.

Mientras oramos y meditamos en las lecturas de hoy, oremos al Espíritu Santo para que continúe enseñándonos cómo hablar del amor de Dios todos los días.

St. Angela Merici OPERATION RICE BOWL-2022

Operation Rice Bowl is coming to St Angela's for Lent.

- When: **Sunday February 27** after all Masses.
- Set the bowl in the kitchen or dining table as a daily reminder.
- Use the bowls during Lent to set aside your alms.



Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with

a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.



Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council and PALS.



Turn bowls in with alms collected on **Sunday May 1st** (or write a check to **Catholic Relief Services(CRS)** for the amount in the bowl).
