

Sunday Reflection and Weekly Readings FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR THE **20TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

When I was a child, my mother bought a book called "The Prayers God Will Always Answer." I remember my anticipation as I cracked the spine and turned to the first page.

I had been spending a lot of time asking God — begging God, actually — over and over again for some specific things that were not materializing. Frankly, it was beginning to feel a lot like that time I asked Santa Claus for a new house, only to wake up on Christmas morning to find ordinary, non-house-shaped presents under the tree — and a growing sense of suspicion that my faith had been ill-placed.

To the great disappointment of my pre-teen heart, my mother's book was not a directory of magical phrases God is compelled to obey. It was a list that included things like "Forgive me" and "Help me." I tossed it aside, disappointed.

I marvel at the wisdom and the confidence of the Canaanite woman who persists in begging Jesus to heal her daughter. She is ignored, and still she will not be deterred. The disciples try to dismiss her — still, she presses on. Christ himself challenges her, and her faith makes her ready with a reply.

Somehow, I am sure that even if Christ had said, "No, it cannot be done for you as you wish," she would have still dropped to her knees and worshiped him, because she knew what I did not: God is not a vending machine, and he's not the genie from "Aladdin." Prayer is not a negotiation, but a relationship.

The story of the Canaanite woman is not a story about how to get God to give you what you want. It is a story about the prayers God always answers.

"Then Jesus said to her in reply, 'O woman, great is your faith!"" - Matthew 15:28

Cuando era niña, mi madre compró un libro llamado "Las Oraciones que Dios Siempre Contestará." Recuerdo mi anticipación cuando rompí el lomo y volteé a la primera página.

Había estado pasando mucho tiempo pidiéndole a Dios, rogándole a Dios, en realidad, una y otra vez por algunas cosas específicas que no se estaban materializando. Francamente, empezaba a parecerse mucho a aquella vez que le pedí a Santa Claus una casa nueva, solo para despertarme la mañana de Navidad y encontrar regalos ordinarios que no tenían forma de casa debajo del árbol, y una creciente sensación de sospecha de que mi fe había sido mal puesta.

Para gran desilusión de mi corazón preadolescente, el libro de mi madre no era un directorio de frases mágicas que Dios está obligado a obedecer. Era una lista que incluía cosas como "Perdóname" y "Ayúdame." Lo tiré a un lado, decepcionada.

Me maravillo de la sabiduría y la confianza de la mujer cananea que persiste en rogar a Jesús que sane a su hija. Ella es ignorada, y aun así no será disuadida. Los discípulos tratan de despedirla, pero ella sique adelante. Cristo mismo la desafía, y su fe la prepara con una respuesta.

De alguna manera, estoy segura de que incluso si Cristo hubiera dicho: "No, no se puede hacer por ti como quieres," ella todavía se habría puesto de rodillas y lo habría adorado, porque sabía lo que yo no sabía: Dios no es una máquina expendedora, y no es el genio de "Aladino." La oración no es una negociación, sino una relación. La historia de la mujer cananea no es una historia sobre cómo conseguir que Dios te dé lo que quieres. Es una historia sobre las oraciones que Dios siempre contesta. "Entonces Jesús le respondió: 'Mujer, ¡qué grande es tu fe!"" — Mateo 15:28

First Saturday Rosary

Here at St Angela Merici it has been a practice for many years to pray the Rosary on the First Saturday of the month. A group of parishioners has gathered in the church after the 8 am Mass to pray the rosary with special intentions. When the rosary is finished, those who desire to do so can also stay for an additional few minutes to pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy for the poor souls in Purgatory. In recent years our Knights of Columbus council has also designated this event as the venue for their monthly council rosary. Additionally, those who are able to attend daily Mass can find a group of parishioners who stay after the daily 8AM Mass to pray the rosary and Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

All parishioners are invited to join in this beautiful prayer to our Lady. Just show up and join us. Praying the Rosary on the first Saturday of the month is a long-standing Catholic tradition based on our Lady's revelation at Fatima.

"Look, My daughter, at My Heart, surrounded with thorns with which ungrateful men pierce Me at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Do you, at least, try to console Me and announce in My name that I promise to assist at the moment of death, with all the graces necessary for salvation, all those who, on the first Saturday of five consecutive months shall confess, receive Holy Communion, recite five decades of the Rosary, and keep Me company for fifteen minutes while meditating on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary, with the intention of making reparation to Me."

10 Things That Happen When You Go To Adoration More Often

- 1. You develop a sense of awe and wonder. There is nothing like the atmosphere of a quiet chapel or church, the smell of incense and the splendor of the monstrance to help you understand the truth of what is happening in Adoration. We are truly before Jesus Christ, His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The more you sink into that silence in front of the Host, the more you'll realize the only response is awe and wonder at the greatness of our God.
- 2. You experience peace in other areas of your life. Jesus said, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you." (John 14:27) The outward peace we can experience in Adoration (the quiet and the stillness) reaches much deeper. It leads to an inner peace that affects all areas of our lives. It doesn't mean everything in our life will be perfect and without suffering, but Christ's peace means we know the storms of life can't shake us.
- 3. You begin to look outwardly. Jesus told us to "love one another as I have loved you". (John 13:34) Spending time in Adoration connects us to the whole world after all, we're spending time with the Creator of all things! More time praising and adoring God means you can look beyond your own concerns and see the needs of others in your life and in the world, we live in.
- 4. You get bored sometimes. There are going to be times when Adoration can feel anything but glorious. You get distracted, your mind begins to wander, you can hear someone else sniffing next to you. Maybe in the beginning, Adoration was full of wonderful feelings! Regular Adoration is when daily life sets in, and it can make it feel not so special. But that doesn't devalue or take away from the truth of what Adoration is. Our faith is more than feelings and God will still be working in you. This is the beauty of the Incarnation—God made man, coming into all our stresses, fears, problems—and yes, boredom. Know that even if an hour spent in Adoration is a continual returning to Him every few minutes when your mind wanders, you are still giving God the best gift you can—your time and company.
- 5. But you become excited going to Adoration. The more time you spend in Adoration discovering that God is a God who loves you and wants to spend time with you, the more you begin to actually want to go. If Adoration once felt like a chore, you might even find yourself becoming excited to go! Adoration is addictive, not just because of the things we can gain for ourselves, but because we were created to adore. As we say in the Mass, it is "right and just" that we should give thanks to the Lord! Adoration is imprinted on our hearts and "our hearts are restless until they find our rest in Him"! (Thanks, St. Augustine!)

- 6. Grace enters your life. It's amazing how a simple act of committing to even a short time of regular Adoration makes such a huge difference to the rest of your life. You can carry that moment of being in His presence with you long after you've left the church or chapel. His grace sustains you in every moment, especially in moments of temptation. Temptation becomes easier to resist when you're spending more time in Adoration. Sometimes, it really is that straightforward.
- 7. You realize how fortunate you are. If it is as simple for you as getting in the car and driving to Adoration at church, or even walking to the chapel nearby, you realize how much you can take it for granted. There are those who would love to spend more time with Jesus in Adoration but who are housebound, sick, or busy parents. Then there are those around the world who risk their lives for the Eucharist, in places where they are persecuted for their faith. When you remember those who walk for hours or days in dangerous situations in order to be present with Jesus, you realize what a gift it is to be able to pray openly, not to mention having a priest to minister the sacraments.
- 8. You realize God has a sense of humor. The more you are able to sit and let God speak to you (instead of spending all your time filling the silence with talking to Him), you'll find that God has a really good sense of humor. He likes a joke or two, and sometimes these moments are funny enough to make you want to laugh out loud. Surprising, maybe, but don't the best fathers show you their love by affectionate good humor?!?
- 9. You want to go to Confession more. This might sound scary, but it's not. Confession allows us to experience the mighty boundless ocean that is God's mercy. His mercy swallows up all our sins and gives us a true kind of freedom, a freedom without fear, which allows us to make the leap into His love and goodness, complete with all His perfect plans for our life. Time and time again, going to Confession re-enforces the knowledge that we are jumping into the arms of a Father who loves us very much and "never tires of forgiving us." (Pope Francis)
- 10. You fall in love! Ultimately, you can't help this one! When you spend more time with an open heart in Adoration and just let Christ love you, then you'll fall in love too. That love will define you and allow you to be yourself. "I came that they may have life, life in all its fullness." (John 10:10)


