FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD

A friend of mine is a young priest who teaches high school physics at a Catholic boys' prep school. Like many today, the boys often think science and religion are enemies. So, he delights in their raised eyebrows when he reminds them his first full-time job as a priest was to be an astrophysicist. He cataloged the size, shape, and matter of distant stars. He tells them, "Science gave me more love for God, not less."

The Magi were something like scientist-astronomers. Like today's scientists, they employed disciplined methods of discovering dependable patterns in the world. Their rigorous commitment to the truth led them to the joy of discovering Jesus. Their love for knowledge leads them to worship the Source of all knowledge. Luke says of them, "They were overjoyed at seeing the star."

We may see the universe as cold and empty and feel sad. But why should we do that? The Magi, like my priest-friend, show us there is another way to experience the world. We use our intelligence to discover the beautiful patterns in the world — in mathematics, physics, astronomy, biology, neuroscience, and so on — and allow this to lead us to greater love for God. So, my fellow Magi: the world needs us to be overjoyed at finding God in science and, finally and fully, in Jesus.

Existe un refrán popular que dice así: "No hay peor sordo que el que no quiere oír". Y le agregaría el que no quiere ver. Los Magos del Oriente no se hicieron sordos ni ciegos, sino que, presurosos siguieron la estrella que los guiaba a Jesús. Preguntaron y escucharon su historia, por aquello de no perderse del lugar donde se encontraba aquel famoso recién nacido. "¿Dónde está el rey de los judíos que acaba de nacer? (Mateo 2,2). ¿Dónde está Jesús en nuestros días? ¿A quién hemos preguntado donde encontrarlo? Quizá, se encuentra en los corazones de los padres de familia que han perdido a sus hijos(as) en la violencia, o tal vez está ahí donde el inmigrante sufre y muere luchando por una vida mejor.

La liturgia de este Domingo de la Epifanía, manifestación de Jesús como salvador de todos los pueblos, nos invita a no ser oyentes pasivos sino activos, comprometidos a la esperanza de una sociedad mejor. La voz del Papa Francisco es el eco de Dios que motiva a ver la luz de la estrella reflejada en el corazón de todo aquel que desea la paz. "El día de hoy debemos sentir cerca a los Magos, ellos tenían el corazón abierto al horizonte: «Vieron la estrella porque se habían puesto en el camino» (San Juan Crisóstomo). Su ejemplo nos anima a contemplar la estrella y a no conformarnos, sino a dejarnos fascinar por la bondad y la verdad. Ellos reflejan la imagen de todos los que no dejamos de levantar la mirada hacia el firmamento, poniendo en nuestro camino a nuestro Dios, Rey del Universo".



DO YOU KNOW...

What prayers the priest whispers during Mass?

There are quiet prayers that the priest prays for himself, "asking that he may exercise his ministry with greater attention and devotion" (GIRM 33).

The first happens when the priest is about to proclaim the Gospel. He says in a soft voice, "Cleanse my heart and lips, almighty God, that I may worthily proclaim your holy Gospel."

Later during the Mass, the priest does a ritual hand washing during the preparation of the altar, he prays.

"Lord wash away my iniquity; cleanse me of my sin."

As you can see, these are the moments when the priest personally expresses humility before God. The priest is not being secretive; he's humbly seeking God's grace that he may be worthy to serve God's people in the celebration of the Mass.

¿SABES...

¿Qué oraciones susurra el sacerdote durante la misa?

Hay oraciones silenciosas que el sacerdote reza por sí mismo, "pidiendo que pueda ejercer su ministerio con mayor atención y devoción" (GIRM 33).

La primera sucede cuando el sacerdote está a punto de anunciar el Evangelio. Dice con voz suave: "Limpia mi corazón y mis labios, Dios todopoderoso, para que pueda proclamar dignamente tu santo Evangelio".

Más tarde, durante la misa, el sacerdote hace un ritual de lavado de manos durante la preparación del altar, reza.

"Señor, lava mi iniquidad; límpiame de mi pecado."

Como puede ver, estos son los momentos en que el sacerdote expresa personalmente la humildad ante Dios. El sacerdote no está siendo reservado; está buscando humildemente la gracia de Dios para que pueda ser digno de servir al pueblo de Dios en la celebración de la Misa.




