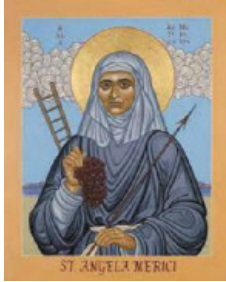

REFLECTION FOR THE 16TH SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

The Catholic Bubble

There's a dangerous myth that exists among pockets of faithful, observant Catholic families. I call it the Legend of the Catholic Bubble.

Here's how the legend goes: you find a devout Catholic parish and a devout Catholic community filled with devout Catholic people who care about devout Catholic things, and you stay away from everything and everyone else, you and your children will be safe from the influence of the evil one. Your children will never fall away from the faith, or even be tempted, and your own faith will stay steel-strong amidst the many tempests and trials of this earthly life.

But like the Loch Ness Monster and the Abominable Snowman, it's all made up.

Don't misunderstand me: I love a good devout Catholic parish. I live for a supportive, devout Catholic community. It's one of the biggest blessings in the Christian life, and I cannot overstate how helpful it is to raise children in an environment that upholds your Catholic faith and does not denigrate it.

But. But.

Make no mistake: the Catholic Bubble will not save you. The trials and the temptations will find you there, too: on the parish council, at Catholic school, in your Catholic moms' group. No community on earth is so supportive that it mimics Heaven. The weeds have been sown with the good seed, and the harvest time is not yet upon us.

Cherish your community, certainly — but beware of the lure of the Catholic Bubble. We are called to be yeast in the loaf of bread, and yeast is nothing on its own.

DO YOU KNOW...

What is the Apostles Creed and what it means to Catholics.

The Apostles' Creed is attributed to some of the earliest missionary followers of Jesus Christ, distilling the fundamental basics of what it means to be a Catholic and follow in the teachings of God. The creed acts as a concise summary of His teachings and is deeply rooted in Scripture. By reciting the Apostles' Creed, we can feel a sense of unity and community with fellow Catholics of every age worldwide.

When we recite the Apostles' Creed during Mass, we end the creed saying "Amen," our declaration of affirmation and confirmation. We, the assembled faithful of Christ, recite the creed as it is our shared belief. While the creed is not our entire faith, it mentions fundamental truths we believe and surmises the teachings within the Scripture. Although the Apostles' Creed was written centuries ago, it still plays an important role in the Catholic Church, allowing us to reflect on the words and praise the glory of God.

El Credo de los Apóstoles se atribuye a algunos de los primeros seguidores misioneros de Jesucristo, destilando los conceptos básicos fundamentales de lo que significa ser católico y seguir las enseñanzas de Dios. El credo actúa como un resumen conciso de Sus enseñanzas y está profundamente arraigado en las Escrituras. Al recitar el Credo de los Apóstoles, podemos sentir un sentido de unidad y comunidad con otros católicos de todas las edades en todo el mundo.

Cuando recitamos el Credo de los Apóstoles durante la Misa, terminamos el credo diciendo "Amén", nuestra declaración de afirmación y confirmación. Nosotros, los fieles de Cristo reunidos, recitamos el credo como es nuestra creencia compartida. Si bien el credo no es toda nuestra fe, menciona verdades fundamentales en las que creemos y supone las enseñanzas de las Escrituras.

Aunque el Credo de los Apóstoles fue escrito hace siglos, todavía juega un papel importante en la Iglesia Católica, permitiéndonos reflexionar sobre las palabras y alabar la gloria de Dios.

Meet our new Priests

Bishop Kevin Vann appointed Fr. Daniel Reader as pastor of St. Angela Merici Church effective July 1, 2023. To get to know a little more about Fr. Daniel's life and ministry, Fr. Daniel wanted to share the following biographical information.



Fr. Daniel was born in 1968 in Houston, TX where he lived until he was five years-old when his family moved back to Kentucky to be closer to his maternal grandmother who was in poor health. Fr. Daniel's parents worked in education and stressed that throughout their lives. His father was a high school history teacher and football coach. His mother worked for the local board of education. Fr. Daniel was raised in Louisville, KY with his two older brothers and an older sister. He attended St. Rita Catholic School and was taught by the Ursulines sisters (St. Angela Merici's order). He went on to attend St. Francis Xavier High School where he enjoyed his studies and participated in the school's Cross Country and Track & Field teams. In 1990, Fr. Daniel graduated from the University of Louisville with his Bachelor's degree in Political Science and International Relations. He thought he would go to law school or work in public service. He moved to Orange County, California in 1990 where his sister lived. As God's will and life unfolded, his vocational journey saw him working in law firms but not going to law school. Later, he would work for a software and technology company in sales and marketing. With the help of his then-pastor, Fr. Eamon O'Gorman and Msgr. Wil Davis, the diocesan Director of Priestly Vocations, Fr. Daniel discerned that God could be calling him to the priesthood and to conform his life more radically to Christ. After attending St. John Seminary in Camarillo, CA and completing his Master's degrees in Divinity and Theology, Fr. Daniel was ordained priest in 2011. Fr. Daniel was assigned a parochial vicar to St. Irenaeus Church in Cypress, CA from 2011-2015. In 2015, Bishop Vann appointed him Director of Priests' Personnel where he served in that capacity until 2023. Fr. Daniel assisted Bishop Vann and the Priest Personnel Board with recommendations for annual priest assignments. In 2017, he was given additional duties to serve as the Chancellor of the Diocese of Orange. From 2015-2023, Fr. Daniel lived in-residence at Christ Cathedral and served as a supply priest. One aspect of Fr. Daniel's spiritual life that guides him is the communion of saints and the lives of the saints. Some of his favorite saints are St. Augustine of Hippo, St. Rita of Cascia, St. Catherine of Siena, St. Teresa of Ávila, St. John of the Cross, St. Katherine Drexel, St. Paul VI, and St. John Paul II the Great. Having been taught in elementary school by St. Angela Merici's religious order, the Ursulines, and now being assigned here at St. Angela's to serve, Fr. Daniel will now foster a greater devotion to St. Angela Merici and her order's charisms. With the prayer and intercession of Our Lady of Guadalupe and St. Junipero Serra, Fr. Daniel commends himself to their care, and asks for all parishioners to pray for him. On a personal note, Fr. Daniel enjoys reading, walking and hiking, and occasionally a tennis match when partners are available. As we all continue our Catholic faith here in Brea at St. Angela Merici Church, Fr. Daniel wanted to share one of his favorite sayings with all of you, "Do not be afraid. God wants us to be successful in our faith, even more than we do."

FR. MANUEL LÓPEZ GONZÁLEZ

PAROCHIAL VICAR

Fr. Manuel was born in the state of Michoacán, Mexico, and is the oldest of five brothers and sisters. He is 46 years old and his ordination as a priest was 12 years ago. He has been a Parochial Vicar here in the Diocese of Orange in the parishes of Saint Barbara in the city of Santa Ana, in the parish of St. Justin Martyr in the city of Anaheim, and in Mission Basilica Parish in San Juan Capistrano. Fr. Manuel joined our parish community of Saint Angela Merici on July 1, 2023.

Father Manuel shares with us that the vocation to the priesthood is a gift from God according to the words of the Lord Jesus: "You have not chosen me, but I have chosen you" Jn 15:16. He asks God to help him always do his will and the Virgin of Guadalupe to continue interceding for him before her Son, our Lord Jesus Christ. He commends himself to your prayers and you may count on his prayers for you.

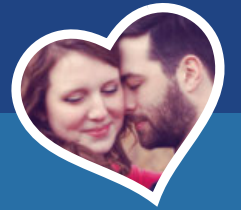
