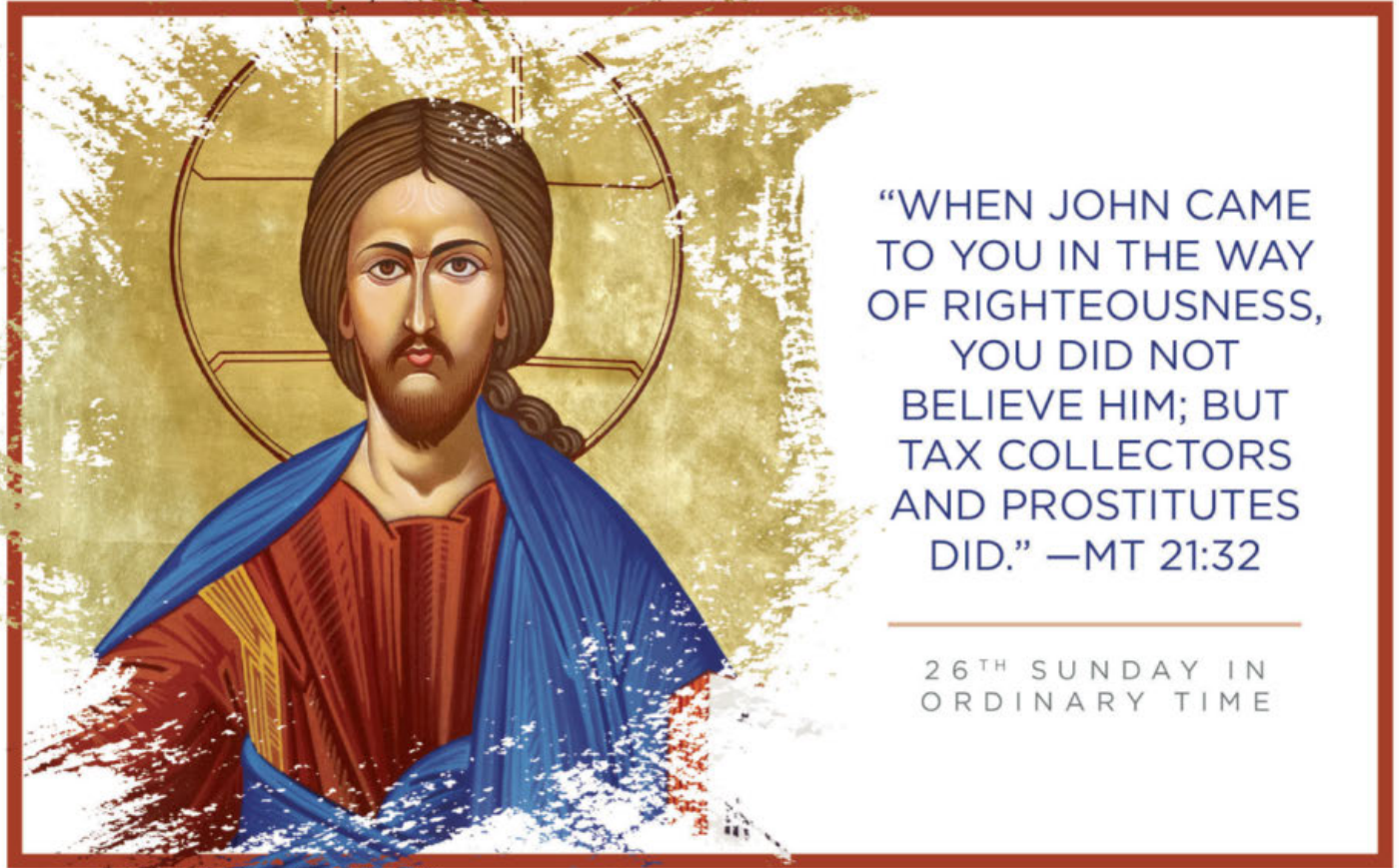

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR THE

26TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The second son never showed up to the vineyard. Did he get lost? Did he get tired? Did he not know where to begin?

When it comes right down to it, good intentions amount to very little. We all know this, don't we? "Show me, don't tell me." "I'll believe it when I see it." It's as true in the workplace and in relationships as it is in the life of the Christian disciple. It doesn't matter if we intend to work in the vineyard. It doesn't matter if we promise to, if we think about it a lot, or if we make grand plans for what we will accomplish there. None of that matters if we don't show up. Before we show up, we have to find the way.

Showing up is the whole point. The work is the point, not the intention.

But all this begs the question: what does the work mean for us as baptized Catholics in the modern world? Spending our Saturdays in soup kitchens and homeless shelters? Standing on a street corner shouting out the words of the Gospel?

Our baptismal call is to the vineyard. Where is our vineyard? How do we show up? We are ready, Lord, we say. We intend to work. But where do we go? My vineyard is not your vineyard, and so it's not my place to tell you how to get there. I am glad you want to go, but you'll have to find your own way, just like I will. But I can tell you this: only one voice will lead you there. If you listen to it, you will find your vineyard.

REFLEXIÓN PARA EL

26TH DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

El segundo hijo nunca apareció en la viña. ¿Se perdió? ¿Se cansó? ¿No sabía por dónde empezar? Cuando se trata de eso, las buenas intenciones equivalen a muy poco. Todos sabemos esto, ¿no? "Muéstrame, no me digas." "Lo creeré cuando lo vea." Es tan cierto en el lugar de trabajo y en las relaciones como en la vida del discípulo cristiano.

No importa si tenemos la intención de trabajar en la viña. No importa si lo prometemos, si lo pensamos mucho o si hacemos grandes planes para lo que lograremos allí. Nada de eso importa si no nos presentamos. Antes de aparecer, tenemos que encontrar el camino.

Aparecer es todo el punto. El trabajo es el punto, no la intención.

Pero todo esto plantea la pregunta: ¿qué significa la obra para nosotros como católicos bautizados en el mundo moderno? ¿Pasar nuestros sábados en comedores populares y refugios para personas sin hogar? ¿Estar de pie en la esquina de una calle gritando las palabras del Evangelio?

Nuestro llamado bautismal es a la viña. ¿Dónde está nuestro viñedo? ¿Cómo nos mostramos? Estamos listos, Señor, decimos. Tenemos la intención de trabajar. Pero, ¿adónde vamos?

Mi viña no es tu viña, por lo que no me corresponde a mí decirte cómo llegar allí. Me alegro de que quieras ir, pero tendrás que encontrar tu propio camino, al igual que yo. Pero puedo decirte esto: solo una voz te llevará allí. Si la escuchas, encontrarás tu viña.

DO YOU KNOW...

Before signing the Declaration of Independence, there were discrimination laws against Catholics and there were no public Catholic Churches. Prior to Father John Carroll becoming America's first Catholic Bishop, his brother built a small framed chapel for Bishop Carroll on his mother's estate in Maryland where Mass was held every Sunday. Weekday Mass was said in his mother's home. The remains of Bishop Carroll are guarded in the Baltimore Basilica crypt.

Antes de que el padre John Carroll se convirtiera en el primer obispo católico de Estados Unidos, su hermano construyó una pequeña capilla enmarcada para el obispo Carroll en la finca de su madre en Maryland, donde se celebraba misa todos los domingos. La misa entre semana se celebraba en casa de su madre. Los restos del obispo Carroll están custodiados en la cripta de la Basílica de Baltimore.

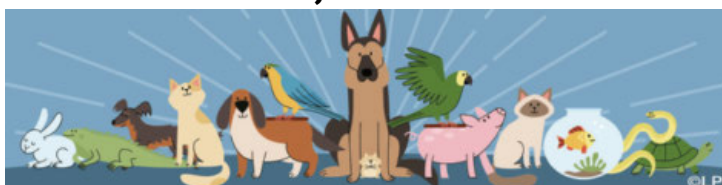

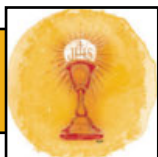


**Please be aware of a phishing scam
imitating the priests of our parish.**

Our church staff, including our priests, will NEVER text or email any parishioners asking for money or any type of assistance. Please do not respond to these requests.

Here are 5 easy steps to take to keep yourself safe:

- 1. Review the sender's email address.** Take a close look at the email address and the domain (e.g. gmail.com) for any inconsistency.
- 2. Examine the URL without clicking it.** Hover over hyperlinks in the email and double-check for odd domain names that you cannot easily identify, as well as shortened URLs that hide the actual link.
- 3. Look out for generic greetings.** Phishing emails may not use your name and, instead, address you as "Dear User" or "Dear Customer."
- 4. Avoid the urgency to act or respond quickly.** Phishing emails tend to use alarming language to pressure someone to quickly respond or click a link.
- 5. Verify with the source.** If you are not sure if the email is valid, contact the person or business through another method of communication
