**OUR GOAL**

REFLECTION FOR  
29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

From a young age, I loved winning at sports. I confess that winning was a bit of an addiction. It was probably coming from a deep desire for attention and affirmation from others. Nevertheless, it was a driving motivation for me. Baseball, soccer, track, table tennis, and whatever else I could find was a chance to win. Competition was my obsession.

Another John, and his brother James, demonstrate a kind of wildly competitive obsession when they dare to say to Jesus: "Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory" (Mark 10:37). Their audacity arouses an indigent reaction from the other apostles, who are clearly raw that these two are out to win the highest spots.

How does Jesus respond to us in our desires for greatness? The same way he does to James and John. He does not criticize them for their desire for glory. But he does highlight their ignorance ("you do not know what you are asking."). Then he invites them to be champions of true greatness: by drinking not the cup of worldly victory, but his cup of self-giving suffering love, to be the "slave of all." The true winners are slaves of love. This week, dare to tell Jesus what your ambitions truly are. Hear him call you to an even greater victory.

29º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Ciertamente que en el evangelio de hoy se pasaron de listos los discípulos Santiago y Juan. Ya que le pidieron a Jesús algo que causó enojo en el resto del grupo de los doce. Y no pedían poca cosa, nada más y nada menos que sentarse a la derecha de Jesús, cuando estuviera en su gloria. De hecho, no sabían lo que pedían, ni siquiera imaginaban que para ello se tiene que servir y trabajar duro en cuestión del discipulado. Sin embargo, hay que entenderlos desde un punto de vista muy humano, pretender grandezas y buenos puestos nos gusta a todos. Y más si no implica sacrificio alguno.

Jesús deja muy claro lo que significa seguirlo y desear estar en primer lugar: "El que quiera ser el más importante entre ustedes, debe hacerse el servidor de todos. Y el que quiera ser el primero, se hará esclavo de todos" (Marcos 10: 43-44). Es decir, no oprimir a los demás como si fuesen sus dueños, no imponer sus ideas, ni sus condiciones de opresión. Para que quede más claro aún, la ley del Reino de Dios es el sufrimiento y el servicio a los que nos rodean. ¿Crees esto? ¿Te atreverías pedirle a Jesús sentarte a su lado sin hacer nada por los demás? Reflexiona en tu vida actualmente, no corras el riesgo de extraviarte en bagatelas por los caminos de la vida. Si escuchas los consejos de Jesús a sus discípulos de aquel entonces, verás que son los mismos para nosotros ahora. Servir y amar sin condiciones, dar la vida en el día a día con alegría, dejando el perfume de Cristo a nuestro paso.

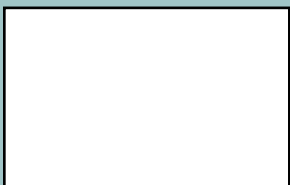

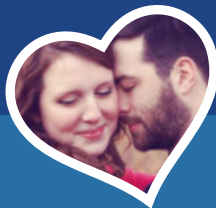

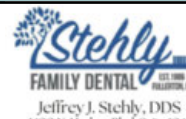
