

## Sunday Reflection and Weekly Readings FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

### REFLECTION FOR THE 14TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

"My yoke is easy and my burden is light," says the man hanging from a cross. And if we only went on what we see with our eyes — flesh driven through by nails and sword, swollen from beating and inches from expiration — it would seem like a joke. I'll tell you something we all know: this life on earth is hard. It's either too long or it's too short. It's frequently painful. It's riddled with problems that seem to make no sense. It is, as Dickens wrote, "made of ever so many partings welded together." But it's also shockingly, senselessly beautiful. It is full of physical experiences of love, jou, and peace that are so powerful they leave you breathless. It is both these things — good and bad, hard and wonderful, just as we are both body and soul, spirit and flesh.

No one knows the Father except the Son, who entered into our bodily existence to free us from enslavement to it. No one knows the Son except the Father, and the means by which they know one another — the love passing between them, the Third Person himself — has been shared with us, has made its dwelling within us through baptism.

Son ambas cosas: buena y mala, dura y maravillosa, así como somos cuerpo y alma, espíritu y carne. Nadie conoce al Padre excepto el Hijo, quien entró en nuestra existencia corporal para liberarnos de la esclavitud a ella. Nadie conoce al Hijo sino el Padre, y el medio por el cual se conocen —el amor que pasa entre ellos, la Tercera Persona misma— ha sido compartida con nosotros, ha hecho su morada en nosotros por el bautismo.

- \* Perdona todas las heridas.





Rev. Raphael Ddamba, originally from Uganda, attended St. John's Seminary in Camarillo. He was ordained to the priesthood in August 2011. He served as associate Pastor in Uganda and Los Angeles before moving to Portland in 2013, where he was a hospital chaplain at Providence Portland Medical Center and on his return to Orange County at St. Jude Medical Center.

On returning to Uganda in February 2021, Fr. Raphael was named the Founding Parish Priest of St. Joseph the Worker in Mpigi district, where he oversaw the construction of the rectory and formation of a new parish Community. In June 2021 he was appointed as Acting Deputy Chaplain of St. Charles Lwanga Catholic Community at Makerere University Business School, Nakawa. He was confirmed as Deputy Chaplain in September 2021 to date.

Fr. Raphael is the founder and Executive Director of the St. Isidore Next Generation Foundation, which operates in Uganda for the empowerment of the youth through education and employment opportunities.

After returning, she began working for Catholic Charities of Los Angeles at the Good Shepherd Center for Homeless Women and Children as a Case Manager. As part of the Mission Doctors Association team, Amie is now working in the area of recruitment, training, and support for both long and short-term MDA medical professionals, and their families, serving in Africa and Latin America.

Dr. Malvina Torbay is originally from Venezuela where she practiced as a physician for many years. Joining her family in California, became involved in the work of Mission Doctors Association and has represented the organization across the country. Her deep faith and commitment to the poor are reflected in her connection with this mission and her special devotion to St. Therese of the Child Jesus, who is the patroness of mission.

Amie and Dr. Torbay will be speaking at all the Masses at St. Angela Merici Parish on <u>July 15-July 16</u> on behalf of Mission Doctors Association as part of the Diocese of Orange Missionary Cooperative Plan.
