# SUNDAY REFLECTION

It was not all that long ago when diabetes was a killer disease for which there was no cure. Then insulin was discovered, and suddenly sufferers were given back hope. Insulin does not stop people from getting diabetes, nor does it get rid of the anguish it causes. However, it does take the sting of death out of the disease for sufferers because they know there is hope. This makes a huge difference between life and death for the sufferers for now they only have to learn to live with it.

The ultimate fear of humankind has always been death. In the second reading of this Sunday, St. Paul talks about the sting of death: *Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting? St. Paul did not avoid these two difficult questions which is truly only one. It is the victory of death that gives out its sting. The death is victorious because of sin, Paul said. However, there is an antidote for most things like insulin for diabetes. The antidote for the sting of death is Jesus Christ through his death and resurrection. He overcomes the power of sin by not condemning us. However, there is a big 'but' behind this phrase; we don't condemn others.*

This Sunday's gospel begins with Chapter 6: 39, Jesus made a few examples by not judging others. It precedes by verse 37 and 38 from last Sunday gospel: "Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven."

The antidote for the sting of death is there. But would we be willing to take it?

No fue hace tanto tiempo cuando la diabetes era una enfermedad mortal para la que no había cura. Luego se descubrió la insulina y, de repente, a los pacientes se les devolvió la esperanza. La insulina no evita que las personas desarrollen diabetes, ni elimina la angustia que causa. Sin embargo, elimina el aguijón de la muerte de la enfermedad para quienes la padecen porque saben que hay esperanza. Esto marca una gran diferencia entre la vida y la muerte para quienes lo padecen, ya que ahora solo tienen que aprender a vivir con ello.

El último temor de la humanidad siempre ha sido la muerte. En la segunda lectura de este domingo, san Pablo habla del aguijón de la muerte: ¿Dónde está, oh muerte, tu victoria? ¿Dónde, oh muerte, está tu aguijón? San Pablo no eludió estas dos difíciles cuestiones que en verdad es una sola. Es la victoria de la muerte la que da su aguijón. La muerte es victoriosa a causa del pecado, dijo Pablo. Sin embargo, existe un antídoto para la mayoría de las cosas, como la insulina para la diabetes. El antídoto para el aguijón de la muerte es Jesucristo a través de su muerte y resurrección. Él vence el poder del pecado al no condenarnos. Sin embargo, hay un gran 'pero' detrás de esta frase; no condenamos a los demás.

El evangelio de este domingo comienza con el capítulo 6: 39, Jesús hizo algunos ejemplos al no juzgar a los demás. Le precede el versículo 37 y 38 del evangelio del domingo pasado: "Dejad de juzgar y no seréis juzgados. Deja de condenar y no serás condenado. Perdona, y serás perdonado."

El antídoto para el aguijón de la muerte está ahí. Pero, ¿estaríamos dispuestos a aceptarlo?

## ST. ANGELA MERICI OPERATION RICE BOWL 2022

Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.

Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council and PALS.

Turn bowls in with alms collected on **Sunday, May 1** (or write a check to **Catholic Relief Services (CRS)** for the amount in the bowl).


