FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR FIFTH
SUNDAY OF EASTER

REFLEXIÓN PARA QUINTO
DOMINGO DE PASCUA

If you had to summarize the essential core of the Christian life, what would it be? Mercy, truth, or love, perhaps? The readings today suggest another word which may surprise you. That word is priesthood.

St. Peter says to us, "You are a 'chosen race, a royal priesthood'" To be part of a priesthood is to offer a particular sacrifice in order for the community to survive and thrive. Jesus is the great high priest because he offers the one perfect sacrifice which heals and perfects the entire human race. Peter the Apostle wants us to know that all the baptized share in this priestly ministry. The whole of our lives, including every detail, is meant to become our acceptable offering to God.

The baptized exercise this priesthood in many ways, I'll mention three. At Sunday Mass, in private prayer, and in daily work. At Mass, we offer the sacrifice of our lives with that of the priest, who symbolizes Christ the Priest. In our prayer, a "morning offering" prayer is a great way to offer up all the joys and sufferings of the day to come. In our daily work, we sacrifice our time, comfort, money, and energy to do good for others. All this gives the deepest possible meaning to our lives: we share in the priesthood which saves the world. That's at the core of our faith.

Tenemos un Padre que nos ama y nos espera siempre con amor, compasión y perdón. En este V Domingo de Pascua, Jesús nos dice que confiemos en Dios y confiemos en él: "En la casa de mi Padre hay muchas habitaciones. De no ser así, no les habría dicho que voy a prepararles un lugar" (Juan 14,1-2). Qué bonito se siente escuchar que Jesús nos tenga un lugar preparado, una habitación completa. Solo nos pide no perder la paz. También, nos muestra su profunda relación con su Padre del cielo, al que ahora regresa. En esta Pascua, Jesús desea que no perdamos la paz a pesar de todas las dificultades que enfrentamos. Ya se sabe el camino para llegar al cielo. No hay que buscar otros senderos: "Yo soy el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida". (Juan 14,6). Señor Jesús, tú eres nuestro camino. Tú nos invitas a colaborar en el proyecto del Reino. Todos, como bautizados, estamos metidos en este trabajo de colaboración. ¿Cómo lo hago? ¿De qué forma colaboro? Es de diferentes maneras: la misión está en la familia, en la escuela, el trabajo y la sociedad. En Jesús está la respuesta, como camino, verdad y vida. Si de verdad hiciéramos vida estas palabras de Jesús, en lugar de guerra, habría paz, y en lugar de odio, habría perdón. En la Lectura de Pedro se nos invita a acercarnos a Jesús, que es la piedra viva. La Iglesia es el Pueblo de Dios, donde todos seguimos el camino que Jesús nos indicó.

DO YOU KNOW...

Why we sit, stand and kneel during mass?

Sitting is a posture of listening. Catholics sit for the first reading, the Psalm and the second reading. We also sit for the offering, and the homily.

Standing is for Prayer and Respect: Standing has been a posture of prayer for Jewish people since before the time of Jesus. We stand to affirm our beliefs. We stand for the opening prayer, for the Creed, for the Lord's Prayer for the Gospel and for the Procession(s).

Kneeling is a posture of Respect and Adoration. We kneel during the preparation for and before/after reception of the Eucharist. We kneel because we believe Jesus is fully and truly present in Communion. If you believed you were literally in the presence of Christ himself, falling to your knees would be a natural thing to do. That is why we kneel until the Eucharist is put back into the tabernacle, and the tabernacle is closed.

¿SABES...

¿Por qué nos sentamos, nos paramos y nos arrodillamos durante la misa?

Sentarse es una postura de escucha. Los católicos se sientan para la primera lectura, el Salmo y la segunda lectura. También nos sentamos para la ofrenda y la homilía.

Estar de pie es para orar y respetar: Estar de pie ha sido una postura de oración para el pueblo judío desde antes de la época de Jesús. Nos ponemos de pie para afirmar nuestras creencias. Nos ponemos de pie para la oración de apertura, para el Credo, para el Padrenuestro por el Evangelio y para la(s) procesión(es).

Arrodillarse es una postura de Respeto y Adoración. Nos arrodillamos durante la preparación y antes/después de la recepción de la Eucaristía. Nos arrodillamos porque creemos que Jesús está total y verdaderamente presente en la Comunión. Si creías que estabas literalmente en la presencia de Cristo mismo, caer de rodillas sería algo natural. Es por eso que nos arrodillamos hasta que la Eucaristía se vuelve a colocar en el tabernáculo y el tabernáculo se cierra.

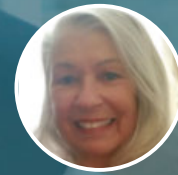

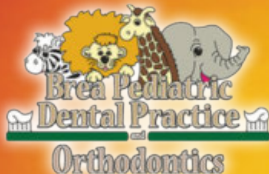
