

SUNDAY REFLECTION

Last week's reflection was written by Mr. John Lee, a member with his wife, Maggie, of our parish and a candidate for Ordination to the Diaconate. John and Maggie have been in discernment of a call to the Diaconate for almost three years. It is exciting and wonderful to see and experience John and Maggie during this time as they listen to our Lord Jesus. One way or another, they are discerning what God's call is in their lives. They are our brother and sister; let's walk with them and pray deeply for them as they journey into deeper waters with the Lord Jesus.

In our Gospel today, Jesus calls Peter, James, and John to a radically different life, being fishers of people. This is a story of failure, fright, trust, and following God's call in OUR lives. Simon and the others' doubt, that going back out into deeper waters will amount to anything is real, yet at Jesus' word, they go. Once they see the incredible catch, they fear the power of this man before them and they want out, they don't want to be there. Jesus knows their giftedness (that God had already given them before the world began) and trusts in them. He tells them, as he does so often in their lives and in ours, "do not be afraid." Jesus invites them to follow him, and they leave everything.

We come from many backgrounds; many of us are married, many have been married and because of death or divorce, are now single and alone. Many are students or already working at least at one job or more to simply survive. Some have families to take care of and/or taking care of their elderly parents. Whatever the case, Jesus calls us to live radically. Passing on our faith not only to our children, or even our parents, but to all we meet by how we live our lives is no easy task. Yet our Lord is with us, never leaving our side. He urges us on. Will we follow Him, will we sacrifice for Him? This is the question for us today. May we continue to answer His call to serve others by our lives. May we ask God's help at Mass today to enable us to feel His presence when the road is tough. With Him, may we put out into deep waters.

La reflexión de la semana pasada fue escrita por el Sr. John Lee, un miembro con su esposa, Maggie, de nuestra parroquia y es candidato para la Ordenación al Diaconado. John y Maggie han estado en discernimiento de un llamado al diaconado durante casi tres años. Es emocionante y maravilloso ver y experimentar a John y Maggie durante este tiempo mientras escuchan a nuestro Señor Jesús. De una forma u otra, están discerniendo cuál es el llamado de Dios en sus vidas. Ellos son nuestro hermano y hermana; caminemos con ellos y oremos profundamente por ellos mientras viajan a aguas más profundas con el Señor Jesús.

En nuestro Evangelio de hoy, Jesús llama a Pedro, Santiago y Juan a una vida radicalmente diferente, siendo pescadores de personas. Esta es una historia de fracaso, miedo, confianza y seguimiento del llamado de Dios en NUESTRAS vidas. Simón y los demás dudan de que regresar a aguas más profundas equivalga a algo real, pero a la palabra de Jesús, van. Una vez que ven la captura increíble, temen el poder de este hombre frente a ellos y quieren salir, no quieren estar allí. Jesús conoce sus dones (que Dios ya les había dado antes de que el mundo comenzara) y confía en eso. Él les dice, como lo hace tantas veces en sus vidas y en las nuestras, "no tengan miedo". Jesús los invita a seguirlo y lo dejan todo.

Venimos de muchos orígenes; muchos de nosotros estamos casados, muchos han estado casados y por muerte o divorcio, ahora estamos solteros y solos. Muchos son estudiantes o ya tienen al menos un trabajo o más para sobrevivir. Algunos tienen familias que cuidar o están cuidando a sus padres ancianos. En cualquier caso, Jesús nos llama a vivir radicalmente. Transmitir nuestra fe no solo a nuestros hijos o incluso a nuestros padres, sino a todos los que conocemos por la forma en que vivimos nuestras vidas no es una tarea fácil. Sin embargo, nuestro Señor está con nosotros, nunca se aparta de nuestro lado. Él nos insta a seguir. ¿Lo seguiremos, nos sacrificaremos por él? Esta es la pregunta para nosotros hoy. Que sigamos respondiendo a Su llamado de servir a los demás con nuestras vidas. Pidamos la ayuda de Dios en la Misa de hoy para que podamos sentir Su presencia cuando el camino sea difícil. Con Él, podemos navegar en aguas profundas.

Operation Rice Bowl is coming to St Angela's for Lent.

- When: **Sunday February 27** after all Masses.
- Set the bowl in the kitchen or dining table as a daily reminder.
- Use the bowls during Lent to set aside your alms.



Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with

a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.




