REFLECTION FOR THIRD

SUNDAY OF EASTER

I always feel a little sad when someone begins to speak to me with the words, "Father, I know you're so busy, but " It happens a lot. And I get it. He or she is trying to be respectful of my time. But it saddens me because a priest makes Jesus present to people in a special way, and Jesus always has time for us. Don't we all feel at times that God just doesn't have time for us? Nonsense. Just look at the stunning "Road to Emmaus" story we hear this week. It's the day Jesus rose from the dead. And the Risen One appears in disguise to two disciples. He walks with them, chats with them, and eventually eats with them. It could have been hours he spends with them — two unnamed persons — in the middle of nowhere. On the day he rose from the dead!

My friends, please take this to heart: The Risen Jesus is not too busy to spend time with you! He doesn't have "better things to do." You and I are members of this crucified and risen Body. He therefore has all the time in the world to be with us. So, I challenge you this week to approach him confidently in prayer and conversation. After all, being with you and me is the reason he rose from the dead.

El reto y la invitación en esta Pascua es ser un cristiano comprometido que alegre el camino de los que lo rodean. También se nos invita a leer y meditar la Sagrada Escritura en familia.

DO YOU KNOW...

When is a Word Service is permitted ?

The United States Conference of Catholic Bishop (USCCB) provided the following direction regarding having a Word Service in parishes.

In recent years, the Church in the United States of America has experienced a reduction in the number of priests available to celebrate Mass on a daily basis in our parish communities. Indeed, in some places, one priest is assigned as pastor of several parishes and is barely able to provide Sunday Mass in each of these communities. In other instances, even the Sunday Mass is not possible each week. Thus, the ritual book Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of Priest was developed. The specialized provisions of Sunday Celebrations in the Absence of a Priest are not appropriate to weekday celebrations. Therefore if a priest is not available to preside at a daily mass, a word service is not permitted to be performed

¿SABES...

¿Cuándo se permite un servicio de Word?

La Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos (USCCB, por sus siglas en inglés) proporcionó las siguientes instrucciones con respecto a tener un Servicio de Palabra en las parroquias. En los últimos años, la Iglesia en los Estados Unidos de América ha experimentado una reducción en el número de sacerdotes disponibles para celebrar la Misa diariamente en nuestras comunidades parroquiales. De hecho, en algunos lugares, un sacerdote es asignado como párroco de varias parroquias y apenas puede ofrecer la Misa dominical en cada una de estas comunidades. En otros casos, incluso la misa dominical no es posible cada semana. Así, se desarrolló el libro ritual Celebraciones dominicales en ausencia del sacerdote. Las disposiciones especializadas de las celebraciones dominicales en ausencia de un sacerdote no son apropiadas para las celebraciones entre semana. Por lo tanto, si un sacerdote no está disponible para presidir una misa diaria, no se permite realizar un servicio de palabra.

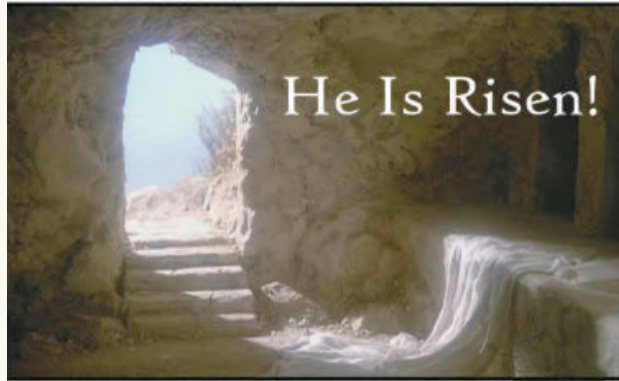
