SUNDAY REFLECTION

Fasting from food, feeding on the Bible During Lent

Right about now, most of us are asking ourselves, "what are we giving up for Lent?" "Giving up" usually means food which is in keeping with the church's ancient practice of fasting. As we have grown up, fasting is extended to things like giving up "things" such as TV or social media. Fasting is seen as doing penance for sin as well as being united with Jesus who spent 40 days fasting in the desert as we see in today's Gospel reading.

We must fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, having one full meal and a second meal that isn't as large as the first. We are also to abstain from meat on these two days and every Friday during Lent. We are encouraged to fast during the whole of Lent. We should, of course, make a commitment to giving up things we should not be doing anyway: smoking, eating junk food, drinking too much alcohol, gossiping, judging others, acts of anger. Doing something, rather than giving up something, is also an option: regular exercise for many people, especially me, is certainly a penance.

Fasting is only one way to observe tradition. You can choose to be nourished by the Word of God. The readings from everyday Mass were especially chosen during Lent to educate those who wanted to be Catholic. These daily readings were the original catechism of the Catholic Church. Ideally, the best way to hear these readings would be to go to daily Mass, but many of us aren't able to do this. The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has the daily Mass readings on their website: usccb.org under "Daily Readings." Using the podcast, "New American Bible or NAB," you can listen to the readings while commuting or walking.

The word "Lent" means "spring," a time for renewal and new birth. Along with the sacraments, it is the Scriptures that renew us and give new life to the Christian Community. Whether you read or listen, the Word of God is essential to the Christian life. This is something to do for Lent.

Ayuno de comida, alimentándose de la Biblia durante la Cuaresma

En este momento, la mayoría de nosotros nos preguntamos, "¿a qué estamos renunciando por la Cuaresma?" "Renunciar" generalmente significa comida que está de acuerdo con la antigua práctica de ayuno de la iglesia. A medida que crecimos, el ayuno se extiende a cosas como renunciar a "cosas" como la televisión o las redes sociales. Se considera que ayunar hace penitencia por el pecado, además de estar unido a Jesús, quien pasó 40 días ayunando en el desierto, como vemos en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy.

Debemos ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo, con una comida completa y una segunda comida que no sea tan grande como la primera. También debemos abstenernos de comer carne en estos dos días y todos los viernes durante la Cuaresma. Se nos anima a ayunar durante toda la Cuaresma. Por supuesto, debemos comprometernos a renunciar a cosas que no deberíamos estar haciendo de todos modos: fumar, comer comida chatarra, beber demasiado alcohol, chismear, juzgar a los demás, actos de ira. Hacer algo, en lugar de renunciar a algo, también es una opción: el ejercicio regular para muchas personas, especialmente para mí, es ciertamente una penitencia.

El ayuno es solo una forma de observar la tradición. Puedes elegir ser nutrido por la Palabra de Dios. Las lecturas de la Misa diaria se eligieron especialmente durante la Cuaresma para educar a aquellos que querían ser católicos. Estas lecturas diarias fueron el catecismo original de la Iglesia Católica. Idealmente, la mejor manera de escuchar estas lecturas sería ir a misa todos los días, pero muchos de nosotros no podemos hacerlo. La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos tiene las lecturas diarias de la Misa en su sitio web: usccb.org bajo "Lecturas diarias". Usando el podcast, "Nueva Biblia Americana o NAB", puede escuchar las lecturas mientras viaja o camina.

La palabra "Cuaresma" significa "primavera", un tiempo de renovación y nuevo nacimiento. Junto con los sacramentos, son las Escrituras las que nos renuevan y dan nueva vida a la comunidad cristiana. Ya sea que lea o escuche, la Palabra de Dios es esencial para la vida cristiana. Esto es algo que hacer para la Cuaresma.

ST. ANGELA MERICI OPERATION RICE BOWL 2022

Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.

Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council and PALS.

Turn bowls in with alms collected on **Sunday, May 1** (or write a check to **Catholic Relief Services (CRS)** for the amount in the bowl).





Consecration to the Holy Family to be celebrated the first Sunday of Lent –

Join us in prayer at each mass THIS WEEKEND

Families today face many struggles, both through cultural pressure and through the personal struggles that accompany family life. Despite these struggles — and partly as a result of conquering them — families have great capacity for love and joy, a joy that is strengthened through the peace and truth found in Christ. To assist families in living out this joy of Christ, Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori has composed a prayer through which families may come together to consecrate themselves under the protection of the Holy Family. We invite every family of our parish to engage in the Consecration to the Holy Family.

How to Prepare

The word consecration literally means “association with the sacred”, and as such it requires a much larger commitment than simply reciting a prayer off of a card. To receive the full benefit of intercession from the Holy Family, one must cleanse the body, mind and soul. The decision to consecrate your family needs to be intentional and a process through which you completely surrender to God through the Holy Family. You are accepting the truth that salvation history was changed forever by a family, and that through your domestic church, you are called to live their example

In the week leading up to this event each family is encouraged to:

- ◆ Have each family member receive the sacrament of reconciliation.
- ◆ As a family, intentionally choose something to fast from. The fast can be for at least a week. As our physical bodies are drawn to things of the world, it is strongly encouraged that you fast from something that you would normally do or consume. Fasting helps to discipline our minds and hearts to refrain from secular activities and be more focused on God.
- ◆ Prepare for the commitment you are making. Consecration to the Holy Family is not a single event. You have chosen a way of life for your family. You and your family are consciously choosing to be a beacon of light of God’s love through his Church.
