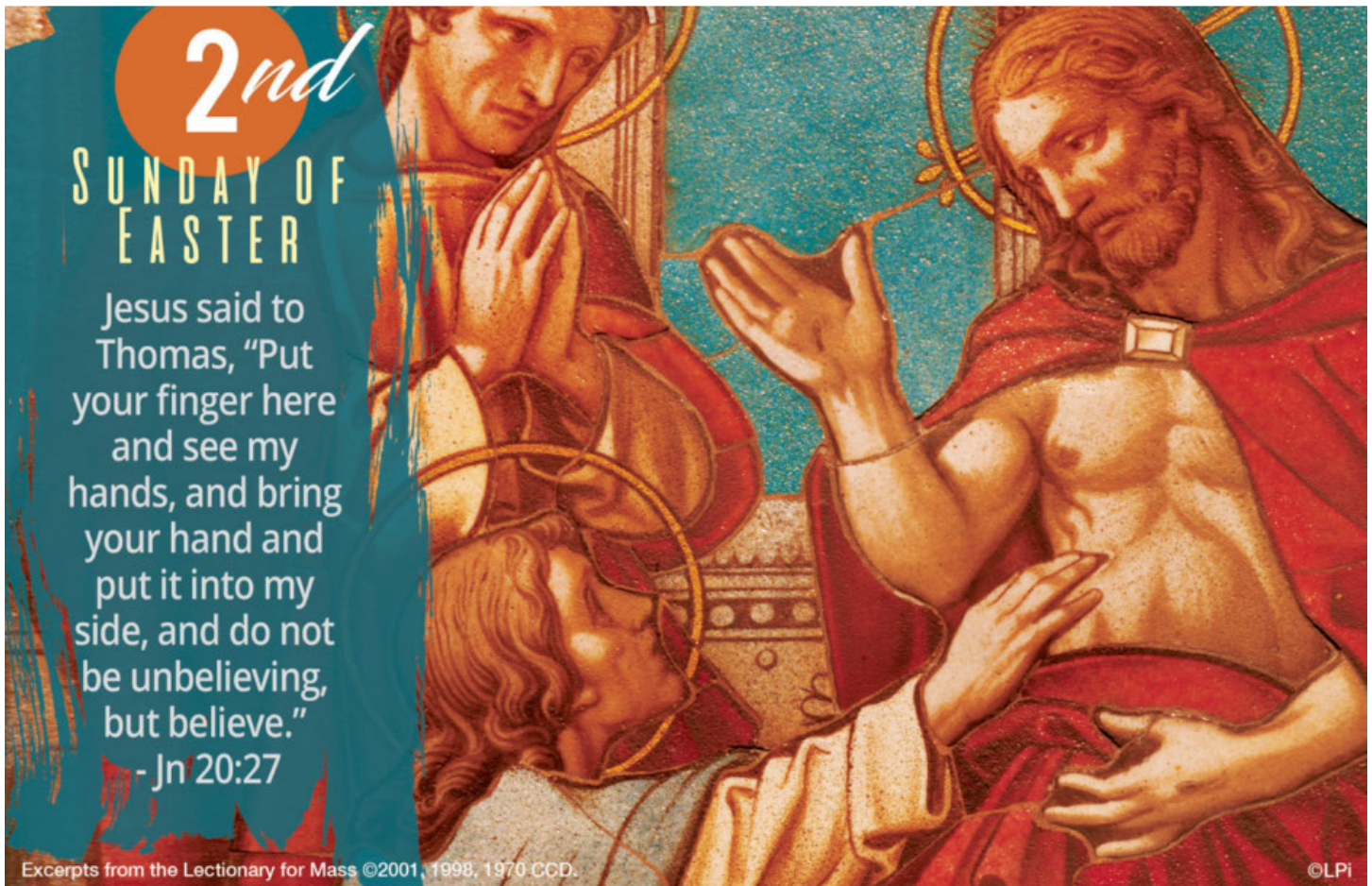

THE MERCY OF GOD IS ETERNAL

This second Sunday in the Easter season is also known as the Sunday of Divine Mercy. The Risen Jesus, who lives forever, gives to his disciples the power to forgive sins, and helps us to achieve this peace from being at peace with God. The peace Jesus gives us is unique and incomparable. The serenity that emanates from him make us all happy, content, positive, and active in carrying out what God wants from us. For what the Gospel says to us today is the peace he gives us through his apostles, has no price, cannot be measure, and most importantly, only those who receive it and feel it, can really show it by their deeds.

God grants space only to those who admit their sinfulness and repent. Only they can be healed and freed from their faults. Jesus said to his disciples: "those who are humble and whose hearts seek and accepts him will have their sins forgiven." OPERATION RICE BOWL

Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.

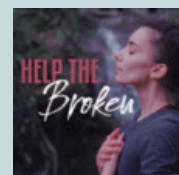
Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council and PALS.

NEW CHURCH CROSS

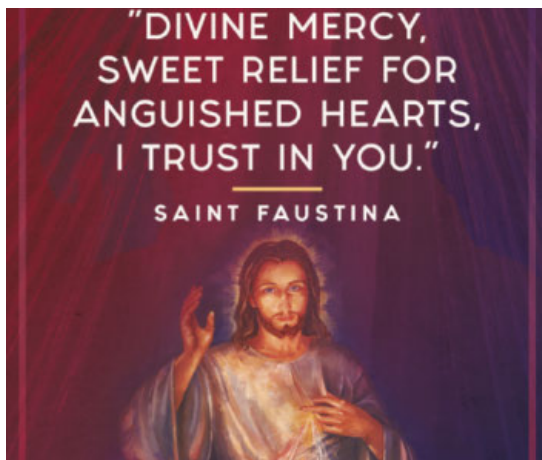
Our new Cross is currently under construction. Thank you to everyone who has helped in this process! We look forward to seeing the final result in the next few months!



NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PROTECTION MONTH

Did you know...What is happening in the diocese to protect children?

- + Training is provided for all adults and youth to identify warning signs and develop strategies for maintaining a safe environment for all.
- + A designated Victim Assistance Coordinator is available to receive reports and accompany victims through their journey.
- + A volunteer independent Review Board assists the bishop in the review of cases and makes recommendations for moving forward.
- + A Safe Environment Coordinator assists parish and school personnel with training and background screenings for anyone who may have access to children.
- + An audit is conducted by an independent firm to evaluate implementation of the Charter for the + Protection of Children and Young People. Findings are incorporated with those of other dioceses and made available in an Annual Report.

LEADING OTHERS TO CATHOLICISM

Question:

My neighbor is just beginning to explore the Catholic faith but was raised agnostic. I grew up believing in God, praying, and attending Mass. How does one start from scratch as an adult to develop a relationship with God?

Answer:

Start on a personal level! How did you and your neighbor become friends? How did you begin to discuss such a personal topic as faith? Communication, spending time together, and getting to know each other are essential to forming the bonds of a relationship. Personal prayer is essential to our relationship with God. We can't be close to someone we don't know! Invite your friend to explore the stories of Jesus in the Bible. Introduce them to the lives of the saints, especially ones you think they might be interested in.

Your neighbor might also have questions about the Catholic faith that you don't know how to answer. If your friend hasn't yet enrolled in RCIA classes, invite them to Mass at your parish. Introduce your friend to the faith formation director to make a connection. Personal support can be helpful as well, especially if few of your neighbor's current friends are practicing their faith. Connect your neighbor to other people in your parish living their faith well. The good examples of other faithful people could help your neighbor to feel welcomed and supported.
