REFLECTION FOR THE 8TH SUNDAY  
IN ORDINARY TIME

One of the things that older pastors and younger priests occasionally quarrel about is the proper balance between work and prayer. I know one pastor who complains that his younger associate ignores the people and the parish because he wants to spend more time in prayer. And the young priest complains that the pastor gives him too much work to do and no time to pray. The Lord's words this Sunday speak into this tension with an image that can help us find a proper balance between life and prayer.

Jesus says, "For every tree is known by its fruit. For people do not pick figs from thorn bushes, nor do they gather grapes from brambles" (Luke 6:44). When we are deeply rooted and cultivating our relationship with Jesus, we are going to bear the fruit of that love in our lives.

No fruit, no good prayer. How do we know that we are praying well? We are experiencing concrete fruits of love for others in our lives.

Someone who prays well will, sooner or later, burst forth the "figs" and "grapes" of acts of love. But without concrete commitment to deeds of selfless service to others, our prayer time is as useless as thorn bushes and brambles. Let's recommit ourselves to be men and women of prayer and service. And hopefully the pastors will help their associates to pray and serve fruitfully...with minimal quarreling.

REFLEXIÓN PARA EL 8º DOMINGO  
DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Siempre que vamos al súper, llegamos con el buen deseo de escoger lo mejor. Especialmente la fruta, la queremos fresca, jugosa y dulce. Has pensado en los árboles de donde proviene la fruta. ¿Serán buenos, estarán bien regados y vitaminados? Porque depende del árbol cómo es que será su fruto, bueno o malo. Hoy, es día de examen, para saber cómo andamos de frutos. Mucho depende de lo que llevamos dentro del corazón y Jesús, sin rodeos, lanza la siguiente pregunta: "¿Puede un ciego guiar a otro ciego? Ciertamente caerán ambos en algún hoyo" (Lucas 6:39). Desde luego que no, alguno de los dos debe tener visión clara y saber hacia dónde se dirige. Observemos bien qué tipo de fruto esta dando nuestra vida y eso se mide en el refrán que dice: Obras son amores, y no buenas razones.

El Papa Francisco, también lo explica de la siguiente manera: "Los niños y los jóvenes son los frutos de los árboles. Y cuando un árbol tiene buenas raíces y un buen tronco (abuelos y padres) da buenos frutos. Debemos ser un bosque lleno de buenos frutos; las familias numerosas son una gran esperanza de la sociedad". Todos por lo general tendemos a cuidar las apariencias, por lo tanto, descuidamos lo más importante, el interior del corazón, que es de donde sale lo bueno: "La boca habla de lo que está lleno el corazón" (Lucas 6:45). Pidamos al Señor, que nuestros frutos buenos sean para que los demás los disfruten.

**St. Angela Merici OPERATION RICE BOWL - 2025 is here!**

Pick up rice bowls today after all Masses, or from the parish office during the week. Begin your Lenten journey with this cardboard reminder of your prayer, fasting and Lenten almsgiving. Operation Rice Bowl is here at St Angela's

Set the bowl in the kitchen or dining table as a daily reminder.

Use the bowls during Lent to set aside your alms.

Turn bowls and alms in on Sunday May 3rd

CRS Rice Bowl is a staple on the table of Catholic families across the country during Lent. This simple cardboard box is a tool for collecting Lenten alms—and comes with a Lenten calendar that guides families through the 40 days of Lent with activities, reflections, and stories.

More than 40 years ago, Catholics in the United States wanted to respond to famine in Africa. Could people who were hungry be helped through Lenten prayers, fasting and almsgiving? Yes! The help came in the form of a small cardboard box, marking the beginning of "Operation Rice Bowl" in 1975 in parishes in Allentown, Penna.. Today, CRS Rice Bowl is a tradition for millions of Catholics in the U.S. who employ the Lenten pillars of praying, fasting and almsgiving to change the lives of others while enriching their own. In 1976, Operation Rice Bowl was adopted by the United State Conference of Catholic Bishops as a national program. In 1977, they voted to make Operation Rice Bowl the official program of Catholic Relief Services. Operation Rice Bowl at St. Angela's is sponsored by the Knights of Columbus council, PALS and the Hispanic community.

Hace más de 40 años, los católicos de los Estados Unidos querían responder a la hambruna en África. ¿Se podía ayudar a las personas que pasaban hambre mediante oraciones, ayunos y limosnas de Cuaresma? ¡Sí! La ayuda llegó en forma de una pequeña caja de cartón, marcando el comienzo de la "Operación Plato de Arroz" en 1975 en las parroquias de Allentown, Pensilvania. Hoy, Plato de Arroz de CRS es una tradición para millones de católicos en los EE. UU. que emplean los pilares de Cuaresma de oración, ayuno y limosna para cambiar las vidas de los demás y enriquecer las suyas. En 1976, la Operación Plato de Arroz fue adoptada por la Conferencia de Obispos Católicos de los Estados Unidos como un programa nacional. En 1977, votaron para convertir la Operación Plato de Arroz en el programa oficial de Catholic Relief Services. La Operación Plato de Arroz en St. Angela's está patrocinada por el consejo de los Caballeros de Colón, PALS y la comunidad hispana.

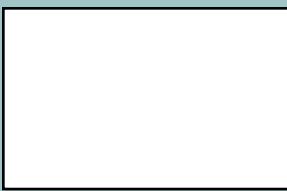
