REFLECTION FOR THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

Why do we believe in Jesus and the Catholic Church? Why should we continue to do so? We've never seen him face-to-face (at least not most of us, I assume). Most of us have never had mystical visions of angels or saints. We live in the same world as our atheist and secularists friends. Why do we believe in Christ if we've never seen him?

The simple, symbolic answer the Gospel presents to us this week might surprise us: we believe because of John the Baptist. Early in John's Gospel we hear: "There was a man sent from God, his name was John. He came for testimony, to bear witness to the light, that all might believe through him." The Baptist powerfully announces Jesus. This is a historical fact, and it is also now a pattern at work in our lives. John the Baptist stands for the entirety of the old covenant, everything entrusted to the Jewish people. And yet he prophetically opens the door to something entirely new in Jesus, to the revival and fulfillment of God's promises. In every generation, and in every human life, God continues to do this. He has done it through people named Augustine, Francis, Catherine, Theresa, and countless others. In my life, the Baptist's spirit has come through persons named Eric, Paul, Mary, and Ron. I challenge you to name at least three people through whom God has announced the coming of Jesus in your life. Consciously thank God for their testimony. And let's commit ourselves to listening to the spirit of John the Baptist testify again this week so that we might more strongly believe in the light.

DO YOU KNOW...

The Christmas Liturgy dates and meaning?

Dec. 17, one week before Christmas Eve. This is the day when the church starts praying the "O antiphons" (antiphons which are most popularly well-known as the inspiration for the Advent hymn "O Come, O Come Emmanuel") before the Gospel at daily Mass and before the "Magnificat" prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours. The beginning of the "O antiphons" marks a shift in the church's liturgy, where Christmas is anticipated with a more immediate sense of urgency. The church celebrates the "octave," or the eight days following Christmas, almost as though it were Christmas day itself.

Jan. 6 is the traditional date of the feast of the Epiphany or "Three Kings' Day," a feast which marks the last day of the 12 days of Christmas. But officially, the Christmas season doesn't end until the feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which the church celebrates the Sunday after Jan. 6.

Feb. 2. This is the last day that the Vatican keeps up their Christmas tree and crèche in St. Peter's square in Rome.

¿SABÍAS QUE...

¿Fechas y significado de la Liturgia de Navidad?

17 de diciembre, una semana antes de Nochebuena. Este es el día en que la iglesia comienza a rezar las "Antífonas O" (antífonas más conocidas popularmente como la inspiración para el himno de Adviento "O Come, O Come Emmanuel") antes del Evangelio en la Misa diaria y antes del "Magnificat" Oración en la Liturgia de las Horas. El comienzo de las "Antífonas de Oh" marca un cambio en la liturgia de la iglesia, donde la Navidad se anticipa con un sentido de urgencia más inmediato.

La iglesia celebra la "octava", u ocho días después de Navidad, casi como si fuera el mismo día de Navidad. El 6 de enero es la fecha tradicional de la fiesta de la Epifanía o "Día de los Reyes Magos", fiesta que marca el último día de los 12 días de Navidad. Pero oficialmente, la temporada navideña no termina hasta la fiesta del Bautismo del Señor, que la iglesia celebra el domingo después del 6 de enero. 2 de febrero. Este es el último día en que el Vaticano mantiene su árbol de Navidad y su pesebre en la plaza de San Pedro en Roma.

Parish Kitchen Update

After several decades of loving ministry and outreach, we have been notified by the Orange County Health Department that we need to update our parish hall kitchen facility in order to receive a Health Permit to serve food.

That being said, the cost of the project to complete the conditions for use, require the Diocese of Orange Office of Construction to implement and oversee the restoration.

Sadly, we will not be able to use the kitchen facility during the restoration and the use of the kitchen will be suspended effective December 18, 2023.

We are excited about what will be, in the coming months ahead, an up-to-date and fully-functional kitchen. Once completed, St. Angela Merici Church and School will have a health permit and improved kitchen that is compliant with health, safety and building codes.

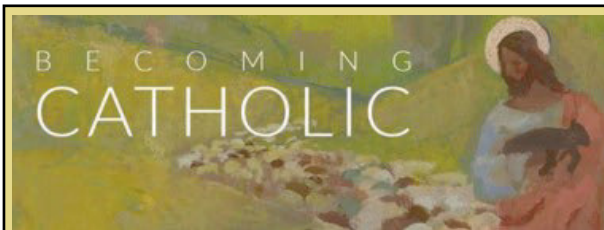

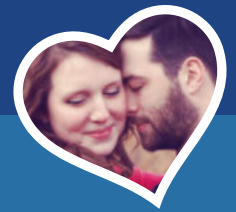
