

# SUNDAY REFLECTION

## EASTER SUNDAY

Alleluia! The exclamation rings out across the land, and we who are disciples of Jesus Christ pause to reflect on the reality that he rose from the grave and, in turn, conquered death. In today's colleges and universities, in pulpits of every denomination, and in books and journals, there are those who say it is unimportant whether or not he really rose from the dead. They say that the facts do not impact the moral of the story. Of course, two thousand years of Christianity give evidence that they are incorrect. What the faithful of many generations have experienced and given testimony to is not something built on an idea. It is not a philosophy or a self-help psychology.

The church is a direct result of real events in the course of human history. Without those real events, we simply follow a man who showed us a different way to live. Instead, we follow a God who emptied himself into a human form, suffered the pain of torture and death at the hands of those he had created, and then shattered the chains of death so that we in our human form may follow suit. Today, humanity is redeemed. It is time to face the facts!



Pongamos mucha atención en la secuencia que se proclama en este día y busquemos como María Magdalena al Señor: “*¿Qué has visto en la mañana, María, en la mañana?*”. “*A mi Señor glorioso, la tumba abandonada, los ángeles testigos, sudarios y mortajas. ¡Resucitó de veras mi amor y mi esperanza!*”. Corramos presurosos a buscarlo resucitado en la familia, en la escuela, en el trabajo, en los inmigrantes, en los enfermos, y lo más importante, en nuestro propio corazón. El Ángel también anima a las mujeres al llegar a la tumba: “*Ustedes no tienen por qué temer. Yo sé que buscan a Jesús, que fue crucificado. No está aquí, pues ha resucitado, tal como lo había anunciado*” (Mateo 28:5-6). “*Esta es la culminación del Evangelio, es la Buena Noticia por excelencia: Jesús, el crucificado ha resucitado. Este acontecimiento es la base de nuestra fe y de nuestra esperanza. Jesús, el Amor encarnado, murió en la cruz por nuestros pecados, pero Dios lo resucitó y lo ha constituido Señor de la vida y de la muerte*” (Papa Francisco). ¡Aleluya, Aleluya, Aleluya!

## ST. ANGELA MERICI OPERATION RICE BOWL 2022

Rice Bowl is a way of supporting the Lenten period of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. The simple bowl is a reminder of our care for each other and the less fortunate in the world. Lenten alms donated through CRS Rice Bowl support the work of CRS in more than 100 different countries each year. CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families; this simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with a Lenten calendar guiding families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories. More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl". In 1976, it was adopted by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program.

Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council and PALS.

Turn bowls in with alms collected on **Sunday, May 1** (or write a check to **Catholic Relief Services (CRS)** for the amount in the bowl).

Did you know... Child abuse comes in many forms. Most people identify child abuse as physically hitting a child. Neglect is also a form of abuse. Failing to provide a child with proper nutrition, housing and supervision can cause irreparable harm.

Expectations that a child be an active participant in the care of home and family, or even age-appropriate jobs is a part of healthy development. But excessive demands can cross into a form of servitude that is beyond the societal norms. Child pornography is a form of sexual abuse, with real victims in every image. The viewing of these images is an offence against the human dignity.


