

REFLECTION FOR

THE FOURTH SUNDAY IN LENT

God asks a rhetorical and slightly sarcastic question to Samuel, the prophet: "How long will you grieve for Saul, whom I have rejected as king of Israel?" Like us, Samuel is depressed that the old king failed. It's painful to admit that the old regime is done. But God won't let us wallow our pity-party forever. "I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem," announces the Lord, "for I have chosen my king from among his sons." Samuel finally goes and anoints the young David as the new king. And his kingdom is glorious; it's the golden age of Israel's earthly history.

How discouraging to see that my own selfish ego is no longer in charge! How long will I grieve that money, power, pleasure, and reputation have been rejected as the ruler of my life? How wonderful that God has a new future in store for you and me. He is sending us to Bethlehem to anoint the new David as our king. His kingdom won't fail us. He'll slay our goliaths, unite our dispersed energies, and build a Temple where God himself will dwell.

REFLEXIÓN PARA

EL CUARTO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

El Señor nos llena de luz por medio de la curación del ciego de nacimiento y nos ayuda con su milagro a estar bien preparados para llegar a la Pascua. Dentro de poco estaremos celebrando el Domingo de Ramos, para luego entrar a la Semana Santa. La fe viva se manifiesta en nuestro corazón y la entrega generosa que durante la Cuaresma hemos vivido por medio del ayuno, la oración y la caridad, se agranda para celebrar las fiestas de la Pascua.

El Papa Francisco recordó que este IV Domingo de Cuaresma es conocido como "el domingo Laetare, es decir, Alégrate". Por esa razón, la liturgia eucarística inicia con la invitación a la alegría. "Alégrate, Jerusalén, y todos ustedes los que la aman, reúnanse. Regocíjense con ella todos los que participaban de su duelo y quedarán saciados con la abundancia de sus consuelos" (Ver Isaías 66,10-11). Además, agregó: "Este mensaje gozoso es el corazón de la fe cristiana: el amor de Dios ha encontrado la cima en el don del Hijo a una humanidad débil y pecadora. Quien camina en la luz, quien se acerca a la luz, no puede hacer nada más que obras buenas. Es lo que estamos llamados a hacer con mayor empeño durante la Cuaresma: acoger la luz en nuestra conciencia, para abrir nuestros corazones al amor infinito de Dios, a su misericordia llena de ternura y bondad, a su perdón ". Él afirmó que Dios siempre nos perdona, solo pide abrir el corazón y toda la persona a ese perdón infinito de Dios Padre.

DO YOU KNOW...

When are Catholics required to genuflect?

The GIRM (General Instruction Roman Missal) states, "A genuflection, made by bending the right knee to the ground, signifies adoration, and therefore it is reserved for the Most Blessed Sacrament." It is the general custom that you genuflect on one knee whenever you pass before the tabernacle (that contains the Blessed Sacrament). Usually when people enter a Catholic church and walk to their pew they genuflect before sitting down, which is a small gesture of adoration for the One who is present there.

However, its important to note that a genuflection is always necessary when passing the tabernacle. Each time one enters a pew from the center aisle at St. Angela Merici, one should genuflect.

¿SABES...

¿Cuándo se requiere que los católicos hagan una genuflexión?

El GIRM (Misal Romano de Instrucción General) afirma: "La genuflexión, hecha doblando la rodilla derecha hasta el suelo, significa adoración, y por tanto está reservada al Santísimo Sacramento". Es costumbre general hacer una genuflexión sobre una rodilla cada vez que se pasa ante el tabernáculo (que contiene el Santísimo Sacramento). Por lo general, cuando las personas ingresan a una iglesia católica y caminan hacia su banco, hacen una genuflexión antes de sentarse, lo cual es un pequeño gesto de adoración por Aquel que está presente allí. Sin embargo, es importante notar que siempre es necesaria una genuflexión al pasar el sagrario. Cada vez que uno ingresa a un banco del pasillo central en St. Angela Merici, debe hacer una genuflexión.



Raul and Rhodora <u>Enecillo</u> live on their farm in Northern Samar, Philippines, with their granddaughters Loraine and Kate.

Raul and Rhodora get up at 5 a.m. each day to tend to the fishpond, <u>pigs</u> and chickens before getting their granddaughters off to school. Education is important to Raul and Rhodora. Their

dream is that Loraine and Kate will graduate from college and get good jobs—Loraine wants to be a doctor was a second college.

college and get good jobs—Loraine wants to be a doctor when she grows up. For years, Raul and Rhodora worked hard as coconut farmers. After harvesting, they prepared the coconuts for making oil—but it took a lot of work before they made money. On top of that, periods of heavy rain caused flooding, making farming difficult.

Then Raul and Rhodora participated in a Catholic Relief Services program where they received training and assistance to build their own fishpond. They bought little fish to stock the pond, fish food and a net. The fish grew bigger, and soon they were able to sell them at the market. The fishpond also provided food for their family so they could enjoy nutritious meals together.

"Life is so much easier now that we have the fish for our daily living," Rhodora says.

In the program, Raul and Rhodora also learned how to better prepare for the increasing natural disasters in their area—like typhoons, flooding, earthquakes, and landslides. They made improvements to their house, using stronger, sturdier materials to protect their home and family.

Since joining the program, Raul and Rhodora added two more fishponds along with pigs and chickens. With the extra income from their farm, their granddaughters can enjoy their childhood and live a more comfortable life, giving them the opportunity to study hard and finish school.

"I have many dreams for my family and my grandchildren," Raul says. "I hope I can give them something good."

Adoration Chapel

I've been a parishioner of St. Angela Merici since the early 1960s. Many times, I would listen to the announcements for the Adoration chapel and think, 'Why would I go to the Adoration chapel and ask God for something when I come to church and pray here?'

Then about 5 years ago my mom's health declined, and she was confined to her wheelchair. I was thinking of ways to get her out of the house and help her spiritually. She had always gone to adoration when she was healthy, so I decided to take her (in her wheelchair) each Wednesday night. She loved it and looked forward to it each week.

At first, I would focus on my mom – turning her pages and always making sure she felt secure and comforted.

Then I started to notice the Devine Mercy picture of Jesus looking at me. No matter where I sat - Jesus was still looking me!

Slowly I decided to embrace the idea of praying to the Blessed Sacrament while taking mom —I thought, why not? I brought my holy cards and prayed alongside mom each week. Little did I know this would be one of the most precious memories of my life!

During this time my husband and I were facing a very difficult, life changing decision, that impacted our entire family. Each week I went and prayed for Jesus to guide us and show us his plan. This took some time, but slowly (over the next year) we started receiving direct signs and clear answers to our prayers.

I continued going to adoration to pray and surrender to God's will. Our trials didn't necessarily stop, however the signs, direction and graces kept coming! There is absolutely no doubt my prayers were heard and answered. I experienced many miracles beyond what I had ever imagined. This changed my life.

My mom has since passed. I still go to adoration to pray, seek guidance, and constantly thank God for all my blessings. But most of all, just spending time with the Blessed Sacrament brings me such peace and clarity. I believe this makes me a better person in this world.
