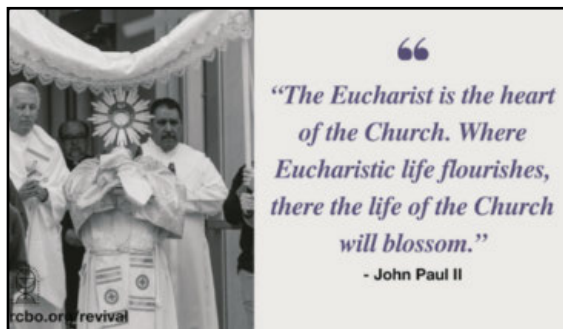

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

REFLECTION FOR THE

27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

It never ceases to amaze me how often I fall into the trap and end up grumbling about the greatest gifts in my life. A husband, children, a life that is full almost to bursting: these are things for which I once begged God. These are the jewels in the crown of my life.

Oh, but the children need care. Constant care. And a husband — a real flesh-and-blood creation of God, entrusted to me by God, to help me be holy and relying on me for holiness in turn — well, that relationship is a lot of work, isn't it? And a "full life" — I laugh to think of it, and then I blush with shame, because I admit sometimes, I do yearn for a life that is a little less full. A full life can leave you awfully tired at the end of the day.

I would imagine it's the same for everyone, no matter your life circumstances or vocation. Your greatest blessings are also those things that require much of you, more than you imagined you would ever be asked to give. The biggest jewels make the crown heavy. But if we had any of these gifts without the effort it takes to maintain them, would they be half as sweet? In this same way, the work of the vineyard is opened to us through baptism; we are given the chance to produce fruit for the kingdom. It's a chance we never dared to dream would be given to us.

It's a gift. But just like with any gift worth having, it requires effort. Upkeep. Work.

It requires that we give in return. And it's the giving that somehow, mystically, transforms us. It's the giving that turns into the gift itself.

27TH DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Nunca deja de sorprenderme la frecuencia con la que caigo en la trampa y termino quejándome de los mejores regalos de mi vida. Un esposo, hijos, una vida plena hasta reventar: estas son las cosas por las que una vez rogué a Dios. Estas son las joyas de la corona de mi vida.

Oh, pero los niños necesitan cuidado. Cuidado constante. Y un esposo, una verdadera creación de Dios de carne y hueso, confiado a mí por Dios, para ayudarme a ser santa y confiando en mí a su vez para su santidad, bueno, esa relación es mucho trabajo, ¿no es así? Y una "vida plena": me río al pensar en ello, y luego me sonrojo de vergüenza, porque admito que a veces anhele una vida que sea un poco menos... plena. Una vida plena puede dejarte terriblemente cansado al final del día.

Me imagino que es lo mismo para todos, sin importar las circunstancias de tu vida o tu vocación. Tus mayores bendiciones son también aquellas cosas que requieren mucho de ti, más de lo que imaginaste que jamás se te pediría que dieras. Las joyas más grandes hacen pesada la corona.

Pero si tuviéramos cualquiera de estos regalos sin el esfuerzo que se necesita para mantenerlos, ¿serían la mitad de dulces?

De la misma manera, el trabajo de la viña se nos abre a través del bautismo; se nos da la oportunidad de producir frutos para el reino. Es una oportunidad que nunca nos atrevimos a soñar que se nos daría.

Es un regalo. Pero al igual que con cualquier regalo que valga la pena tener, requiere esfuerzo. Mantenimiento. Trabajo.

Requiere que demos a cambio. Y es el dar lo que, de alguna manera, místicamente, nos transforma. Es el dar lo que se convierte en el regalo mismo.

DO YOU KNOW...

How the number of names for mass intentions are determined?

According to Canon Law 948, "One Mass for One Intention". Each mass is offered for one and only one intention which a single Mass offering which has been given and accepted. There can only be one intention (one individual name) applied and attached to a single Mass. Arrangements to have a Mass said in honor of someone (living or deceased), may be made with the receptionist in the parish office. The schedule of Mass intentions are usually booked three months in advance.

¿SABÍAS QUE...

¿Cómo se determina el número de nombres para intenciones masivas?

Según el Derecho Canónico 948, "Una Misa por una Intención". Cada misa se ofrece por una y sólo una intención para la cual se ha dado y aceptado una sola ofrenda de Misa. Solo puede haber una intención (un nombre individual) aplicada y adjunta a una sola Misa. Se pueden hacer arreglos para celebrar una Misa en honor de alguien (vivo o fallecido) con la recepcionista de la oficina parroquial. El horario de las Misas de intenciones suele reservarse con tres meses de antelación.

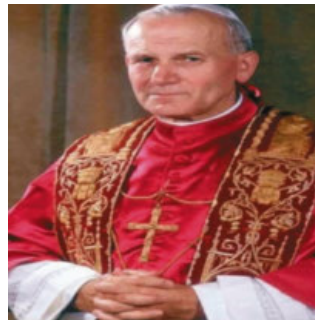

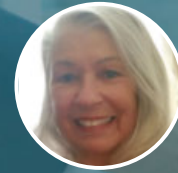

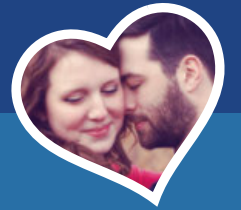
