REFLECTION FOR THE THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"Alas, that these evil days should be mine." If you've ever seen "The Lord of the Rings," you might recognize this quote from "The Two Towers." The words are spoken by King Theoden at the grave of his only son and heir, as Theoden contemplates the coming war for Middle Earth, a war which has already claimed the life of his son, a war he wants no part of, a war that seems utterly hopeless and unwinnable.

These evil days. You don't have to be a fantasy enthusiast or even a Tolkien fan to identify with Theoden here. We have all experienced this same feeling of despair, perhaps increasingly in this age of technology and social media, when the ills of the whole world — violence, injustice, moral disorder and chaos — are in our faces, on our phones, looming over our days. But when we despair like this, we forget an important truth: this is the time of fulfillment, and we are lucky enough to be living through it.

Yes, the world is broken. It was broken two thousand years ago, too, when Jesus stood up in the synagogue on the Sabbath and read the words of the prophet Isaiah: "He has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives...and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord."

Jesus didn't come to fix the brokenness of the world. He came to fix our brokenness. He offers us not relief from the trials of life, but an answer to the question of how to live in joy, in love and in purpose in the midst of these evil days.

Si alguna vez has visto "El Señor de los Anillos," es posible que reconozcas esta cita de "Las Dos Torres." Las palabras son pronunciadas por el rey Théoden en la tumba de su único hijo y heredero, mientras Théoden contempla la guerra que se avecina por la Tierra Media, una guerra que ya ha cobrado la vida de su hijo, una guerra de la que no quiere formar parte, una guerra que parece completamente desesperada e imposible de ganar.

Tiempos aciagos.

No tienes que ser un entusiasta de la fantasía o incluso un fanático de Tolkien para identificarte con Théoden aquí. Todos hemos experimentado este mismo sentimiento de desesperación, tal vez cada vez más en esta era de la tecnología y las redes sociales, cuando los males de todo el mundo —la violencia, la injusticia, el desorden moral y el caos— están en nuestros rostros, en nuestros teléfonos, acercándose sobre nuestros días.

Pero cuando nos desesperamos de esta manera, olvidamos una verdad importante: este es el tiempo de la plenitud, y tenemos la suerte de estar viviéndolo.

Sí, el mundo está roto. También estaba roto hace dos mil años, cuando Jesús se levantó en la sinagoga el sábado y leyó las palabras del profeta Isaías: "Él me ha ungido para anunciar la buena nueva a los pobres. Él me ha enviado a proclamar la libertad a los cautivos... y proclamar un año agradable al Señor."

Jesús no vino a arreglar el quebrantamiento del mundo. Él vino a arreglar nuestro quebrantamiento. Él no nos ofrece alivio de las pruebas de la vida, sino una respuesta a la pregunta de cómo vivir con gozo, amor y propósito en medio de estos días aciagos.

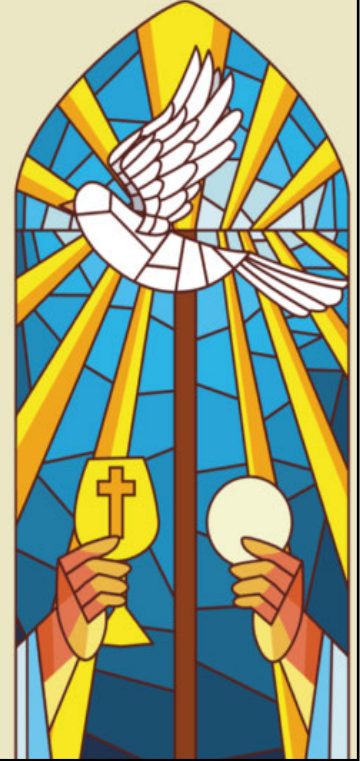

The OCIA is the process through which adults and older children who are not baptized become Catholic. Those baptized as Catholics or in another Christian faith but have not received Eucharist (Communion) and Confirmation are also prepared through this process.

## Team OCIA

There are many moving parts in OCIA not only discussion topics of the Catholic faith, but dismissals, Breaking Open the Word, rituals, etc. This involves many individuals such as yourself to support and guide those seeking to be full active members of the Catholic Church.

**Dismissal Leaders\***: Do you love discussing the Sunday Readings? Dismissal leaders are needed to help with Breaking Open the Word. Catechumens are led out after the homily (9:30AM Mass) by a leader to St. Paul room to discuss the readings.

**Sponsors/godparents\***: Many of our catechumens and candidates need someone to support them on their journey at the OCIA sessions, rituals and Easter Vigil. You may feel a special calling to walk with one of these individuals as they become full members of the Catholic Church.

**Support Team\***: These are individuals who attend the OCIA sessions and show "support" by their presence and shared experience of the Catholic faith.

\*All the above require that individuals be adults fully initiated  
(*Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation*) practicing Catholics.
