THE THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Art of Retreat

Social media has made it far too easy for me to share my opinion.

These virtual spaces tend to strip our words of all empathy. Someone will post something that I think is nonsense, and I just have to tell them why — and quickly! Hurry! Before they delete it!

Nine times out of ten, when the dust is settled, I find that I've said too much and listened too little.

As I've gotten older, the motto I try (not always successfully) to live by is this: You do not have to be on the attack all of the time, even if it's for what you think is the truth.

I can't help but notice that the first thing Jesus does when he hears of the arrest of John the Baptist is to retreat. He doesn't punch a hole in a wall or take to the streets in protest. He withdraws.

And what does he do after withdrawing? A lot of praying, I would imagine. A lot of thinking, a lot of reflecting. A lot of listening to the voice of his Father. Sometimes we mistake stillness with vulnerability. But Christ shows us that to withdraw, to contemplate, can actually be a tremendous show of strength. Even the fiercest dogs wait for the command of their master before they act.

los perros más feroces esperan la orden de su amo antes de actuar.



DO YOU KNOW...

Why we strike our breast three times during the Confiteor?

During the Confiteor, the action of striking our breast each time we say the word fault strengthens our awareness that my sin is my fault (usccb.org/liturgy/girm/bul3.shtml). Our physical actions, when done piously, help bring home to us spiritual truths. When we pray the Confiteor (and we have to remember it is a prayer) we are professing our contrition to God, His angels and saints in heaven, and the faithful on earth. We are asking for forgiveness for all those sins - thoughts, words, deeds and omissions -- which we have committed. Such a confession of sins makes it possible for our venial sins to be forgiven during the Mass itself..
