

# Sunday Reflection and Weekly Readings FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### REFLECTION FOR

### THE SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

The walk down from Mount Tabor after the Transfiguration must have been a long one for Peter, James, and John. How differently they must have viewed the world with the eyes that had seen what they had just seen. How uncertain they must have been.

I think it's important to remember that, on the mountain, they were amazed, yes — but first, they were afraid. We are given the image of these three grown men — these saints, these giants of salvation history — cowering in fear at the voice of God. It was not until Jesus touched them that they could even bear to look up.

Christ was transfigured on Tabor, but in a way, the disciples were transfigured as well. We are all changed by what we see and what we hear. That change can be hard because knowledge is hard. Truth is hard. Sometimes cowering is easier.

Go forth, God told Abram. I will make of you a great nation.

Rise, Christ told his disciples. And do not be afraid. I spend too much time cowering in fear at the voice of God. I cower even when the voice whispers into my heart instead of booming from the clouds. When it's the start of a hard day or a tough conversation. When it's the middle of a half-finished battle, big or small. When I know where Christ is and what he is asking, but I'm afraid because the walk down the mountain is so long, and the world that awaits me is so uncertain.

La bajada del Monte Tabor después de la Transfiguración debe haber sido larga para Pedro, Santiago y Juan. Cuán diferente deben haber visto el mundo con los ojos que habían visto lo que acababan de ver. Qué inciertos deben haber estado.

Creo que es importante recordar que, en la montaña, estaban asombrados, sí, pero primero tuvieron miedo. Se nos da la imagen de estos tres hombres adultos, estos santos, estos gigantes de la historia de la salvación, encogiéndose de miedo ante la voz de Dios. No fue hasta que Jesús los tocó que siguiera pudieron soportar mirar hacia arriba.

Cristo se transfiguró en el Tabor, pero en cierto modo, los discípulos también se transfiguraron. Todos somos cambiados por lo que vemos y lo que oímos. Ese cambio puede ser difícil porque el conocimiento es difícil. La verdad es dura. A veces, encogerse es más fácil. Deja tu país, le dijo Dios a Abram. Haré nacer de ti un gran pueblo.

Levántense dijo Cristo a sus discípulos. Y no teman. Paso demasiado tiempo encogiéndome de miedo ante la voz de Dios. Me encojo incluso cuando la voz susurra en mi corazón en lugar de retumbar desde las nubes. Cuando es el comienzo de un día difícil o una dura conversación. Cuando es el centro de una batalla a medio terminar, grande o pequeña. Cuando sé dónde está Cristo y lo que pide, pero tengo miedo porque la bajada del monte es tan larga y el mundo que me espera es tan incierto.

### DO YOU KNOW...

Should the Holy Water fonts be emptied during lent? Despite its popularity in some places, this practice is not permitted, in fact it is prohibited. It has been the Church's practice to empty the holy water fonts during Triduum, but for a different reason. It is not permitted to have them empty through the whole season of Lent. The Congregation for Divine Worship has stated: The removing of Holy Water from the fonts during the season of Lent is not permitted, in particular, for two reasons: 1. The season of Lent, which though truly being a season of penance, is also a season rich in the symbolism of water and baptism, constantly evoked in liturgical texts. 2. The encouragement of the Church that the faithful avail themselves frequently of the sacraments is to be understood to apply also in the season of Lent. The "fast" and "abstinence" which the faithful embrace in this season does not extend to abstaining from the sacraments or sacramentals of the Church. As spoken about previously in a "Do You Know", when we dip our fingers into Holy Water and make the sign of the cross, we are reminding ourselves of our sacrament of baptism.

# ¿SABES...

# ¿Se deben vaciar las pilas de agua bendita durante la cuaresma?

A pesar de su popularidad en algunos lugares, esta práctica no está permitida, de hecho está prohibida. Ha sido práctica de la Iglesia vaciar las pilas de agua bendita durante el Triduo, pero por una razón diferente. No está permitido tenerlos vacíos durante todo el tiempo de Cuaresma. La Congregación para el Culto Divino ha declarado: No está permitido sacar el Agua Bendita de las fuentes durante el tiempo de Cuaresma, en particular, por dos motivos: 1. El tiempo de Cuaresma, que es verdaderamente un tiempo de penitencia, es también un tiempo rico en el simbolismo del agua y del bautismo, evocado constantemente en los textos litúrgicos. 2. El estímulo de la Iglesia de que los fieles se aprovechen frecuentemente de los sacramentos debe entenderse que se aplica también en el tiempo de Cuaresma. El "ayuno" y la "abstinencia" que abrazan los fieles en este tiempo no se extiende a la abstención de los sacramentos o sacramentales de la Iglesia. Como se mencionó anteriormente en un "¿Sabes?", cuando sumergimos nuestros dedos en agua bendita y hacemos la señal de la cruz, nos estamos recordando a nosotros mismos de nuestro sacramento del bautismo
