FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR THE SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

Meister Eckhart asks, "Who is the man whose prayers God always hears?" He answers, "God hears the man who appeals to God as God. When, however, man appeals to God, hoping for some worldly good, he is not appealing to God at all, but to what he is asking of God. He is trying to make God his servant. On this point, St. Augustine says: 'You pray to what you love, for true whole prayer is nothing but love!' Thus, we pray to what we love, and no one rightly prays to God but he who prays for God and has nothing on his mind but God." We struggle with what we want God to do and how we want our prayer validated. Meister Eckhart is correct. We often want God to be our servant. We further struggle with trusting that God knows what we need and that His will is best.

God's will is not some predetermined outcome of events that we must simply suggest. "Thy will be done" is not an invocation beckoning us to accept a particular state of affairs passively. Rather, it is the humble and confident placement of ourselves in the presence of the God we seek, whom we call "Father." We must remember that God is the God of life and light. It is from nothing that God brings something and from the darkness that God brings life. Prayer allows us to seek the One we love with the assurance that all will be well regardless of what course the events of our lives take. God is not about passive submission but the humble trust of love.

That's what makes the Lord's Prayer the perfect prayer. It provides us with proper disposition and focus, putting in line all of the essential relationships of our lives. It celebrates and fosters the ever-deepening relationship of trust we have with our Creator. It also calls us to keep open the doors of love between our brothers and sisters with the power that comes with forgiveness. If in one's darkest hour they can find the resolve to fervently pray this perfect prayer of Jesus' conviction, then there is no doubt that God will hear their plea, reach out in love, and bring them ever closer to His heart. What more does one need to weather the storms of life besides faith, hope, and love? These are God's most perfect gifts and all we really need.

REFLEXIÓN PARA 17º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

A lo largo de servir en el ministerio de la catequesis, muchas personas me han preguntado: ¿Cuál es la mejor manera de hacer oración? Cuando los discípulos le preguntan a Jesús lo mismo, él les participa su propia experiencia de oración: hablar con el Padre del cielo que nos ama y nos conoce y sabe perfectamente lo que nos hace falta. El Padrenuestro, oración que nos lleva a saber dónde está Dios, que Él es Santo, que nos perdona siempre, que nos da el pan de cada día, y que nos libra de todo mal.

"Pidan y se les dará, busquen y hallarán, llamen a la puerta y les abrirá. Porque todo el que pide recibe, el que busca halla y al que llame a la puerta se le abrirá" (Lucas 11,9-10). ¿Qué le pides a Dios hoy? ¿De qué le quieres hablar? El Papa Francisco nos da su catequesis sobre la oración y nos dice que: "La oración es el primer y principal instrumento de trabajo que tenemos en nuestras manos. Insistir a Dios no sirve para convencerle, sino para reforzar nuestra fe y nuestra paciencia, es decir, nuestra capacidad de luchar junto a Dios por las cosas realmente importantes y necesarias. En la oración somos dos: Dios y yo luchando juntos por las cosas importantes". Por esa razón, Abraham, insistió tanto en su oración para salvar a Sodoma. Fue un diálogo de petición y una respuesta de amor.

KNIGHT'S OF COLUMBUS ANNUAL ESSAY CONTEST

Each year our Knights of Columbus Council here at St Angela sponsors an Essay Scholarship Contest for the eighth graders at St Angela Merici Parish School, the purpose of which is to support and help further Catholic Education among our parish youth. The contest is open to any 8th grade student at our Parish school who has a minimum 3.0 GPA and will be attending a Catholic High School the following year. The theme of this year's topic was focused on "Family Love: A Vocation and a Path to Holiness". The authors of the two highest scoring essays each received a \$1,000 scholarship from our Council to help defray tuition costs.

This year we had 21 students submit essays, which is a record number. This was due in large part to the efforts and enthusiasm of one of the teachers, Mrs. Jennifer Valencia, and the Knights wish to express their sincere thanks to her for helping promote the contest.

The two winners were announced and certificates presented to them at the school Awards Ceremony held in our Church on Wednesday June 8th. Grand Knight Rob Fulton took time out of his busy schedule to attend and make the presentations himself, further demonstrating the significance our Council holds in helping to further Catholic education among our youth. The authors of the two highest scoring essays are Miss Sasha Regalado and Miss Paige Deiparine, and it is with the kind permission of their parents and Fr. LEADING OTHERS TO CATHOLICISM

Question:

My neighbor is just beginning to explore the Catholic faith but was raised agnostic. I grew up believing in God, praying, and attending Mass. How does one start from scratch as an adult to develop a relationship with God?

Answer:

Start on a personal level! How did you and your neighbor become friends? How did you begin to discuss such a personal topic as faith? Communication, spending time together, and getting to know each other are essential to forming the bonds of a relationship. Personal prayer is essential to our relationship with God. We can't be close to someone we don't know! Invite your friend to explore the stories of Jesus in the Bible. Introduce them to the lives of the saints, especially ones you think they might be interested in.

Your neighbor might also have questions about the Catholic faith that you don't know how to answer. If your friend hasn't yet enrolled in RCIA classes, invite them to Mass at your parish. Introduce your friend to the faith formation director to make a connection. Personal support can be helpful as well, especially if few of your neighbor's current friends are practicing their faith. Connect your neighbor to other people in your parish living their faith well. The good examples of other faithful people could help your neighbor to feel welcomed and supported. When I grew up, my parents taught me about God and how to be a great catholic. Their teaching and upbringing have made me who I am today. The mourning and grief my family feels for this loss makes us relate to each other and have more empathy. Now we have extra motivation to come together and celebrate the Lord and each other. I now realize that when my dad was still alive, I did not always appreciate his presence and what he said. However, I look back every day and replay teachings in my head. The love and Holiness in my family was not always apparent, but now my dad has found some way to give us some sense of peace and comfort because we still feel his presence through our memories of him. Just like we feel Jesus through his teachings even though he is not physically present. Because of this, I know that my family and I can keep on living with God's teachings and words and feel his great love.

I feel like my dad taught the Lord's values best in my family. I will always appreciate what my other family members taught me, but my dad's words will forever reside in my heart. I remember when I was 3 or 4 years old, he would find some way to make God interesting and fun to learn for example, he knew I wasn't the best at paying attention at church. So, when I was distracted, he would put the sermons into simpler words and make it sound like a fantastical story. My dad would also promise me we'd get donuts after Mass, which was my second favorite part. When most of my family visit, they say, "you sound like / look like your dad." I take it as a compliment because I appreciate his thoughts and ways of talking. I remember all the times he took me to fun places like Disneyland or the OC fair, but he also had some serious conversations with me all about the value of motivation and working hard. My dad also taught me valuable life skills like how to learn and protect myself. Even if my dad has gone too soon, I feel like he exemplifies love and holiness.

When I become a parent one day, I would like to be just as great as my dad was. My parenting style would be strict yet fun, and I would try my best to integrate God in everyday life. At an early age, I would like to teach my kids how to be kind and respectful, to show empathy and always help others. I would also like to take them to fun places like the museum or fairs, so they can also learn to relax and have fun. The best part for me is I would be able to help shape their young minds and love them how they are. Everyday lessons will include God's teachings, perhaps making them read a Bible entry or simply teaching them prayers. I feel like these values and teachings would be a great way to teach and shape kids into becoming good citizens. In conclusion, the key to success in life is having a stable, loving relationship not only with God, but with your family as well.

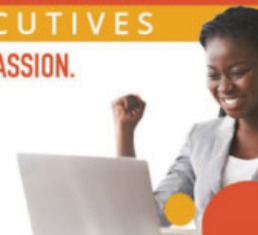
