

REFLECTION FOR THE

27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

It never ceases to amaze me how often I fall into the trap and end up grumbling about the greatest gifts in my life. A husband, children, a life that is full almost to bursting: these are things for which I once begged God. These are the jewels in the crown of my life.

Oh, but the children need care. Constant care. And a husband — a real flesh-and-blood creation of God, entrusted to me by God, to help me be holy and relying on me for holiness in turn — well, that relationship is a lot of work, isn't it? And a "full life" — I laugh to think of it, and then I blush with shame, because I admit sometimes, I do yearn for a life that is a little less full. A full life can leave you awfully tired at the end of the

I would imagine it's the same for everyone, no matter your life circumstances or vocation. Your greatest blessings are also those things that require much of you, more than you imagined you would ever be asked to give. The biggest jewels make the crown heavy. But if we had any of these gifts without the effort it takes to maintain them, would they be half as sweet? In this same way, the work of the vineyard is opened to us through baptism; we are given the chance to produce fruit for the kingdom. It's a chance we never dared to dream would be given to us.

It's a gift. But just like with any gift worth having, it requires effort. Upkeep. Work.

It requires that we give in return. And it's the giving that somehow, mystically, transforms us. It's the giving that turns into the gift itself.

DO YOU KNOW...

How the number of names for mass intentions are determined?

According to Canon Law 948, "One Mass for One Intention". Each mass is offered for one and only one intention which a single Mass offering which has been given and accepted. There can only be one intention (one individual name) applied and attached to a single Mass. Arrangements to have a Mass said in honor of someone (living or deceased), may be made with the receptionist in the parish office. The schedule of Mass intentions are usually booked three months in advance.

¿SABÍAS QUE... ¿Cómo se determina el número de nombres para intenciones masivas?

Según el Derecho Canónico 948, "Una Misa por una Intención". Cada misa se ofrece por una y sólo una intención para la cual se ha dado y aceptado una sola ofrenda de Misa. Solo puede haber una intención (un nombre individual) aplicada y adjunta a una sola Misa. Se pueden hacer arreglos para celebrar una Misa en honor de alquien (vivo o fallecido) con la recepcionista de la oficina parroquial. El horario de las Misas de intenciones suele reservarse con tres meses de antelación.




