FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR

THE SECOND SUNDAY IN LENT

The walk down from Mount Tabor after the Transfiguration must have been a long one for Peter, James, and John. How differently they must have viewed the world with the eyes that had seen what they had just seen. How uncertain they must have been.

I think it's important to remember that, on the mountain, they were amazed, yes — but first, they were afraid. We are given the image of these three grown men — these saints, these giants of salvation history — cowering in fear at the voice of God. It was not until Jesus touched them that they could even bear to look up.

Christ was transfigured on Tabor, but in a way, the disciples were transfigured as well. We are all changed by what we see and what we hear. That change can be hard because knowledge is hard. Truth is hard. Sometimes cowering is easier.

Go forth, God told Abram. I will make of you a great nation.

Rise, Christ told his disciples. And do not be afraid.

I spend too much time cowering in fear at the voice of God. I cower even when the voice whispers into my heart instead of booming from the clouds. When it's the start of a hard day or a tough conversation. When it's the middle of a half-finished battle, big or small. When I know where Christ is and what he is asking, but I'm afraid because the walk down the mountain is so long, and the world that awaits me is so uncertain.

DO YOU KNOW...

Should the Holy Water fonts be emptied during lent?

Despite its popularity in some places, this practice is not permitted, in fact it is prohibited. It has been the Church's practice to empty the holy water fonts during Triduum, but for a different reason. It is not permitted to have them empty through the whole season of Lent. The Congregation for Divine Worship has stated: The removing of Holy Water from the fonts during the season of Lent is not permitted, in particular, for two reasons: 1. The season of Lent, which though truly being a season of penance, is also a season rich in the symbolism of water and baptism, constantly evoked in liturgical texts. 2. The encouragement of the Church that the faithful avail themselves frequently of the sacraments is to be understood to apply also in the season of Lent. The "fast" and "abstinence" which the faithful embrace in this season does not extend to abstaining from the sacraments or sacramentals of the Church. As spoken about previously in a "Do You Know", when we dip our fingers into Holy Water and make the sign of the cross, we are reminding ourselves of our sacrament of baptism.

¿SABES...

¿Se deben vaciar las pilas de agua bendita durante la cuaresma?

A pesar de su popularidad en algunos lugares, esta práctica no está permitida, de hecho está prohibida. Ha sido práctica de la Iglesia vaciar las pilas de agua bendita durante el Triduo, pero por una razón diferente. No está permitido tenerlos vacíos durante todo el tiempo de Cuaresma. La Congregación para el Culto Divino ha declarado: No está permitido sacar el Agua Bendita de las fuentes durante el tiempo de Cuaresma, en particular, por dos motivos: 1. El tiempo de Cuaresma, que es verdaderamente un tiempo de penitencia, es también un tiempo rico en el simbolismo del agua y del bautismo, evocado constantemente en los textos litúrgicos. 2. El estímulo de la Iglesia de que los fieles se aprovechen frecuentemente de los sacramentos debe entenderse que se aplica también en el tiempo de Cuaresma. El "ayuno" y la "abstinencia" que abrazan los fieles en este tiempo no se extiende a la abstención de los sacramentos o sacramentales de la Iglesia. Como se mencionó anteriormente en un "¿Sabes?", cuando sumergimos nuestros dedos en agua bendita y hacemos la señal de la cruz, nos estamos recordando a nosotros mismos de nuestro sacramento del bautismo.

Our almsgiving has the power to transform the world. During Lent, CRS Rice Bowl invites you to reflect on some of the lives that are changed through Lenten almsgiving. Read stories of hope from Honduras, the Philippines, and Kenya and reflect with your family using our Lenten family calendar.



What is Almsgiving?

We all want to be "good Samaritans." When we see our sister or brother suffering, we are moved by compassion. We want to help. We are inspired to give. Almsgiving is central to how we practice Lent. Almsgiving flows from prayer and fasting. We reflect on the needs of the world and how God is calling us to meet those needs through prayer. We make room for the needs of others—and for the Holy Spirit to work within us—through fasting. Through a recognition of the world's needs and a personal commitment to act, we give alms. What are alms? Alms are money or goods that are given to—or other acts of charity that are performed for—those in need. Catholics look to the Catechism, which says that almsgiving is "a witness to fraternal charity" and "a work of justice pleasing to God."

When we reflect on the charity of the good Samaritan, we sometimes miss the second part of the man's almsgiving. He leaves the innkeeper with these words—and a few coins: "Take care of him. If you spend more than what I have given you, I shall repay you on my way back." He gives freely and wholeheartedly in equal measure to the need of the one whom he serves. No reservations. No disclaimers. This Lent, almsgiving is your way to become a "good Samaritan." As we journey from Ash Wednesday through Holy Week to Easter, we invite you to consider CRS an innkeeper in your Lenten almsgiving.

How CRS Uses Alms

For more than 45 years, Lenten alms given through CRS Rice Bowl have supported programs that prevent hunger and poverty around the world, including the countries featured in the Lenten stories of hope. Seventy-five percent of gifts help support CRS' work in more than 100 countries. Twenty-five percent of gifts remain in each U.S. diocese where they are given to support hunger and poverty alleviation efforts in those communities. Each diocese uses this differently.

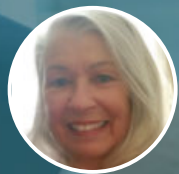

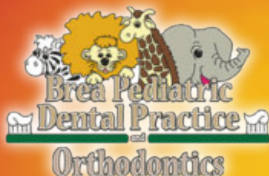
