

### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### REFLECTION FOR THE TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

As adults, unless we are dealing with children, "obedience" is not a word we typically like to hear. It often brings connotations of military protocols, deference to superiors at work, or conforming to laws and practices. In a culture that has learned to challenge authority, being obedient is understood more as something I "have" to do, not "want" to do. Do you ever see merit in wanting to be obedient? Encouraged to develop independent, self-sufficient egos and personas. we learn to focus on our own wills and merits as we strive for success and achieve a sense of well-being. Giving ourselves over to the will of another, especially when done blindly, can sometimes carry more risk than we are willing to take. Also, blindly following orders without any deference to ethics or morality can lead to atrocious crimes and violence against humanity.

St. Ignatius of Loyola states, "There are three sorts of obedience; the first, obedience when a strict obligation is imposed upon us, and this is good; the second when the simple word of the superior, without any strict command, suffices for us, and this is better; the third, when a thing is done without waiting for an express command, from a knowledge that it will be pleasing to the superior, and this is the best of all." St. Ignatius sees obedience as an act of love. When the person we are obeying genuinely has our best interest in mind, acting themselves with love and integrity, then what St. Ignatius says makes excellent sense. When mutual trust and a bond of love and respect are present, obedience can lead to freedom and truth.


We ask God to increase our faith. In other words, increase our trust that God knows best how to live and act in this world. We desire the same confidence, determination, and patience Jesus had that the fulfillment of God's vision would one day come. Nurturing a deep love of God and trusting in his providence, we obediently do what we know is pleasing to God: love, repent of sin, show mercy, be compassionate and fight injustice. As we willingly give witness to our faith, we do only what we are obliged to do, expecting nothing in return. Spared from the task of having to figure it all out for ourselves, we discover freedom.

### REFLEXIÓN PARA 27º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Oh, si tuviéramos fe como un granito de mostaza, la vida sería completamente diferente. Seguimos, igual que los apóstoles, preguntando a Jesús sobre el aumento de la fe. Era la misma situación entonces que ahora. "La fe comparable al grano de mostaza es una fe que no es orgullosa ni segura de sí misma, ¡no pretende ser un gran creyente haciendo el ridículo en algunas ocasiones! Es una fe en su humildad siente una gran necesidad de Dios y, en la pequeñez, se abandona con plena confianza a Él. Es la fe la que nos da la capacidad de mirar con esperanza los altibajos de la vida, la que nos ayuda a acepta incluso las derrotas y los sufrimientos, sabiendo que el mal no tiene nunca, no tendrá nunca la última palabra" (Papa Francisco).

Crecer en la fe es cosa de dos, Dios y tú. Se crece en la fe con la oración personal, seguida de buenas obras. Seguramente, si reflexionamos en el trayecto de nuestra vida, descubriremos que muchas personas han cooperado en el crecimiento de nuestra fe. Nuestros padres, abuelos, catequistas el párroco y la comunidad de fe. El proyecto de Dios es que la fe nos lleve a servir a los demás. Para darnos cuenta, que "somos servidores no necesarios, hemos hecho lo que era nuestro deber" (Lucas 17,10). Solamente la fe y el trabajo por la paz nos dará la esperanza en este mundo tan lastimado por el odio y la venganza.

# DO YOU KNOW... ABOUT THE "ANOINTING OF THE SICK" (FORMERLY KNOWN AS LAST RITES)

Some Catholics may believe the sacrament of the "Anointing of the Sick" is ONLY for those near death. This is NOT the case. In fact, the Catechism of the Catholic Church says this: The anointing of the sick is not a sacrament only for those who are at the point of death. As soon as anyone of the faithful BEGINS to be in danger of death from sickness, or old age, the fitting time for him/her to receive this sacrament has certainly arrived.

The anointing of the sick, can also be administered prior to one having a medical procedure or surgery. The anointing of the sick can be administered more than once in one's lifetime.

If a person who received an anointing recover to health, they may receive the sacrament again if they are experiencing a grave illness. For those who are placed under hospice care, the appropriate time to request an anointing, would be as soon as they are put on hospice care and while they are still able to participate.

### RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

### Lessons from Baptizing a Frog

I used to lead an RCIA session on baptism, where I would bring in my Kermit the Frog toy from when I was a child and pretend to baptize it. It was a session I especially made sure I led when we had children preparing for Easter sacraments. You would think Kermit would have become super holy having been baptized so many times, year after year. But, if he had been real, he would not have been any holier due to multiple baptisms than he was after the first baptism. He couldn't be rebaptized. (Not to mention, of course, he is a FROG.)

When Jesus came to John for baptism, he transformed the baptism of repentance that John was practicing into a baptism of redemption. And although we are called to repentance over and over in our life, redemption comes to us only once. We cannot get baptized again in the Jordan or Sea of Galilee because of romantic notions, or come into the Catholic Church by a second baptism so we can start all over. Our baptism, whether we can remember it or not, is a one-time deal. But it is the real deal. Whether you feel it or not, you are sealed for Christ, and the stain of original sin has been washed away.

Too many of us take that moment for granted. Yes, you may have been baptized as an infant. But much time has passed since then, and you can work to understand the impact that it had on your life. We sometimes look for a good time to begin living a stewardship way of life. However, that time already passed, and God has been waiting. We are called to reflect on our baptism and respond to the call it has placed on our lives. We can respond and be disciples, or we can be like Kermit the Frog, always searching for a new start that never comes.
