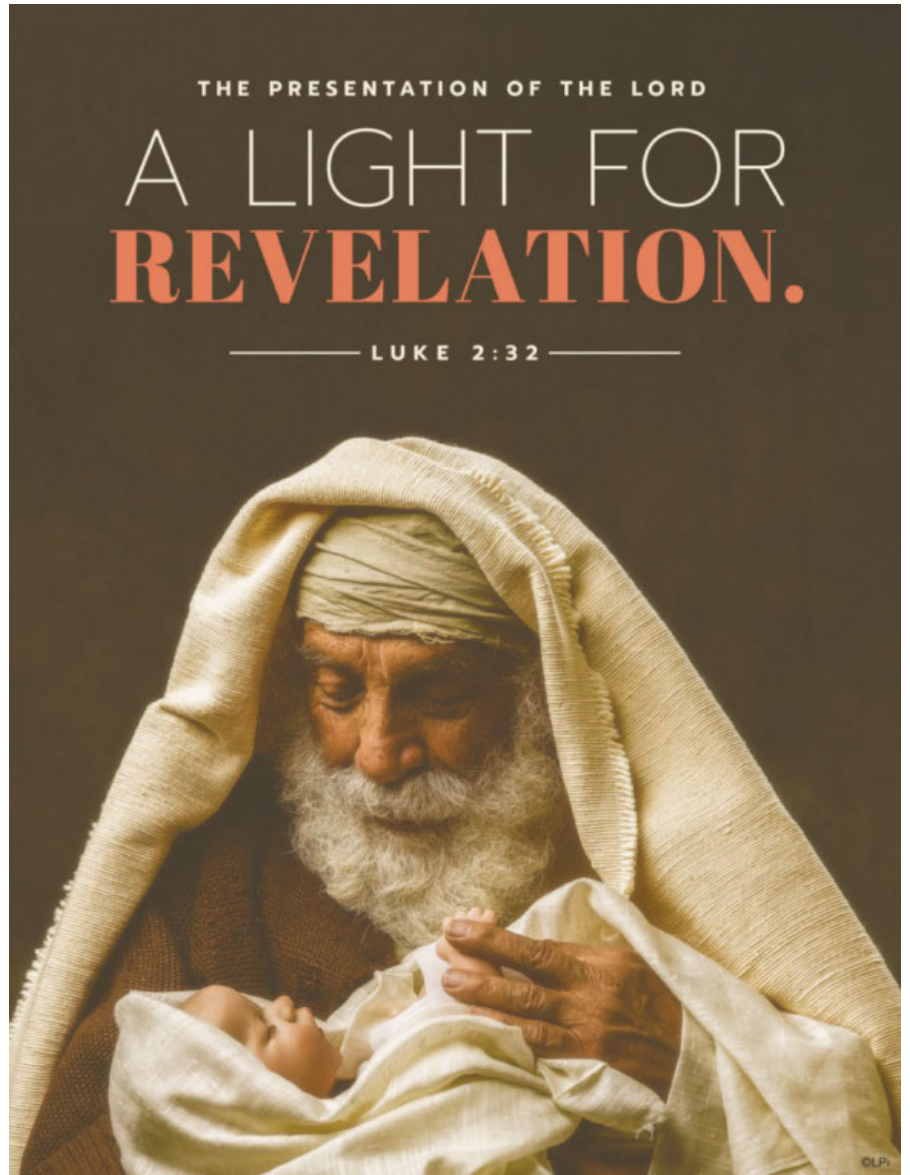

REFLECTION FOR THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

What is the secret to sharing in God's power to overcome our difficulties? Mary teaches us this in the prophecy of her pierced heart. This Sunday, the old man Simeon prophesies that when her son faces opposition, Mary's soul will be pierced by a sword. The seemingly pointless agony of a mother helplessly watching her son be mocked, tortured, killed and then cruelly desecrated in death by a spear — somehow this piercing of her heart releases a power by which "the thoughts of many hearts may be revealed" (Luke 2:35). What to make of this?

Whatever problems we currently face, the deepest threat is finally that evil thoughts are hidden in the human heart: hatred, envy, pride, lust, greed and so on. Behind every tyrant's injustice, for example, is a heart unpierced by love. Evil hides in our hearts. Mary's pierced heart, and its suffering love for her son, reveals and scatters these evil thoughts, and replaces them with love, forgiveness, generosity and peace.

This week, I invite us to ponder Mary's pierced heart. Her heart is quietly at work for us in the Church and world, exposing our evil thoughts and making a path for her son's divine love. This is how she gently cooperates in our salvation. Closed hearts are our biggest problem; love-pierced hearts are the ultimate power to overcome every difficulty.

Ellos, ya ancianos, nos enseñaron y mostraron el camino de ver, abrazar a Dios hecho niño y a anunciar la esperanza. Abracemos también nosotros la ternura de Dios y llevémosla a los tristes, a los enfermos, y a los que no tienen voz en muchos lugares de la sociedad en que vivimos, tal como son los niños y los ancianos. Abramos nuestro corazón al misterio de Dios que está en tantas personas que nos encontramos a diario, en casa, en el trabajo, y en nuestros vecindarios. Ojalá, que al final de nuestros días, Dios nos de la dicha de poder decir como el anciano Simeón: "Ahora, Señor, ya puedes dejar que tu servidor muera en paz, como le has dicho. Porque mis ojos han visto a tu salvador" (Lucas 2:29-30).

The OCIA is the process through which adults and older children who are not baptized become Catholic. Those baptized as Catholics or in another Christian faith but have not received Eucharist (Communion) and Confirmation are also prepared through this process.

Team OCIA

There are many moving parts in OCIA not only discussion topics of the Catholic faith, but dismissals, Breaking Open the Word, rituals, etc. This involves many individuals such as yourself to support and guide those seeking to be full active members of the Catholic Church.

Dismissal Leaders*: Do you love discussing the Sunday Readings? Dismissal leaders are needed to help with Breaking Open the Word. Catechumens are led out after the homily (9:30AM Mass) by a leader to St. Paul room to discuss the readings.

Sponsors/godparents*: Many of our catechumens and candidates need someone to support them on their journey at the OCIA sessions, rituals and Easter Vigil. You may feel a special calling to walk with one of these individuals as they become full members of the Catholic Church.

Support Team*: These are individuals who attend the OCIA sessions and show “support” by their presence and shared experience of the Catholic faith.

*All the above require that individuals be adults fully initiated
(*Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation*) practicing Catholics.
