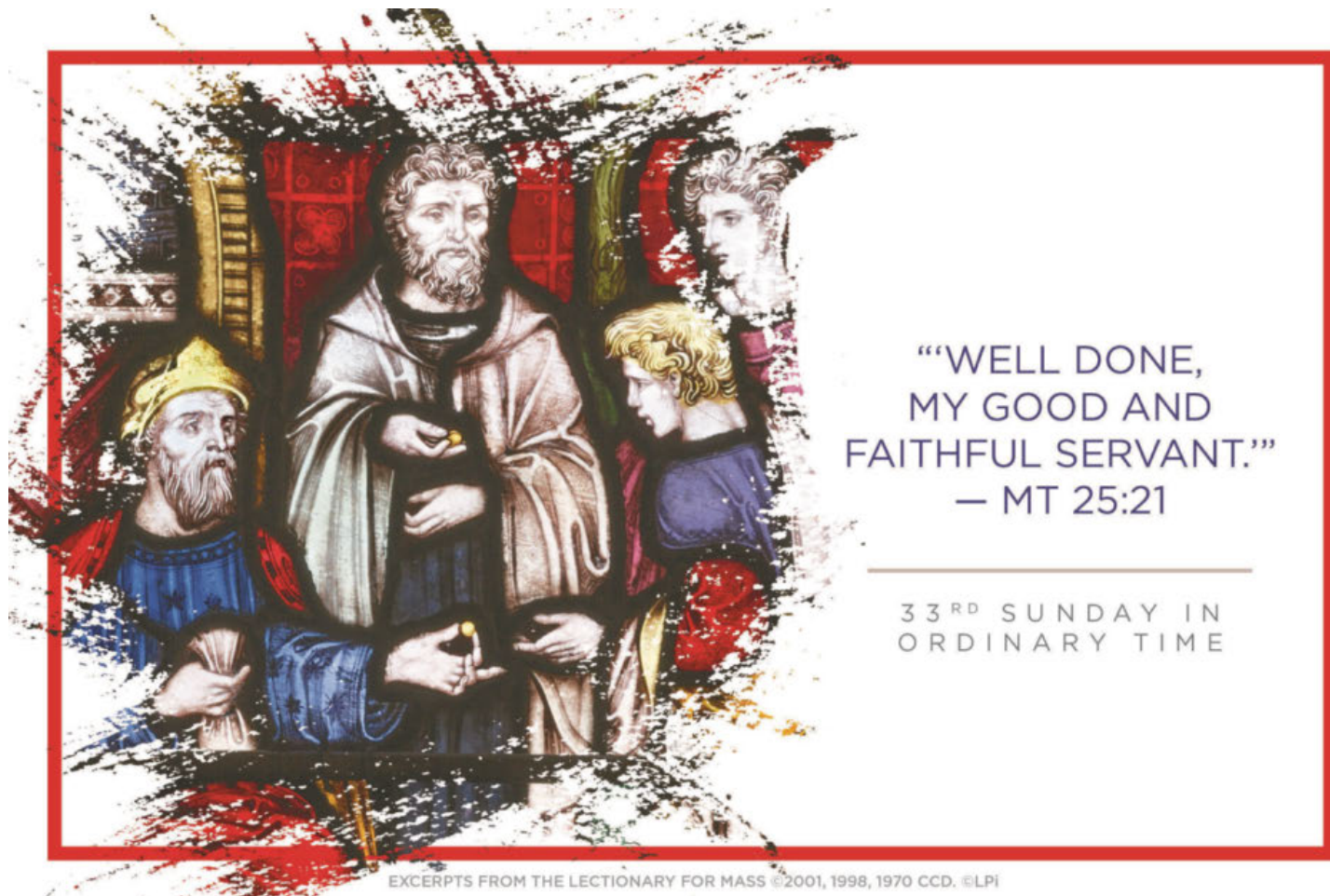

REFLECTION FOR THE 33RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

When my grandfather died, my parents, siblings, and I were left with the question: what's to become of the house?

Anyone who has inherited property knows that it's not simply a matter of assuming ownership of a plot of land upon which sits four walls and a roof. Those four walls and a roof usually contain memories and objects — an enormous volume of both, in the case of my grandfather. When they're left to you, you have to sift through them, the memories and the objects, and with each one you have to think: Is it worth it? Do I keep it? Will I need it? And slowly, painfully, you disassemble the physical existence of the person who lived here. You accept, with a pang, that most of it must be given away or discarded. You cry when you bag up the clothes to take to Goodwill. You can't even bear to look when they break the piano into a hundred pieces and throw it in a dumpster, realizing that no one wants or has a use for something that was once so precious.

But when you come upon a rosary that was used so many times it has begun to fall apart, you don't even think twice before keeping it, and not because you need the rosary. You need what it means. You need what it reminds you of.

When all is said and done, each of us will be called before our master to settle accounts, just as my grandfather was.

"Where are the gifts I gave you? What remains of the fortune to which I entrusted you?" he will ask us. "What have you done with the peace? What have you done with the love? What have you done with the mercy?"

Pero cuando te encuentras con un rosario que se usó tantas veces que ha comenzado a desmoronarse, ni lo piensas dos veces antes de guardarlo, y no porque necesites el rosario. Necesitas lo que significa. Necesitas lo que te recuerda.

Cuando todo esté dicho y hecho, cada uno de nosotros será llamado ante nuestro amo para ajustar cuentas, tal como lo fue mi abuelo.

DO YOU KNOW...

What is a Diocesan Priest vs a Religious Priest?

All Catholic priests are ordained to serve, preach, teach, minister the sacraments, and shepherd the people of God. They all go through long seminary formation and are trained according to Canon Law to fulfill the mission, though the level of formation may vary. There are many similarities among them, but not all Catholic priests are the same. Some belong to a religious order, and others are diocesan priests. Priests who are members of a religious order (the Dominicans, the Franciscans, the Benedictines for example) live in a community, have a rule of life and take vows of Poverty, Chastity and Obedience. They are called Religious Priests and dedicate their lives to the service of the Gospel. Diocesan priests, in contrast, belong to a diocese or a territory rather than a particular religious community or order. They may live with other priests, but don't live in a community. Diocesan priests tend to be parish priests, serving one diocese their entire lives, going from parish to parish helping people of that diocese to get to heaven.

¿SABÍAS QUE...

¿Qué es un sacerdote diocesano versus un sacerdote religioso?

Todos los sacerdotes católicos están ordenados para servir, predicar, enseñar, ministrar los sacramentos y pastorear al pueblo de Dios. Todos ellos pasan por una larga formación en el seminario y son formados según el Derecho Canónico para cumplir la misión, aunque el nivel de formación puede variar. Hay muchas similitudes entre ellos, pero no todos los sacerdotes católicos son iguales. Algunos pertenecen a una orden religiosa y otros son sacerdotes diocesanos. Los sacerdotes miembros de una orden religiosa (los dominicos, los franciscanos, los benedictinos, por ejemplo) viven en comunidad, tienen una regla de vida y hacen votos de pobreza, castidad y obediencia. Se les llama Religiosos Sacerdotes y dedican su vida al servicio del Evangelio. Los sacerdotes diocesanos, por el contrario, pertenecen a una diócesis o un territorio más que a una comunidad u orden religiosa particular. Pueden vivir con otros sacerdotes, pero no viven en una comunidad. Los sacerdotes diocesanos tienden a ser párrocos, sirviendo a una diócesis toda su vida, yendo de parroquia en parroquia ayudando a las personas de esa diócesis a llegar al cielo.

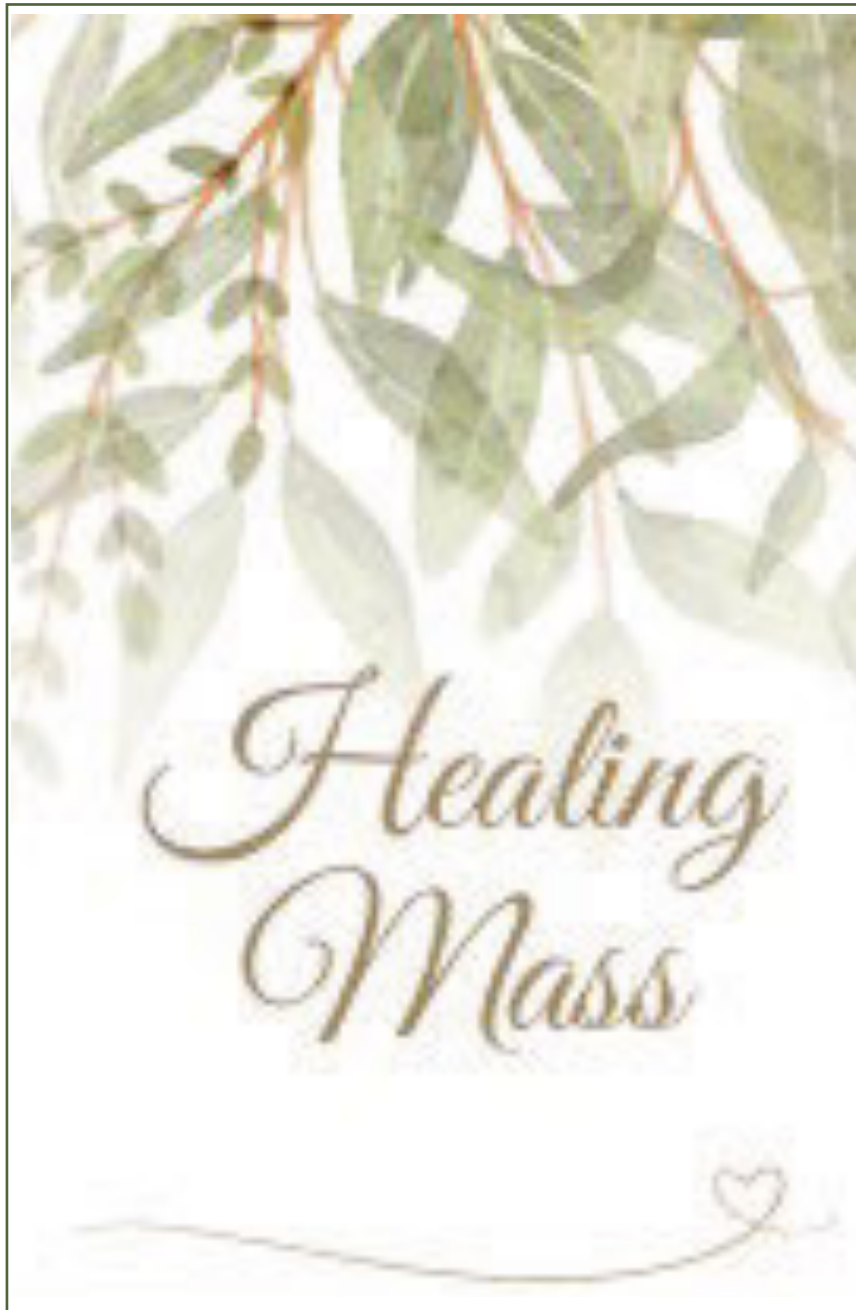

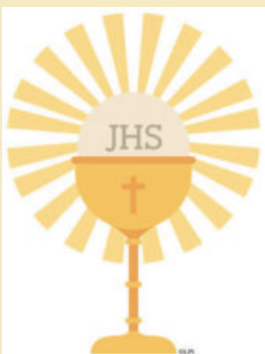

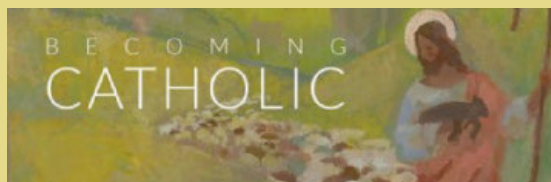

TK & KINDERGARTEN FALL FAMILY POETRY AND ART PROJECT

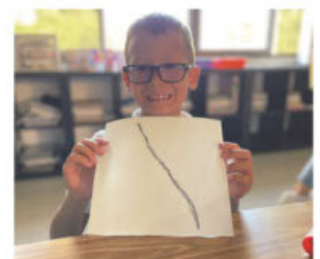

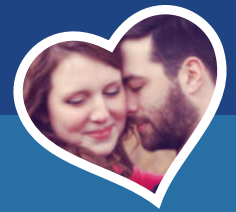
