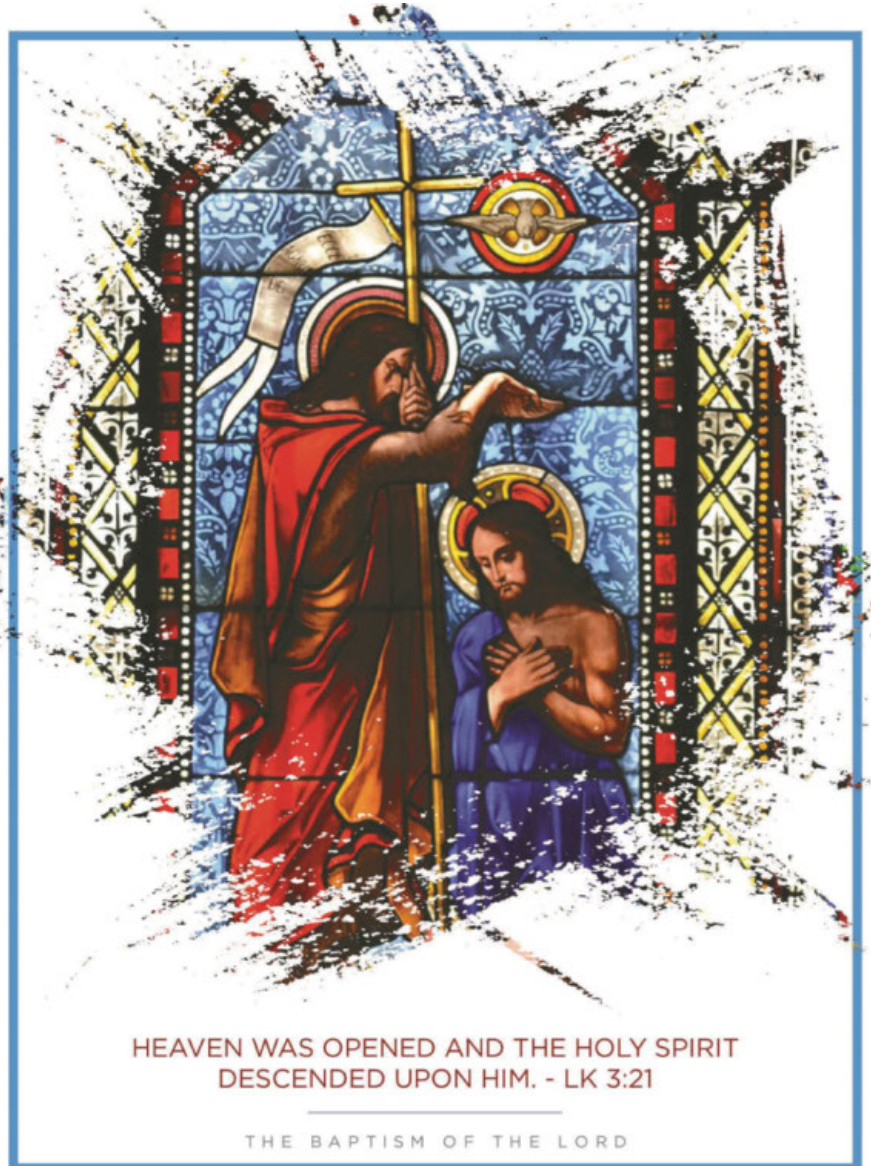

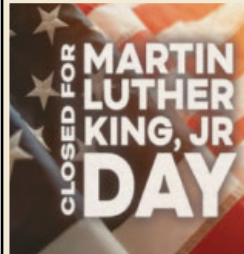

REFLECTION FOR
THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD

In my second year of theology studies, I went to confession to a priest visiting the seminary for a three-day retreat. My heart wasn't in it. I was going through the motions. I confessed my sins and waited for his response. The priest said, "For your penance, I'd like you to go into the chapel and repeat the words 'You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased' (Luke 3:22) until they mean something to you." Easy penance, I thought. But to my surprise, I struggled to say those words. I sensed a strong interior resistance blocking them. How could God be well-pleased with me? He couldn't be, I thought. A battle within me ensued. Two hours later, the resistance vanished, and I found myself able to speak, and claim as my own, those marvelous words. I emerged from the chapel with a new, deep, peaceful conviction that I was indeed God's beloved son. Those words are a precious gift from heaven to all of us. Jesus' baptism, which we celebrate this week, offers them to us. Are we willing to receive these words anew? Many things can block this deepening of our baptismal identity: failings, sins, disappointments, traumas, problems, and so on. Yet God's love is always greater. This week I challenge you to prayerfully repeat these words over yourself — or perhaps over someone you're struggling to love — until those words find a home in your heart.

"El Bautismo es el más bello y magnífico de los dones de Dios... lo llamamos don, gracia, unción, iluminación, vestidura de incorruptibilidad, baño de regeneración, sello y todo lo más precioso que hay" (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, numeral 1243). 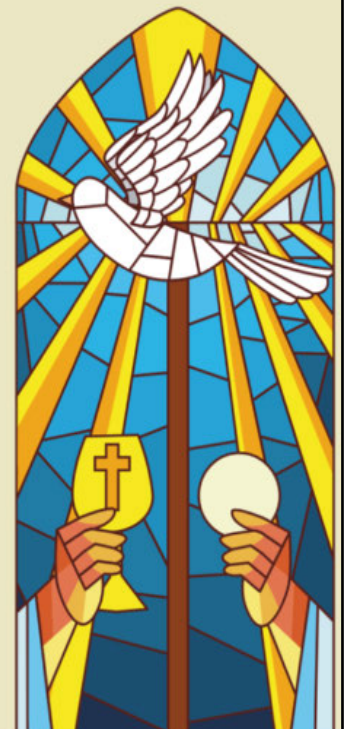

OUR HISTORY

Thousands of children have been offered a first-class, faith-based education since St. Angela Merici Parish School first opened its doors 60 years ago. SAM is an energetic and thriving community that maintains both its traditions of academic excellence and its vision for a bright future in Catholic education.



1951

The Brea Mission is established at the intersection of Fir St and Walnut Ave in Brea.

1962

St. Angela Merici becomes an official parish serving Catholic families in Brea and parts of Fullerton.

1964

St. Angela Merici Parish School opens with the Poor Clare Sisters from Ireland (now Sisters of St. Clare) as teachers.

1968

The parish grows to over 800 families, with approximately 350 students registered in the school.

1969

Construction on the present church building is completed. The first Masses were celebrated on Easter Sunday, 1969. A parish hall and religious education classrooms would later be added.

1989

Summerfest is held for the first time to raise funds to support the school. This beloved SAM tradition continues today thanks to the hard work of parents, parishioners, and alumni and has grown to become the largest community event in North Orange county.


TODAY

Building on the dedication of our predecessors, SAM continues to thrive as we provide an education rooted in the love of Christ. Our campus has expanded to include: TK - 8th grade classrooms, STEM lab, music room, learning support labs, library, extended care center, and science lab.

The Mission of St. Angela Merici Parish Catholic School is to proclaim the Gospel, celebrate through worship, build community, serve others and achieve academic excellence through the discovery of each student's gifts and talents.

OCIA

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

The RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) is becoming OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults).

The OCIA is the process through which adults and older children who are not baptized become Catholic. Those baptized as Catholics or in another Christian faith but have not received Eucharist (Communion) and Confirmation are also prepared through this process.

Order= meaning a collection of Rites

Rites= meaning a church tradition on how the sacraments are celebrated

The OCIA is a process of conversion, not a program.

Not only does the OCIA Team take an active role in supporting these individuals but the Church (community) is an integral part of the formation of these seekers.

We are forming a GriefShare group beginning Thursday evening, Jan. 16, at St. Angela's.

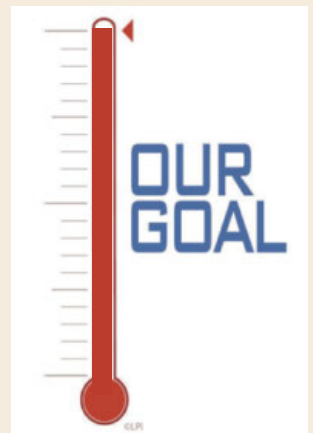

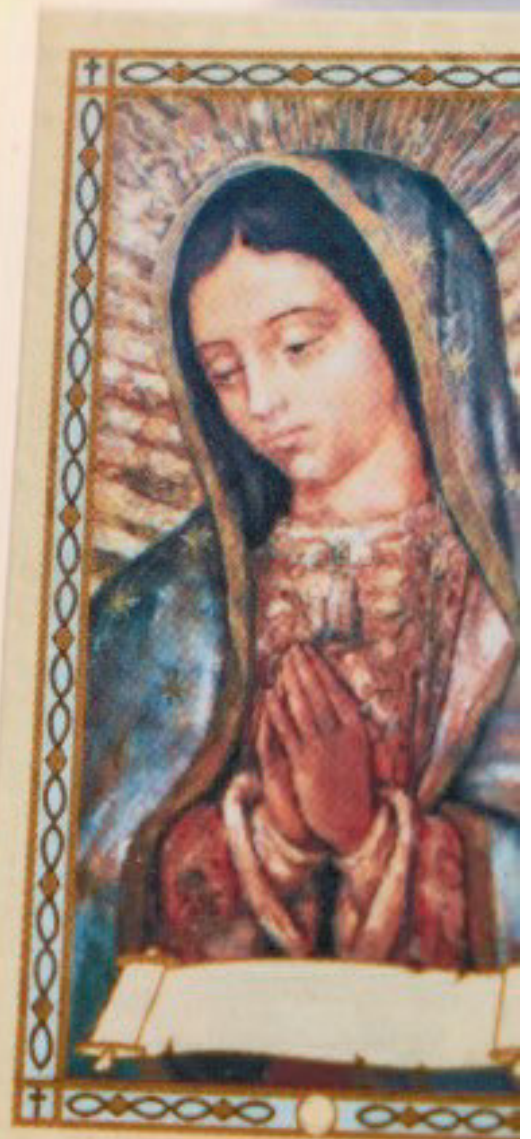

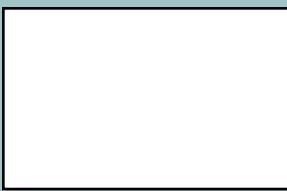
